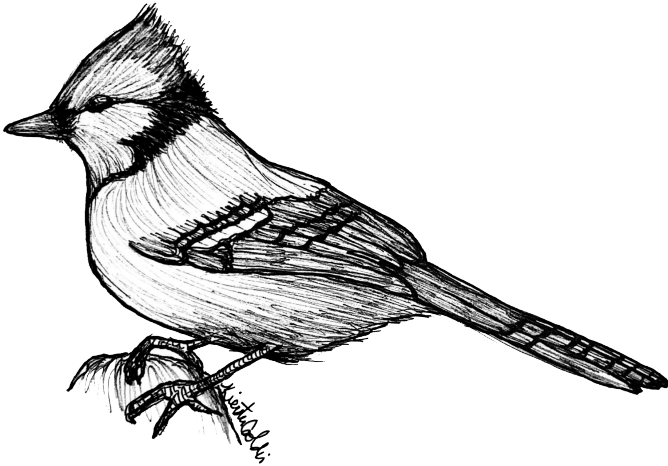


# HANGING BIRD FEEDER TRAY



This hanging bird feeder tray provides a simple and convenient feeding option for a wide variety of different birds, such as doves, crows, juncos, cardinals, and mockingbirds.

The tray's ample size can accommodate large quantities and varieties of food, and the open design of the feeder beckons multiple bird species to visit your yard. This open feeding tray is ideal for seed, suet, or fruit, and the 2.125" tall walls keep the food offerings securely contained. Offer a variety of other treats, such as mealworms, peanut chunks, sunflower kernels, or cracked corn.

A perforated, easily cleaned metal screen provides drainage to the feeder. The perforated metal allows water to run through, helping prevent seed spoilage while keeping the feeder clean and preventing disease among birds. The durable feeder can be easily hung from a branch or hook in your yard to feed a multitude of hungry birds.

A slightly rounded top edge on this frame contrasts the overall square shape of the unit, and dual chains make it easy to place the feeder on a hanger or hook. The fully open design makes quick work of cleaning and refilling, as well as accommodates a significant variety of food for backyard birds.

# MOUNTING YOUR BIRD FEEDER

1. Slip the feeding tray's dual chains over a tree branch or bracket for simple placement. The perforated metal screen will facilitate ample drainage of moisture to prevent seed spoilage.
2. Thoroughly clean the perforated, metal screen when necessary to eliminate accumulated seed and ensure a fresh, nutritional offering.
3. This feeder is constructed of eastern white pine. It will naturally weather to a natural gray color over time to blend in with outdoor surroundings.
