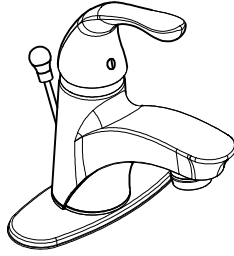

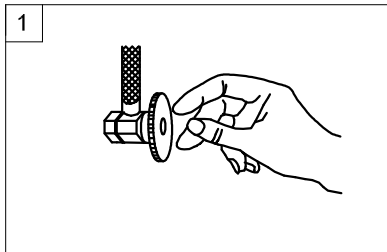

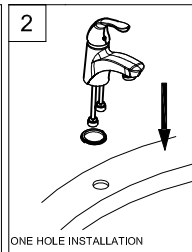
Maintenance:

Your new Lavatory faucet is designed for years of trouble-free performance. Keep it looking new by cleaning it periodically with a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool and harsh chemicals as these will dull the finish and void your warranty.

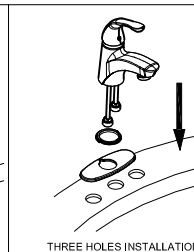
Preparation / Assembly



1. Shut off water supplies. Remove old faucet. Clean sink surface in preparation for new faucet.

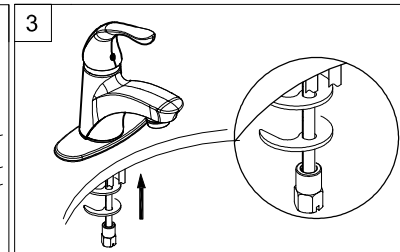


ONE HOLE INSTALLATION

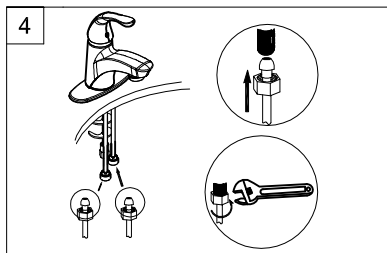


THREE HOLES INSTALLATION

2. Place new faucet through rubber washer for single hole installation. For 3 hole installation, place new faucet through rubber washer and surface plate and base plate and mounting holes in sink. If you need to drill holes, the hole diameter should be 1 1/4". The center of the hole should be 2 1/2" from the edge of the sink.

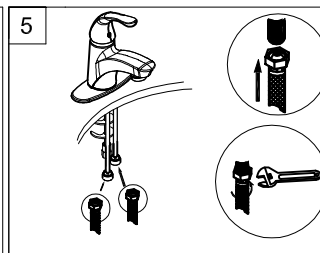


3. From under sink, thread mounting nut onto faucet. Tighten mounting nut.

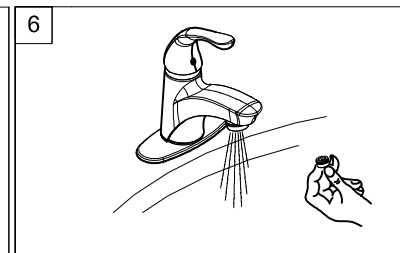


4. Connect water supply lines to faucet. NOTE: The longest water line on the faucet is the hot, the shortest is the cold.

Ball Nose Flexible Supplies: If you are using ball-nose flexible supplies to connect the faucet to water supply lines: Slip coupling nut (not included) behind 3/8" ball-nose of flexible supply tube. Ball nose coupling will go partially into IPS shank or fitting. Tighten coupling nut (DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN). Install opposite end according to manufacturer's instructions for both tubes.

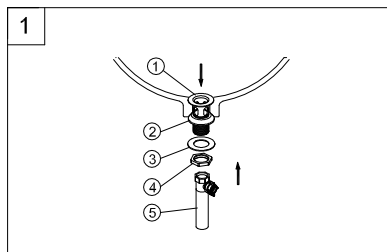


5. Stainless Steel Braided Faucet Supply Tubes: This is the simplest of all installations. If you are using stainless steel braided faucet supply tubes, this faucet requires one end of the supply tube to have a 1/2" female IPS connection. The other end of this supply tube must match the thread on the water supply fittings or shut off valve under your sink. Once you have identified the required tube, carefully follow the manufacturer's installations instructions for each tube.



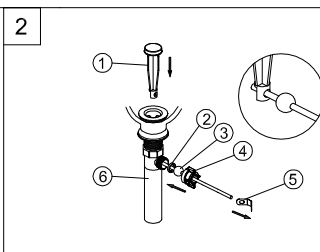
6. Remove AERATOR and turn faucet handle all the way on. Turn on hot and cold water supplies and flush water lines for one minute. Check all connections for leaks again. Re-assemble aerator, but do not overtighten.

Pop up Drain Installation

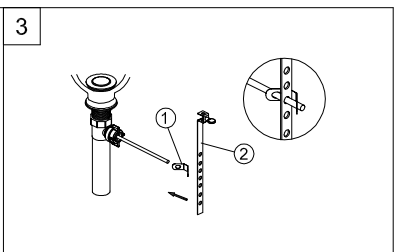


1-1. Remove flange (1), rubber washer (2), steel washer (3) and mounting nut (4) from the pop-up assembly.

