- Assembles and disassembles in seconds with no tools.

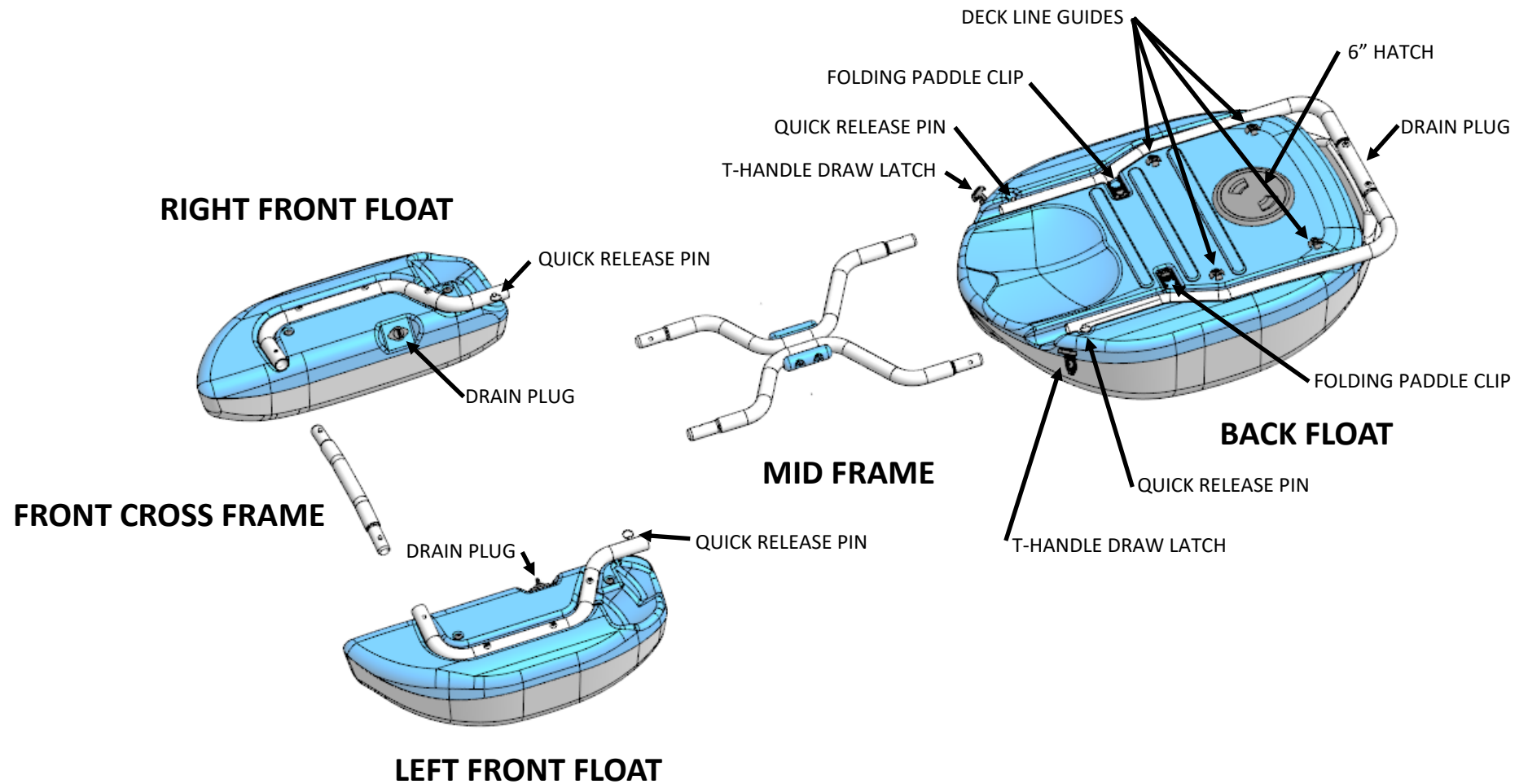

ASSEMBLY

- 1) Unfasten the two T-handle draw latches (fig.1) and open the lid. (fig. 2)
- 2) Unpack the two **FRONT FLOATS** (fig. 3), the **FRONT CROSS FRAME** and the **MID FRAME**, which is snapped to the underside of the lid. Shut the lid and secure with the two T-handle draw latches. (fig. 4)

