STEP 1:

Place the body back side up on a clean surface and place the arms in the position shown. (See figure 1)

Use a screwdriver to attach arms as shown. (See figure 2)

Take care to make sure screws to not break through front of skeleton figure.

STEP 2:

Use a screwdriver to unscrew the 2 screws that are fixed to the back holding the ground stake.

Turn the stake to correct position and reattached with 2 screws. (See figure 3)

If you want to use skeleton indoors leave the stake attached in original position or remove completely.