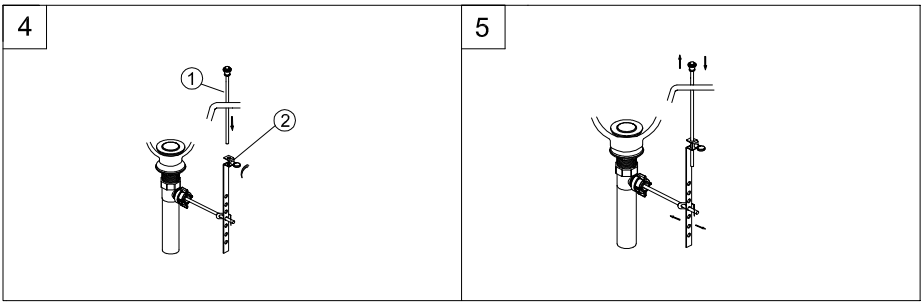
1-2. Put the flange (1) into the sink hole, install the rubber washer (2), steel washer (3) and the mounting nut (4), tighten the mounting nut using wrench, install the pipe body (5).



2. Unscrew the nut (4) from the pipe body (6), retain the white washer (2), then take off the spring clip (5) from the ball rod (3). Insert the stopper (1), insert the ball rod into the side hole of drain, slide the nut on and tighten securely.

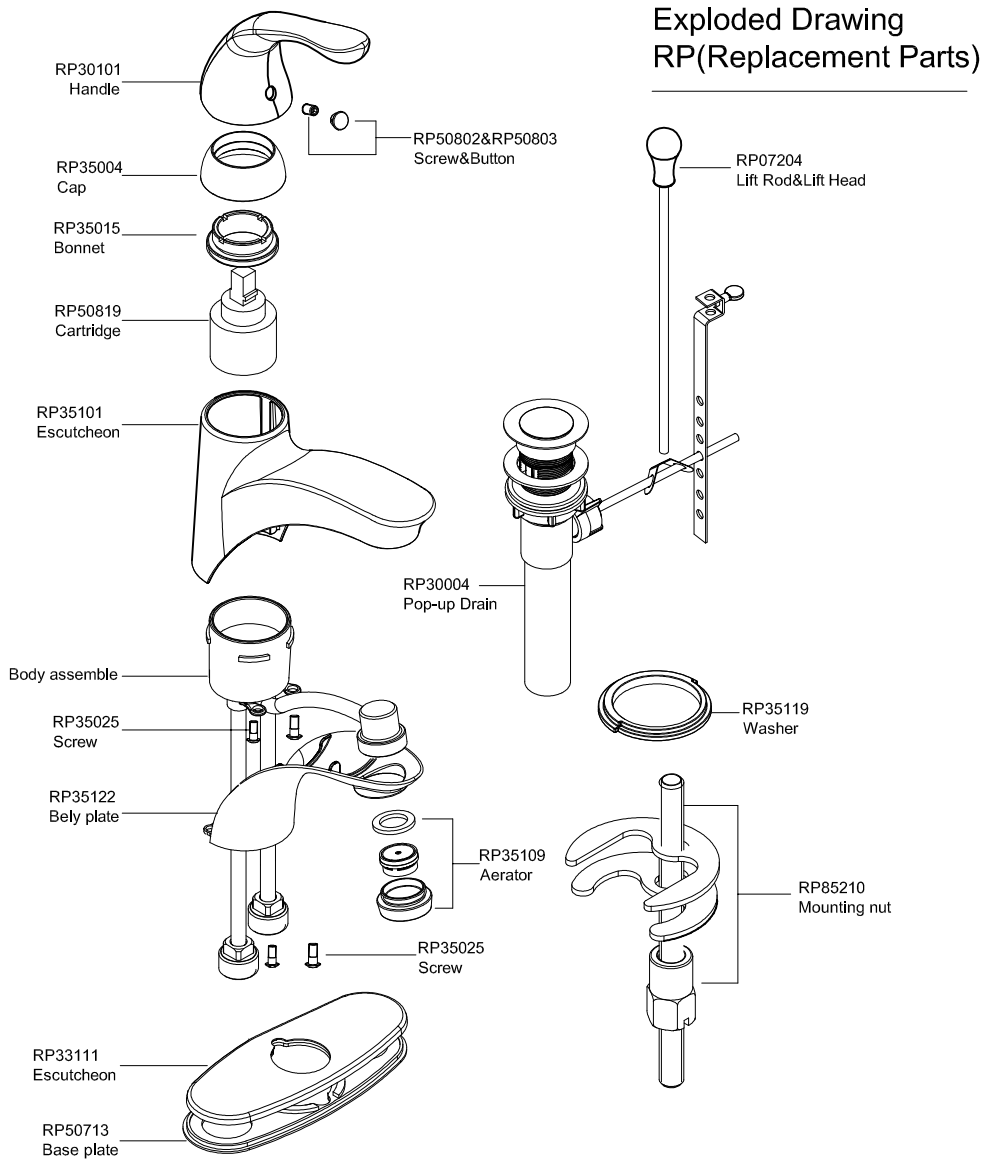


3. Install the spring clip (1) and linker (2) on the ball rod as shown.



4. Insert lift rod (1) into sink hole, through the linker hole. Tighten the lock nut (2).

5. Move the linker along the ball rod, pull the lift rod knob up and down, move the linker at proper location.