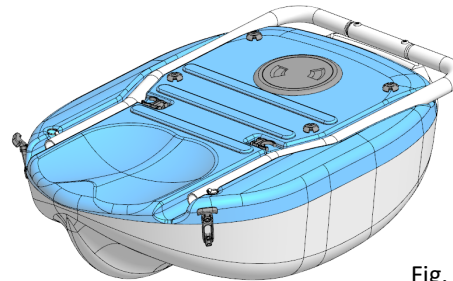

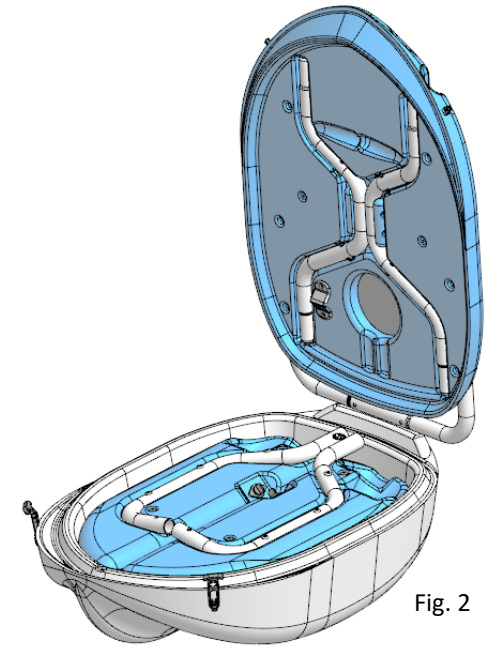

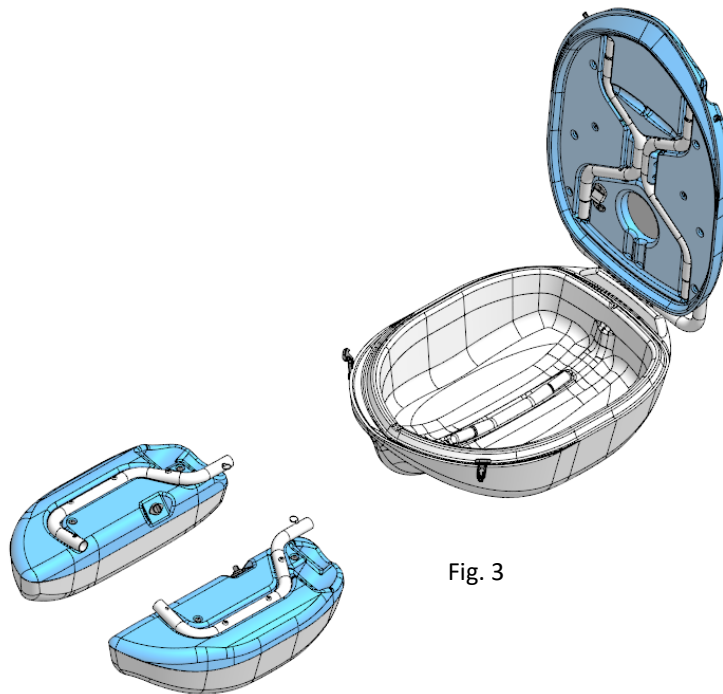

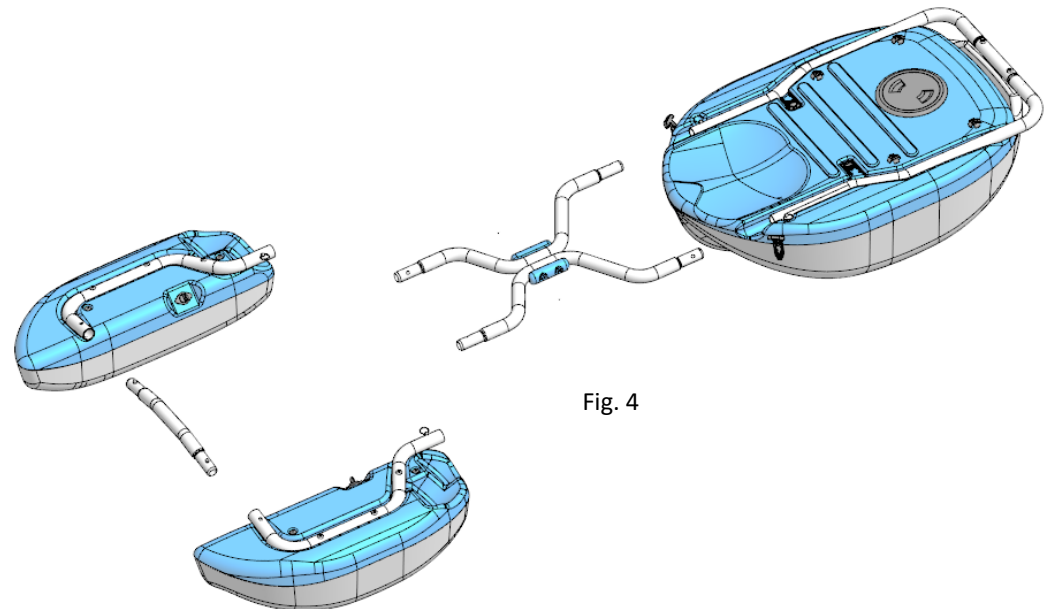

ASSEMBLY

- 3) Use the **FRONT CROSS FRAME** to connect the right and left **FRONT FLOATS** (fig. 5) by inserting the each of the reduced ends of the **FRONT CROSS FRAME** into the front ends of the frames of the **FRONT FLOATS** until it is secured in place by the quick release pins. (fig. 6)

