



HORSE FLY TWEETMINT



NO SYNTHETIC OR VOLATILE CHEMICAL COMPOUNDS

Horse Fly TweetMint is an innovative, natural & nontoxic solution to repel and eliminate blood sucking insects and even helps to remove bot eggs. **Horse Fly TweetMint** is versatile as it can also be used as a natural shampoo for both horses and other livestock & farm animals.

Repellent directions: Dilute 2 – 4 oz. of concentrate in 32 oz. spray bottle of water. Spray liberally over the entire body. When applying to the head/face and ears, spray onto a clean mitt or cloth and apply gently. Be careful to avoid getting dilution into the eye.

For added protection spray dilution onto horse droppings, in and around barn, paddock or stable area. Use a **misting system** with TweetMint to easily control pest infestations, while cooling the horses.

Shampoo directions: Use concentrate and shampoo animal as usual. Reapply each time the animal is washed, exposed to heavy rain or sweating.

Modo de Empleo: Diluir 60 – 120 ml. de concentrado en 1 liter. botella de spray de agua. Pulverizar generosamente por todo el cuerpo. Cuando lo aplique en la cabeza/cara y las orejas, rocíe sobre un guante o paño limpio y aplíquelo suavemente. Tenga cuidado de evitar que la dilución entre en el ojo.

Ingredients: purified water, sodium lauryl sulfate, peppermint oil, enzymes, glycerin, soap. Made in the USA

General Use:

Generally, most insects or arachnids can be controlled with 0.5-2 oz (1-4 tbsp) per gallon of water.

However, each pest has a unique IPM strategy for gaining control; due to different harborage points and behaviors. Increase by 0.5 oz until control is achieved. A **misting system** will help greatly to control many pest infestations.

Cattle:

Follow the same repellent and shampoo directions as horses.

Take a cattle rub and soak/apply 1-4 oz per 32 oz water. To reactivate, simply spray with straight water, or a light dilution, if needed.

Swine:

For lice, flies, mange, mites, and other pests, follow the same repellent and shampoo directions as horses. Spray bedding, manure, and other organic matter with 2-4 oz per 32 oz water. Spray infested feed and allow to dry before before, to be more palatable.

Goats & Sheep:

For mange, ticks, sheep scab & keds, wool maggots, bot flies, mites and others, follow the same shampoo and repellent directions as horses. For thicker wool, make sure to wet the wool generously and massage solution in, if needed.

Llamas & Alpacas:

For mites, lice, fleas, ticks, mosquitoes, mange and other pests, follow the same shampoo and repellent directions as horses. For thicker wool, make sure to wet the wool generously and massage solution in, if needed.
