HOW TO INSTALL

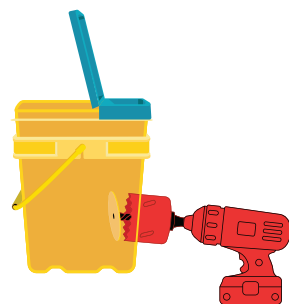
- 1 Find a container you want to use to turn into a feeder. Below are some ideas.



- 2 Place a mark 3" above the bottom of the container and line up the center of the 3" holesaw with the 3" mark.



- 3 Use the 3" holesaw to create a hole for the port



- 4 Clean up all debris inside the container and around the newly cut hole before installing the port.



- 5 Place the port with the gasket* attached into the container and push the port's rainhood back out through the hole.

* The gasket belongs on the inside of the container. The gasket should be in-between the both the port and the container wall.



- 6 Place the locknut around the port's threads on the outside.



- 7 Hold the port upright and twist the locknut onto the threads, turning until tight.
