## Assembly Tips

- Avoid over-tightening the hex bolts as this can cause the bolt threads to become stripped and result in less secure part connections.

- Assemble your cat furniture on a flat, level surface.

- In case of frayed fibers on the carpets exposed edges, trim with a pair of scissors to remove.

- Vacuum your cat tree prior to initial use to remove any packaging debris.
