

WELCOME TO GOSPOUT!

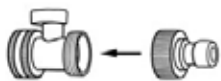
Congratulations on your new GoSpout™, the portable water dispenser that's perfect for outdoor activities such as car camping or a day at the beach. With GoSpout, you can rinse off with clean water no matter where you are. The high-pressure nozzle has five settings, so you can hose down dirty equipment before putting it back in your car.

GoSpout holds up to two gallons of water, and it's easy to fill using your garden hose or a regular spigot. Just a few pumps of the built-in pump cap are all it takes to keep it pressurized. Because GoSpout is made from food grade plastic, it also serves as a handy beverage dispenser. Fill it up with potable water, energy drinks, or any beverage you want – you can even add ice. GoSpout is an outstanding value, and will last for years!

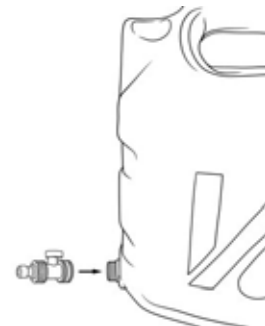
SETUP

Before pressurizing your system, please follow the steps below to get your GoSpout ready for any adventure!

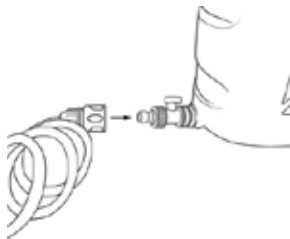
1 Attach the provided female Quick Connect to the brass On/Off valve. Be sure it's tight and the washer is securely fastened to the On/Off valve. The neck of the On/Off valve is on a swivel. For best results, hold the neck of the On/Off valve in place and tighten the Quick Connect.



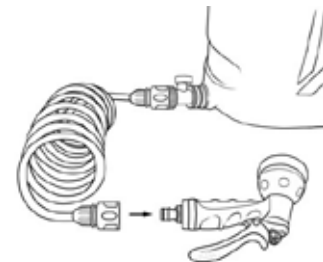
2 Screw on the On/Off valve to the GoSpout's threads. Make sure it's securely fastened.



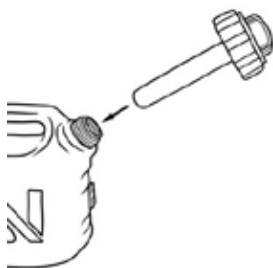
3 Attach the provided 8ft hose. Push in until you hear it click.



4 Attach the nozzle to the provided hose. Push in until you hear it click.



5 Place the pump cap inside your GoSpout and screw the lid until it's securely fastened.



Congratulations! Now you're ready to start filling your GoSpout. Flip over to the other side for instructions to fill your tank.

FILL AND PRESSURIZE YOUR GOSPOUT

MANUAL FILLING

1 To manually fill your GoSpout, add water through the top opening. For best results, leave a slight gap to allow air to build up.



2 Tighten the pump cap and pump the handle to create pressure. Once the pump becomes difficult to press downward, you have reached optimal pressurization. The number of pumps this requires varies depending on how much water is in the tank.

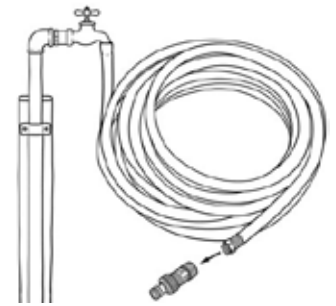


PRO TIPS

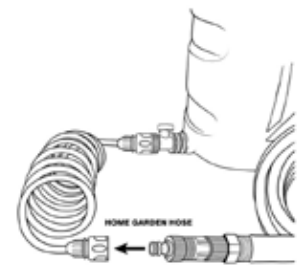
- 1) Make sure your tank is in the upright position when in use
- 2) It is safe to lay the tank on its side (backside)
- 3) Do not allow the water temperature to exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit
- 4) Place your tank in direct sunlight for an extra warm shower at the end of the day
- 5) When disconnecting the hose, pull the nozzle's trigger to release any excess water trapped inside
- 6) To clean your GoSpout, add a few drops of dish soap and hot water, rinse and repeat 1-3 times
- 7) To keep water cold, add ice through the large 2" opening
- 8) Your GoSpout can handle any potable liquid, from water to sports drinks – you now have the ultimate portable liquid dispensing system

SELF-PRESSURIZATION (GL1255)

1 Attach the provided regulator to a hose and screw it on all the way. (You can also attach the regulator directly to the spigot if a garden hose is unavailable)



2 Remove the nozzle from GoSpout's hose and connect the regulator to your garden hose. Turn GoSpout's On/Off valve to the "ON" position and then turn on the hose. It takes approximately 20 seconds to fill



your GoSpout. When GoSpout is full, turn off GoSpout's valve and make sure your hose is completely shut off.

Tip: If you wrap your hand around your GoSpout's hose, you can feel when the water stops flowing. This means your tank is full.

DON'T VOID YOUR WARRANTY



CORRECT



WRONG

Never connect your fill valve directly to the tank. The pressure regulator only works in one direction and must be attached to your HOME GARDEN HOSE (see above). Attaching your REGULATOR to your GoSpout will void your warranty.