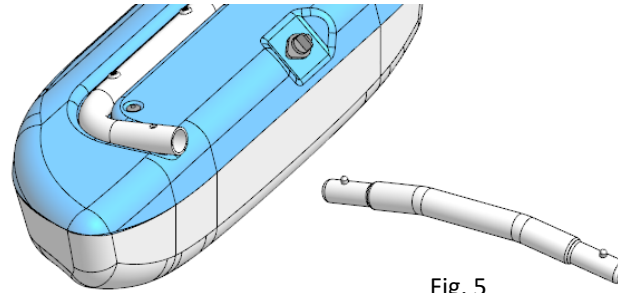

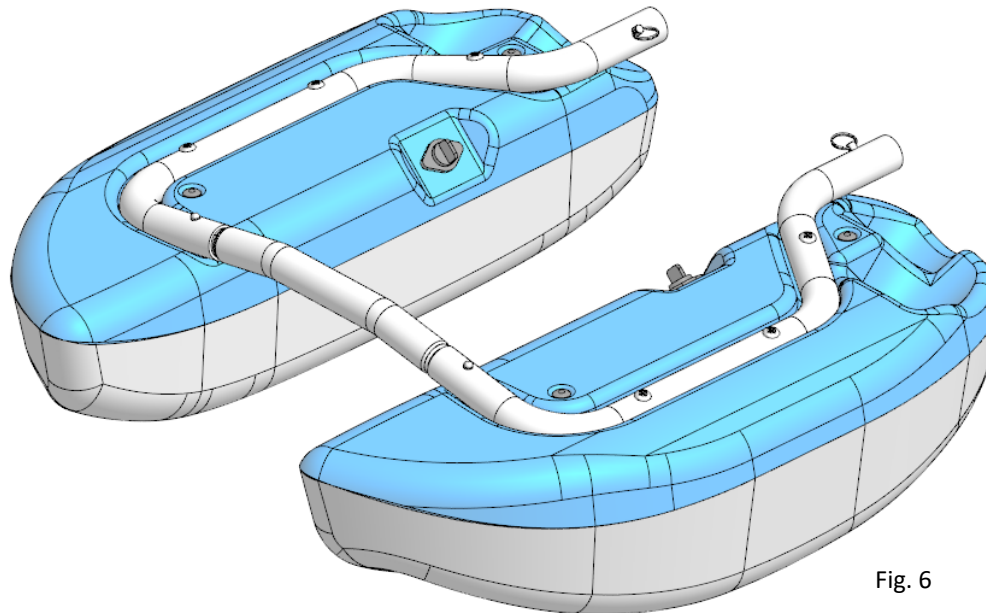
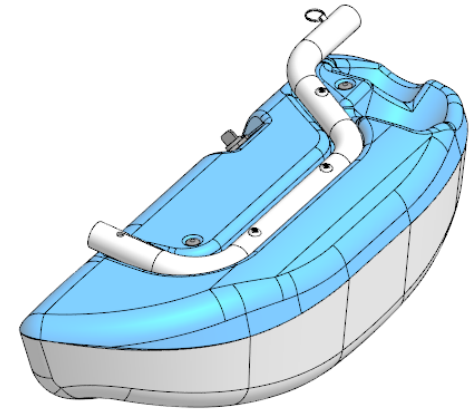

ASSEMBLY

- 4) With the two quick release pins pulled out of the frames of the **BACK FLOAT** (fig. 8), assemble the **MIDFRAME** to the **BACK FLOAT** by inserting the reduced ends of the widest end of the **MIDFRAME** into the frames of the **BACK FLOAT** and secure it with the two quick release pins attached to the **BACK FLOAT**.
- 5) With the two quick release pins pulled out of the frames of the **FRONT FLOATS** (fig. 9), assemble the **MIDFRAME** to the **FRONT FLOATS** by inserting the reduced ends into the frames of the **FRONT FLOATS** and secure it with the two quick release pins attached to the **BACK FLOAT**. (fig.10)

