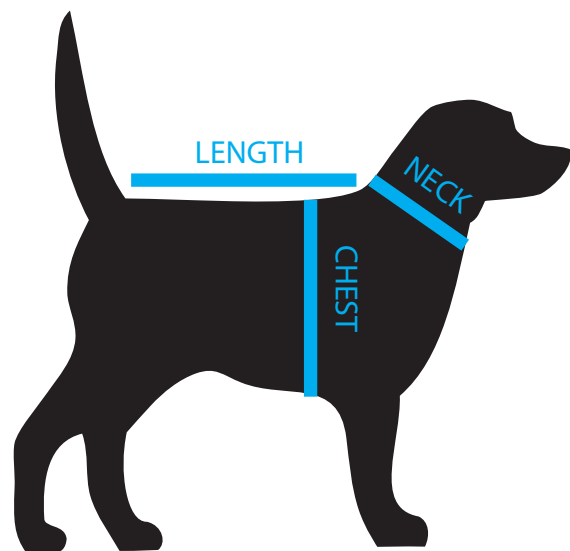


## MEASURING YOUR PET



## APPAREL SIZING

Size	X- SMALL	SMALL	MEDIUM	LARGE	X- LARGE
Length	5" - 9"	10" - 13"	14" - 16"	17" - 19"	20" - 23"
Chest	8" - 14"	15" - 18"	19" - 22"	23" - 25"	26" - 30"
Weight	2 - 6 lbs. (907 g - 2.7 kg)	7 - 12 lbs. (3.7 kg - 5.4 kg)	13 - 20 lbs. (5.8 kg - 9 kg)	21 - 30 lbs. (9.5 kg - 13.6 kg)	31 - 50 lbs. (14 kg - 22.5 kg)

## COLLAR SIZING

Size	SMALL/MEDIUM	LARGE/X-LARGE
Neck	8" - 13"	14" - 22"

### NECK (COLLARS)

Measure around the neck, using an existing collar as a guideline, if possible. As a general guide, you should be able to fit two fingers (flat) easily between the collar and your dog's neck. Remember, a collar shouldn't be tight around your dog's neck, and not too loose, as loose collars can be easily slipped.

### CHEST

Measure the chest at its widest point, all the way around -- typically right behind the front legs. If the dog has a large girth, consider going up a size.

### LENGTH

Measure along the dog's backbone from the base of the neck to the base of the tail. This is where the collar rests to where the tail meets the back/rear-end.

TIP: Use a fabric measuring tape for an accurate measurement. If you don't have one, use a piece of string and measure it against a ruler.
