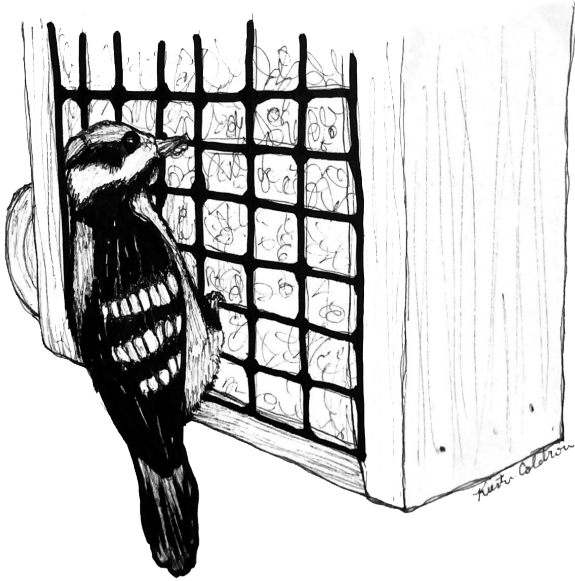


WINDOW SUET FEEDER



A suet or seed cake feeder is a wonderful way to attract a bevy of different birds to your yard for feeding and up close observation. This window suet feeder proves especially helpful to woodpeckers, flickers, and many more feathered friends seeking a suet treat when food is more scarce during winter months.

Place a single suet or seed cake within the unit to offer a nutritious and energy-rich treat to various birds. Peanuts may also be offered as an enticing option. The feeder's roof may be opened via a handy screw, allowing for simple refills and cleaning. A 0.375" square grid keeps the suet treat securely in place, while also lending a wealth of perching spots for hungry birds.

This feeder is designed to be mounted to your window, allowing you an intimate view as you observe the interesting, entertaining antics of feasting birds. Once mounted, the feeder should be scrubbed with hot, soapy water several times during the winter season. Proper maintenance will prevent the spread of disease from bird droppings.

MOUNTING YOUR SUET FEEDER

1. Before mounting, lightly clean the integrated suction cups and the window on which the feeder will be placed. The suction cups should then be very lightly moistened with a small amount of kitchen oil, which will not evaporate.
2. Use the integrated suction cups to mount the feeder to your window for a secure and entertaining display.
3. Place a suet cake or seed cake within the feeder to provide a nutritious meal for birds.