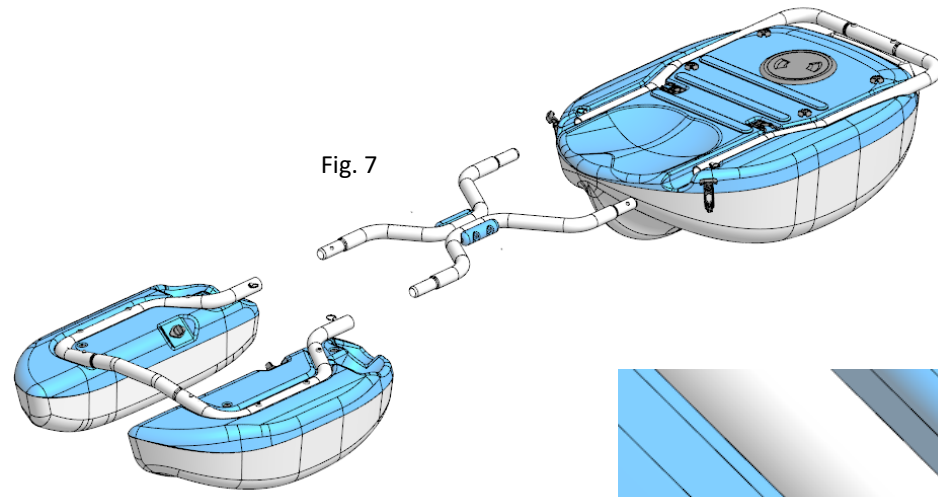

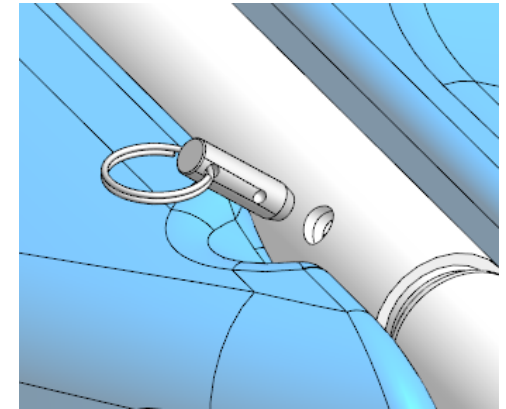

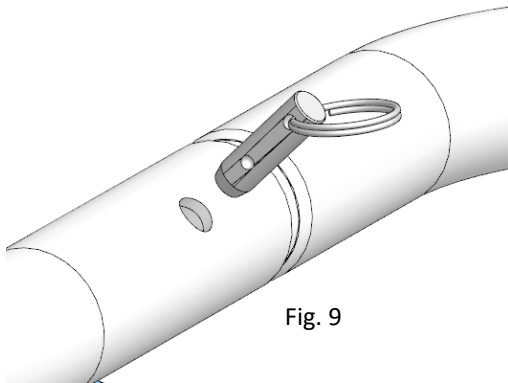

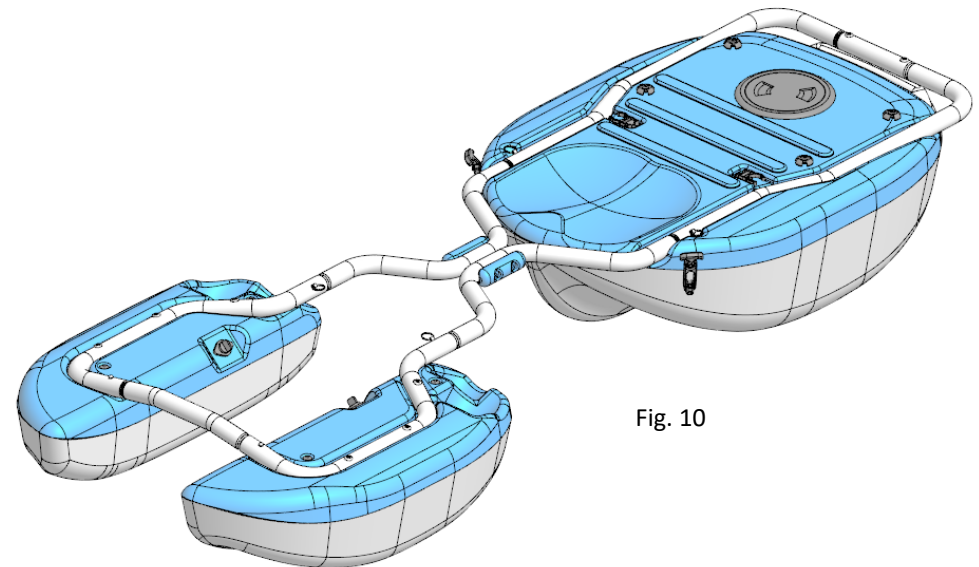


Fig. 10

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
