## Van Zyverden's ERANTHIS WINTER ACONITE





These native European woodland plants can be grown by anybody and require little skill level. They are among the earliest to flower, produce a bright display, especially when planted in large numbers under shrubs and deciduous trees. It makes for an effective ground cover plant, as it spreads quickly.

About This Variety: Also known as buttercups.

*Growing Instructions:* To prevent the bulbs from drying out, buy them early in the season and plant them as soon as possible.


Care Tip: Planted in moist soil. Do not let the soil dry out. Mulch lightly in winter

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 2-3" tall

Spacing: Plant 2-4" apart, 3" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 4-8
