## Van Zyverden's BUTTERCUP/RANUNCULUS DOUBLE BLOOMING MIXED



Buttercups may also be known by their botanical name, "Ranunculus." The multi-petaled type flowering blooms are incredibly vibrant in color and very showy. Lovely cut as well as in bouquets, Ranunculus are easy to grow and are deer resistant. These are an excellent addition to your garden! About This Variety: Early blooming mixture in an array of colors from white, red, gold to orange, yellow, and pink.

Growing Instructions: The plants are not very hardy and may be treated as an annual in colder zones but thrive best in USDA zones 8 to 10. Simply replant new bulbs in colder zones or try to over winter them.

Care Tip: Soak the corms in luke warm water overnight before planting to jump start development. Plant before danger of frost. Plant the corms with the "claws" pointing downward.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 16" tall

Spacing: Plant 4" apart, 3" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones
