GROWING YOUR OWN CHERRY BLOSSOM TREE FROM SEED!



After pre-soaking your seeds for a day, you're ready to begin. First, remove the clear top cap from your mini-greenhouse, and pour in the bag of soil.





Next, gently add water to your mini-greenhouse until the soil is well-saturated. The soil does not need to be soggy, but does need to be wet through-and-through.





Now, it's time to sow your seeds! Simply pour the seeds into the mini-greenhouse. Then, empty the pouch of perlite (looks like white pebbles) directly over the seeds, and replace top cap.





Next, place your mini-greenhouse into the fridge, and leave it there for 30 DAYS. Time in this cold, damp, dark environment prepares the seeds for germination.



After 30 days, take your kit out of the fridge, and set it near a sunny window or in some other WARM place. This transition from cold to warm environment invites your seeds to wake up and grow!





Now, it's time to play the waiting game, as your seeds prepare to sprout. During this waiting period, make certain your soil remains moist, but not soggy.



Eventually, the warmth your seeds are experiencing will cause them to germinate! When they sprout, remove the top cap of your mini-greenhouse to provide increased ventilation, which helps prevent molds. Move the sprout(s) to a slightly cooler, but still sunny location, keeping the soil just moist.





After some time, your baby tree(s) will outgrow the mini-greenhouse, and you will need to transplant to larger containers. Once adjusted to its new container, gradually work your tree(s) into a sunny outdoor location. Enjoy your tree as it develops, and let its soil dry out inbetween waterings. Fertilize with any high-nitrogen fertilizer, if you'd like.
