

# EASY STEPS FOR TURF IMPROVEMENT



## PREPARE HOLES

Mow existing lawn close to the ground and water thoroughly. Dig holes 18" on center, 3" deep.



## FERTILIZE

Apply 1 tsp. of quality slow release fertilizer in each hole. This fertilizer acts like a booster to prime and repair the trouble spot in advance of plugging.



## PLANT PLUGS

Press firmly into the fertilizer primed hole with NO air space around edges. Turf runners should be flush to the ground.



## WATER PLUGS

After area has been plugged and fertilized, water thoroughly to remove air pockets for optimal performance.



## POST PLUG CARE

Thoroughly watering EVERY DAY is the key to plugging success! Keep soil moist at least 6" to 8" deep. Once plugs are rooted (10-20 days), new runners should appear. Decrease watering to twice per week.
