


## POULTRY CARRIER CRATE





Place **base** on the floor with holes facing up.

Line up the bottom pegs of the **side wall with door** to the holes located on the **base**.

Make sure the **label area** is positioned correctly. It should be located in the *TOP LEFT corner* of the **side wall with door** facing towards you. The **handle hole** will also be positioned *towards the top*.

Insert the pegs and push down to secure.



Turn the base around to the opposite side and attach the remaining side wall with door to the base.

NOTE:
The label area will remain in the TOP LEFT corner and the handle hole will be towards the top again when faced towards you.

Turn the base around so that you are facing the longer side.

Line up the pegs of the longer side wall over the holes in the base, make sure the longer side wall is ON THE INSIDE of the ledges of the two shorter walls with door, and push down to secure.

DEMEMBED:

ledge

REMEMBER: **LEDGES** *OUTSIDE*. **LONG SIDE WALL** *INSIDE*.



Attach the remaining **longer side wall** to the base.


Remember to place the *longer side* wall ON THE INSIDE of the *ledges* of the shorter *side* walls with door.

REMEMBER: LEDGES OUTSIDE. LONG SIDE WALL INSIDE.



With the holes of the **top** facing downwards, position the holes over the pegs of the side walls and firmly push down to secure.




Push down on all four corners.




Push down on all edges.


Fold the pad in half.



Slide the pad into the carrier crate through any of its side doors.




Unfold the pad inside the carrier crate. \*



\* Another option is to place the pad directly underneath the carrier crate to use as a barrier when stacking crates for transportation. The purpose of the pad is to prevent the floor or chickens below from getting dirty.
