

## **PACKAGE CONTENTS**

1x port

1x rubber gasket

1x locknut

1x container

1x anti-roost lid

1x spring clip

1x mounting kit: bracket with screws [2]
















## **TOOLS & EQUIPMENT NEEDED**


• drill (only if using mounting kit)

#### Perfect for chickens three days and older up to adult chickens.



#### Appropriate feeder height —

the bottom of the port opening should be at shoulder-level of your smallest chick[en].



#### **SLIDER COVERS FOR FEED PORTS**



Push the slider into the closed position until it clicks in place to restrict access to feed.

We recommend closing it at night to prevent unwanted guest.



Push the slider into the open position to allow access to feed.

## INSTRUCTIONS A

 Insert the port into the container and push the port's rainhood out through the pre-cut hole.



2. Hold the port in its upright position (rectangular hole facing down) and twist the locknut onto the threads at the base of the rainhood, turning until tight.



**3.** Place container in the wire holder and hang on the outside of a cage



 Fill container with feed and cover with anti-roost lid.



## INSTRUCTIONS B

Place container in the wire holder.



Insert the port into the container and push the port's rainhood out through the pre-cut hole.



Hold the port in its upright position (rectangular hole facing down) and twist the locknut onto the threads at the base of the rainhood, turning until tight.



**4.** Fill container with feed and cover with anti-roost lid.

#### **HOW TO CLEAN**

The container, port, locknut, and lid are **dishwasher-safe, top rack only.**Disassemble feeder and separate the rubber gasket from the port before cleaning.
