

Thank you for purchasing the ROBORATTLER Remote Control Snake. The RoboRattler is an exciting action toy that requires user participation to properly control the snake. Please read this instruction booklet as it contains valuable information on how to properly use and care for your Snake. Start by ensuring that the snake is fully charged and new batteries have been properly installed in the snake's included wireless "eqg" shaped controller.

Transmitter Batteries Installation

- Use a Phillips head screwdriver to unscrew battery cover at the back of the transmitter. In an counterclockwise direction, open the battery cover (Fig.1).
- 2. Place 3 pcs of AG13/LR44 button batteries according to the polarity (Fig.2).
- 3. Close the battery cover, use the screwdriver to screw it in clockwise direction (Fig.3).



Charging


- 1) First make sure the ON/OFF switch on the bottom side of the Snake's neck (near the head) is set to the "OFF" position (Fig.4).
- 2) Plug the included USB charger into the Charging Socket on the underside of the Snake neck (Fig.5).

Caution: The USB plug fits the charging socket only in one way. Do not force it. WARNING ONLY USE INCLUDED USB CHARGER! DO NOT ATTEMPT TO USE ANY OTHER CHARGER OR WALL ADAPTER OR THIS MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE PRODUCT AND DANGER TO THE OPERATOR!

3) Plug the other side of the USB charger into a standard Computer USB port(Fig.6).


4) The red LED on the USB plug lights up when charging is complete. Note: If the red LED lights up, either the charging is complete or the USB plug is not properly connected.

 The charging process takes approximately 25-35 minutes depending on how low the battery level was before charging.
A full charge will allow for about 30 minutes of playing time depending upon environment and user input.




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RC Snake Diagram




Remote Control Diagram



Frequency Selector:

Note: you can use the frequency channel switch to control up to 3 RC snakes simultaneously in the same space.

- (1). To control more than one snake at the same time, simply set the frequency channel Switch (Fig. 7) to different frequency channels on each egg transmitter (A,B or C)
- (2). Next only turn on ONE SNAKE AND CONTROLLER AT A TIME and svnc the snake to the channel by pushing the (Forward/Pause) button and making sure the snake begins to move. If the snake is moving you have successfully "synced" the snake to the transmitter channel. You may now Pause this snake from moving, but do not turn off the snake or change the the transmitter channel selection or you will lose the connection.
- (3). To add another snake, simply make sure that the new transmitter is on a different channel (A,B or C) and repeat number 2 above. Remember, once you successfully sync a snake to a transmitter you must leave both in the on position while you wait for other players to join. If you turn your snake off you will lose the connection and have to start over again.



Playing with Your Snake

The Egg controller has 2 operation modes: Mode 1: Invisible Leash mode (Red Indicator Light)


Mode 2: Interactive/Pet mode (Green Indicator Light)


Toggle between the two modes by short press the MODE button in the center of the controller.

INVISIBLE LEASH MODE:

In invisible leash mode you magically control the snake just like a pet! Simply point the transmitting led at the front of the controller directly at the head of your snake and follow the snake around! The snake will respond to your commands from up to 10 feet away!

Important: Remember to always point the egg towards the snakes head and to stay within a ten feet range (Fig. 9). If you go out of range, point the egg in a different direction or stop pushing the controls, the snake will go into AUTONOMOUS MODE using its on-board sensors to avoid most obstacles on its way.






INTERACTIVE/PET MODE:

Push the mode button on the snakes controller and use your hand or foot crosses the sensors in its eyes and it will scurry around for 10 seconds and then suddenly stop. The snake will lie there still until something crosses the sensors in its eyes and then it will automatically scurry randomly again and stop! This is a great mode for scaring unsuspecting people and playing with Pets!






Important! Remember to always turn off the On/Off switch on the bottom of the snake when you finish playing to extend battery life.


Basic Controls

(1).Forward/Pause:

Press the Forward/Pause key to make the rattle snake move forward; Then press the Forward/Pause key once again and the rattle snake will pause from moving. (Fig.10)



(2).Turn left:press the turn left key on the transmitter. (Fig.11)



(3).Turn right: press the turn right key on the transmitter. (Fig.12)

Adjusting the Trim

For a more realistic experience, the snake will slither from side to side in a continuous random motion. If the snake tends to drift to the right or left, and you'd prefer to move it in a more straight and forward motion, you may make an adjustment to "trim" or "tune" the snake.

- (1).Turn the snake ON by switching the "ON/OFF" switch on the underside of the snake to the "ON" position. Then set the snake on the floor, belly down.
- (2). Turn ON the Egg shaped transmitter and press the "forward/pause" button once. The snake should begin to slither in a forward direction.
- (3). If the Snake inadvertently drifts to the left or right while in slither mode, you may ENTER the trim mode by holding down both the LEFT and RIGHT direction buttons for 4 seconds. You will see the flashing indicator light on the front of the transmitter change speed and rhythm. This signifies that you are in the "Trim Adjustment Mode".
- (4). To counter balance a left drifting snake press the "RIGHT" turn arrow repeatedly until the snake is moving in a generally straight direction.
- (5). To counter balance a right drifting snake press the "LEFT" turn arrow repeatedly until the snake is moving in a generally straight direction.
- (6). When finished with the Trimming. You can exit the "Trim Adjustment Mode" by pressing and holding the "Forward/Pause" button till the LED indicator on the transmitter stop blinking.

Battery Warnings

RECHARGEABLE BATTERY:

This SNAKE uses an internal Li-ion rechargeable battery and is not replaceable. If the battery no longer stays charged, dispose of it properly according to local disposal requirements. CAUTION: If the rechargeable battery leaks fluid, avoid contact with eyes and dispose the SNAKE according to the local law.

CONTROLLER BATTERIES:

The transmitter requires 3 "AG13/LR44" batteries (included). Please read the important battery safety warnings below.

- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), and rechargeable batteries (Nickel Metal Hydride).
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the item before being charged (if removable).
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Exhausted batteries should be removed immediately and must be recycled or disposed of properly according to state or local government ordinances and regulations.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
