Wood Duck House Assembly Instructions

Included:

Screws and Latches

Front Panel - Panel with oval entrance hole located near top

Back Panel - Tallest solid panel

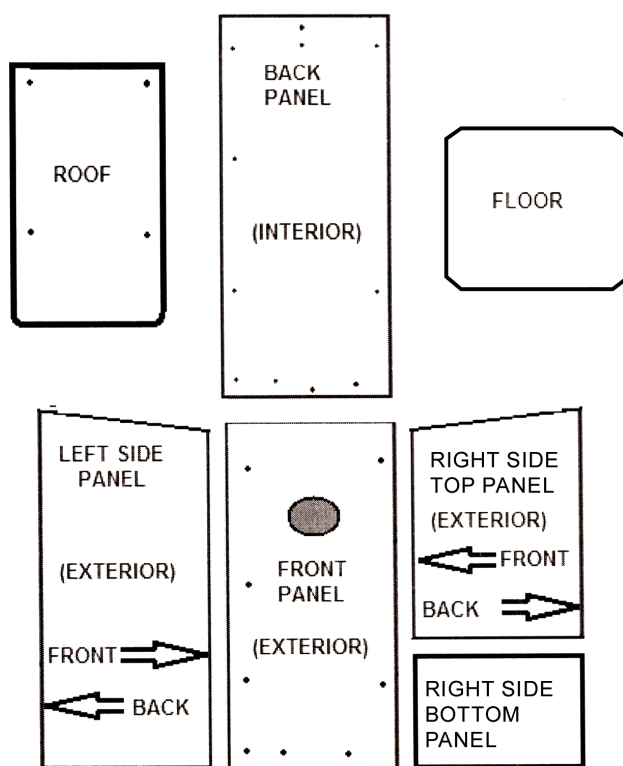
Roof - Large panel with shaped front and four (4) predrilled holes

Floor - Large panel with corners removed

Left Side Panel - Tall panel with downward-angled top edge

Right Side Top Panel - Tall, rectangular slat with angled top and beveled bottom edge

Right Side Bottom Panel - Narrow, rectangular panel with beveled top edge



1. To begin, stand the Left Side Panel on end with the angled edge facing upward.
2. Attach the Front Panel to the Left Side Panel using the included screws and pre-drilled holes. Make sure the edges are flush with each other.
3. Locate the Back Panel and align it with the taller edge of the Left Side Panel.
4. Screw these pieces together using the included screws. Make sure that the hanger bracket is on the outside of the Back Panel.
5. Locate the Right Side Bottom Panel and align it with the right side of the Back Panel. The bevel should be at the top of this panel and sloping down and out.

6. Attach this section with the included screws and pre-drilled screw holes. Repeat this step for the **Right Side Top Panel**.
7. Locate the two (2) **Latches** and install their threaded bases into the **Back Panel** so they latch against the **Right Side Top Panel** and **Right Side Bottom Panel** near the base of each.
8. Lay the house on its left side, open the **Right Side Bottom Panel**, and insert the **Floor**.
9. Attach the **Floor** to the **Left Side Panel**, **Back Panel**, and **Front Panel** using the included screws and pre-drilled holes. Make sure the pre-drilled hole at the center of the **Back Panel** remains exposed, as it is for securing the house to a tree or post.
10. Stand the house upright and attach the **Roof**. The shaped side of the **Roof** goes in the front. Be sure to line the back edge of the **Roof** up with the pre-drilled holes on the **Back Panel**.
11. Secure these pieces together with the included screws.
