

BOA HOLD INSTRUCTION SHEET

Read instructions carefully before you start.



SIZE CHART:

FENCE POST	HOLE DIAMETER	HOLE DEPTH	# OF 56oz BAGS
2" x 4"	8"	1FT	1
2" x 4"	8"	2FT	2
4" x 4"	8"	2FT	2
4" x 4"	10"	30"	3
6" x 6"	10"	30"	3
6" x 6"	10"	3FT	4

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Gloves • Safety goggles • Scissors • Serrated edge knife
- Soft cloth and mineral spirits • Level

Make sure the post hole is at proper depth and diameter for correct expansion level.



1 Push contents from both sides of Boa Hold bag firmly toward the center to force a break in the divider seal, allowing contents A and B to mix freely.



2 Continue mixing parts A and B thoroughly inside bag for a maximum of 30 seconds by rubbing back and forth against your leg or a hard surface. Do not exceed 30 seconds, as mixture will start to expand.



3 Cut the V-shaped end of the bag with scissors or box cutter. (This will be the spout)



4 Pour mixture into the post hole holding the post in place. Attempt to squeeze as much contents out of the bag and around the post as possible.



5 Roll down the end of the bag opposite the spout, further emptying all contents. Any contents left inside the bag will expand and harden.



6 After making sure your post is level, hold it steady while Boa Hold expands for 2-3 minutes. It will harden within 7 minutes and is fully cured in 30 minutes.

If necessary, more Boa Hold may be added to achieve the desired level during the curing process.

Excess on the top can also be cut away after 5 minutes using a serrated-edge knife. Dirt may be added after product has cured.

SAFETY AND CLEAN UP: Use a soft cloth and mineral spirits to remove any product contents from tools or surface areas before it dries. Avoid direct contact with skin. In case of contact, wash area thoroughly before product dries. If product has dried, apply warm soap, water and hand lotion to area repeatedly. Dried product should peel away after 48-72 hours. For contact with hair, apply hair conditioner; leave in for 12-15 minutes and rinse until product is removed.
