Bluetooth Rear View Mirror Quick Start Guide

Getting To know Your Rear View Mirror



Accessories

The following accessories are included in the box: User Manual, Microphone, wiring harness, cable cover



Starting up

The first time you use your rear view mirror, please wait 1 minute as the mirror automatically powers up and searches for previously paired devices.



Connecting to new phone

After the flashing Bluetooth icon disappears, wait 2 minutes to begin the pairing process of your bluetooth device to the rear view mirror.



Connection

Set the password and upon completion, a bluetooth icon will appear on the monitor. This icon signifies that the pairing process is successful. Upon pairing, the monitor will automatically turn off and the rear view mirror bluetooth will be on standby.



Making a call

Using the phone's keypad. Dial number on the keypad or select the contact name from the contact list of your mobile phone. Press "send/call" key on your phone.



Voice dialing

Note: Your device needs to support voice dialing to use this function.

In Standby Mode, quick press the button on the mirror. Once you hear the beep, you may speak the phone number, contact or command to the microphone.



Answer / Reject a Call

When you have an incoming call, quick press the button to answer. To Reject a call, long press the button.



Hanging up

To end a call, quick press the button again.



Bluetooth music

If your phone supports audio through bluetooth, you can play the audio through the rear view mirror speaker. Note: Not all phones properly support this feature.



Backup camera display and manual brightness adjustment

When you reverse the vehicle with a rear view camera, the rear image from the back-up camera will be automatically displayed on the monitor. Once the camera image is displayed, you can manually adjust the monitor's brightness by a short press of the centre button. The brightness can be adjusted from 10 to 100. Once you have reached the desired brightness, wait 5 seconds and the OSD menu will disappear.



Turn on/off video input

When the mirror is in video mode, and no phone is paired, with one short press of the centre button you can switch the active video signal, on or off. While your phone is paired, a short press of the centre button will activate the voice dial mode.



Manual bluetooth connection

You can manually connect your bluetooth device by long pressing the button when your phone is disconnected and the screen is off.



Screen Brightness Adjustment

The LCD screen will automatically adjust its brightness to match the ambient light. In bright settings, the screen brightness will be higher and in low light settings, the LCD will be dimmer.

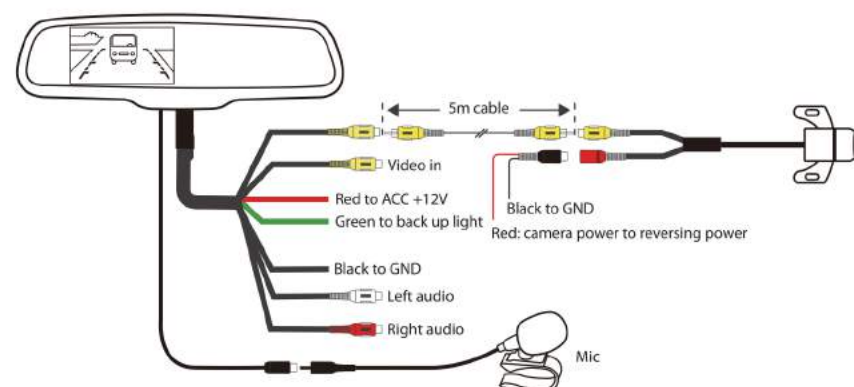


Support
