Like all variegated plants, it will occasionally revert, but it reverts to all black, so will not overgrow the plant. A light crop of red-pink flowers appears in late spring, but the foliage - coupled with an irresistibly neat habit - is the primary reason to grow this beauty! Perfect in containers, landscapes, and as accents!

## **Planting Instructions**

- Water before planting
- Plant in acidic soil with good drainage
- Dig hole 3X the width of pot
- Back-fill and plant 1"-2" above soil level
- Water and add more soil if needed
- Mulch plants
- Fertilize in early spring with a granular or liquid acid fertilizer
