GENERAL SAFETY RULES

CAUTION: Do not allow persons to operate or assemble this 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer until they have read this manual and have developed a thorough understanding of how the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer works.

WARNING: The warnings, cautions, and instructions discussed in this instruction manual cannot cover all possible conditions or situations that could occur. It must be understood by the operator that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into this product, but must be supplied by the operator.

SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

WORK AREA

- Keep work area clean, free of clutter and well lit. Cluttered and dark work areas can cause accidents.
- Keep children and bystanders away while operating a 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer. Distractions can cause you to lose control, so visitors should remain at a safe distance from the work area.
- **Be alert of your surroundings.** Using a 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer in confined work areas may put you dangerously close to cutting tools and rotating parts.

PERSONAL SAFETY

- **Stay alert,** watch what you are doing and use common sense when using a 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer. Do not use a 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. A moment of inattention while operating may result in serious personal injury.
- **Dress properly.** Do not wear loose clothing, dangling objects, or jewelry. Keep your hair, clothing and gloves away from moving parts. Loose clothes, jewelry or long hair can be caught in moving parts.
- Use safety apparel and equipment. <u>Use safety goggles or safety glasses with side shields</u> which comply with current national standards, or when needed, a face shield. Use a dust mask if working in dusty work conditions. This applies to all persons in the work area. Also use non-skid safety shoes, hardhat, heavy-duty work gloves, dust collection systems, and hearing protection when appropriate.

60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer USE AND CARE

- **Do not modify the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer in any way.** Unauthorized modification may impair the function and/or safety and could affect the life of the equipment. There are specific applications for which the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer was designed.
- Always check for damaged or worn out parts before using the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer. Broken parts will affect the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer operation. Replace or repair damaged or worn parts immediately.
- Use weight trays and fill with water for added weight. DO NOT exceed those limits.
- **Distribute the load evenly.** Uneven loads may cause the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer to tip, resulting in personal injury to the operator or others.
- Use the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer on flat and level surfaces capable of supporting the 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer and its maximum load. Pulling or pushing a load on a slanted or uneven surface can result in loss of control.
- Store idle 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer. When 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer is not in use, store it in a secure place out of the reach of children. Inspect it for good working condition prior to storage and before re-use.

ASSEMBLY

- 1. Secure Connecting Tube (#8) to Main Frame (#1) with Bolt (#20) and Nut (#20-1).
- 2. Install Upright (#2) to Main Frame (#1) with Bolt (#16) and Nut (#16-1).
- 3. Attach Trailer Coupler (#12) to Middle Tube (#3) with Bolt (#17) and Nut (#17-1) first, and then attach Side Tube (#4) to Middle Tube (#3) with Bolt (#18) and Nut (#18-1). Finally, install the whole part to Connecting Tube (#8) with Bolt (#19) and Nut (#19-1), connect Upright (#2) and Middle Tube (#3) with Turn Buckle (#13).
- Secure middle of Trailer Jack (#11) to Upright (#2) with Pin (#24).Connect bottom of Trailer Jack (#11) to H-Frame (#5) with Pin (#24). Also connect H-Frame (#5) with Connecting Tube (#8) by using Bolt (#21) and Nut (#21-1), install Tire (#30) on the H-Frame (#5) with Washer (#28) and R-Pin (#29).
- 5. Connect one end of Side Arm (#9) to Main Frame (#1) with Nut (#15), the other end to V-Drag (#6 and #7) with Bolt (#23) and Nut (#23-1). Install V-Drag (#6 and #7) by using Bolt (#22) and Nut (#22-1). Install the whole part to the middle of Trailer Jack (#11) with 2 ends of Anchors (#27) which are on the Chain (#26).
- 6. Install Spike Teeth (#10) to Main Frame (#1) with Bolt (#25) and Nut (#25-1).


OPERATION

WARNING: Sharp edges on teeth, USE CAUTION.

MAINTENANCE

Maintain your 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer. It is recommended that the general condition
of any 60" Tow-Behind Dirt Pulverizer be examined before it is used. Keep your 60" Tow-Behind
Dirt Pulverizer in good repair by adopting a program of conscientious repair and maintenance. If
any abnormal vibrations or noise occurs, have the problem corrected before further use. Have
necessary repairs made by qualified service personnel.
