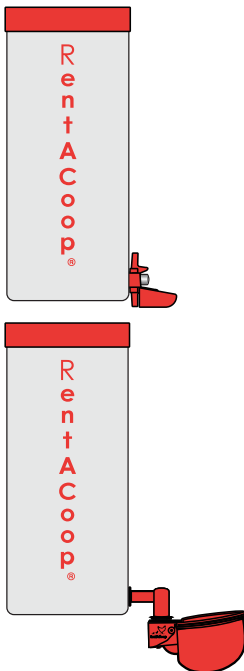

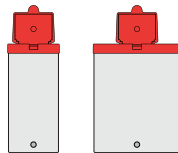

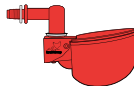
1x 32oz OR 64oz drinker

When introducing a new type of waterer to your animals, completely remove the previous water source and replace it with the new waterer in the same location.

The position of the drinker depends on the height of your animal. **We do not provide an exact measurement as all animal sizes vary. Please use your best judgement when installing.**

## HORIZONTAL NIPPLE

---

### BENEFITS

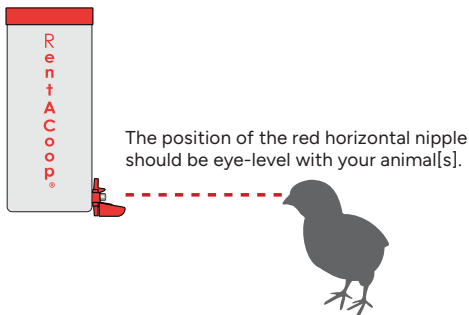
Perfect for use in freezing temperatures when paired with a heating source/waterer deicer\*

Low-maintenance — no dirty water bowls to clean

Training your chickens to use the nipples is easy

*\*Heating source not included and is sold separately. For safety, please follow the directions that come with your heating source/waterer deicer*

*TIP FOR WINTER-USE: We recommend removing the Dribble Dish from horizontal nipple so that water doesn't pool and freeze in it. The dribble dish snaps on and off.*



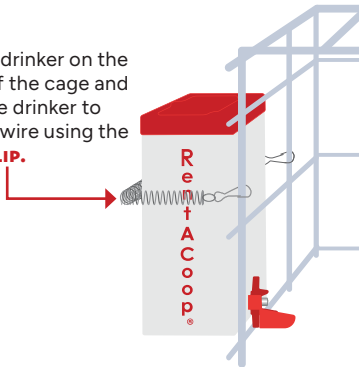
## SETUP

Place the drinker on the outside of the cage and secure the drinker to the cage-wire using the **SPRING CLIP.**

## AUTO-FILL CUP

---

### BENEFITS

Perfect for use in warm weather and non-freezing temperatures

Chickens can dip their wattles in the cups to cool off on hot days

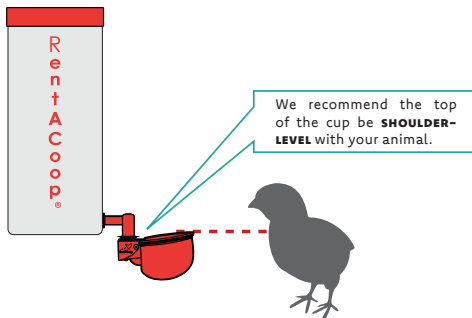
Suitable for cross-beaks

Water is visible to chickens

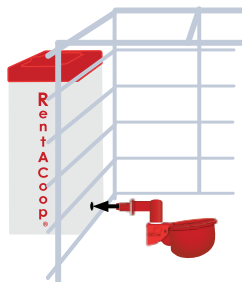
Requires absolutely no training

### SETUP

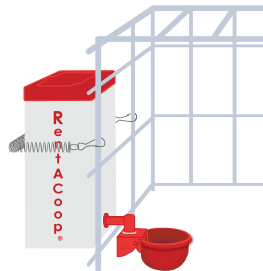
---



1. Hold the **DRINKER** on the outside of the cage and screw the cup into the drinker from the inside.



2. Secure the drinker to the cage-wire using the **SPRING CLIP**.



## MAINTENANCE :

**NOTE:** To prolong the life of your drinker, we recommend washing the entire drinker at least once a week.

**The bottle and lid are dishwasher-safe, top rack only. Disassemble drinker before cleaning.**

### CLEANING THE CUP-INSERT



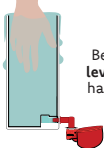
Remove the insert, empty any debris and return the insert back to the cup.

### USING THE EASY-CLEAN PLUG



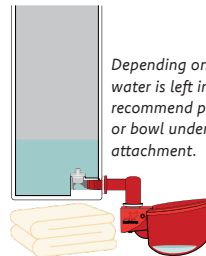
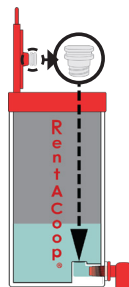
The small silicone plug that is located underneath the lid can be removed and is used to stop the flow of water so that you can easily unscrew, move, and clean your cup without creating a mess.

**ATTENTION!**  
CONTENTS MAY OVERFLOW



Be aware of the **water level** when placing your hand inside the drinker.

1. Remove the **PLUG** from the lid and insert the plug into the hole at the bottom of the inside of the container.



Depending on how much water is left in the cup, we recommend placing a towel or bowl underneath the attachment.

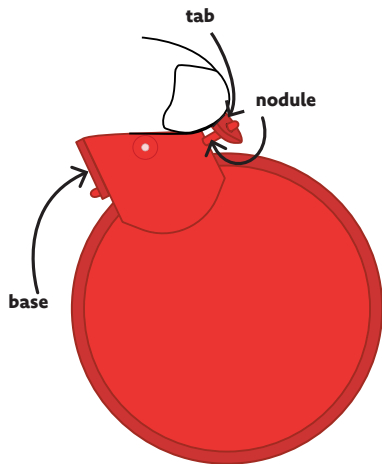
2. Unscrew the drinking attachment by its elbow.



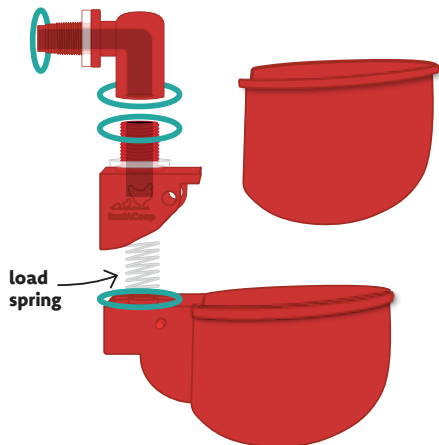
3. After you are done unscrewing, moving, and/or cleaning, re-install the drinking attachment back onto the drinker **before** removing the plug. Return the plug to the lid to store for safe-keeping.

## HOW TO CLEAN THE AUTO-FILL CUP

1. Clean and wipe any dirt or debris from the cup.
2. Pry one side of the tabs on the base to release the small plastic nodule out of its tab. Be careful not to break the nodules off.



3. There is a load-spring so make sure to take the base off slowly. Once you release the first nodule, the second tab will come off easy.
4. Check that all **water spouts** are clean of debris. You can use a toothpick if clogged.
