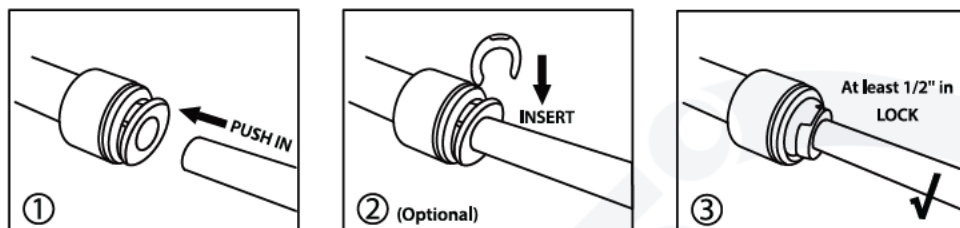
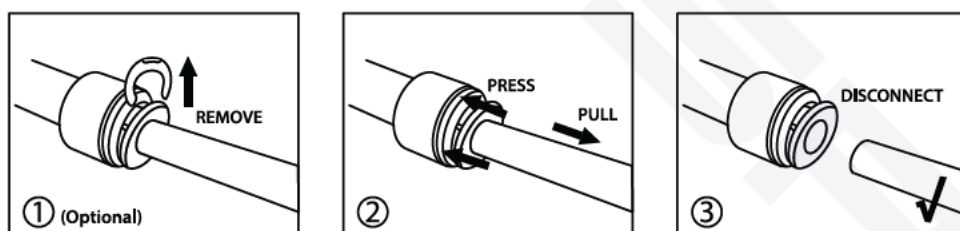

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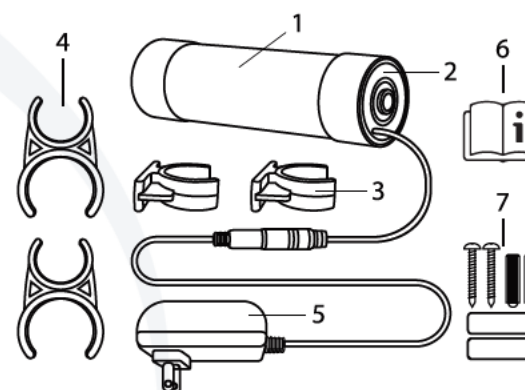

Product Introduction

This kit is designed to be added to any water filtration system with a 1/4" water output. UV-C LED performs the same functions of a conventional mercury-vapor UV lamp but it is more environmentally friendly, much more compact in size, will not transfer heat to water, and has a much longer service life (up to 7000 hours). This kit comes with a flow sensor to turn on the UV light only when water passes by. In most cases, this kit DOES NOT require replacement during the entire service life.

Installation

This kit can be either mounted on the iSpring FT15 and FA15 filters, or any standard size inline post filters on a reverse osmosis system (figure a) or mounted vertically on the back of a cabinet then connected to the filter output with 1/4" tubing (figure b). Mounting is optional since the weight of the kit is minimal.

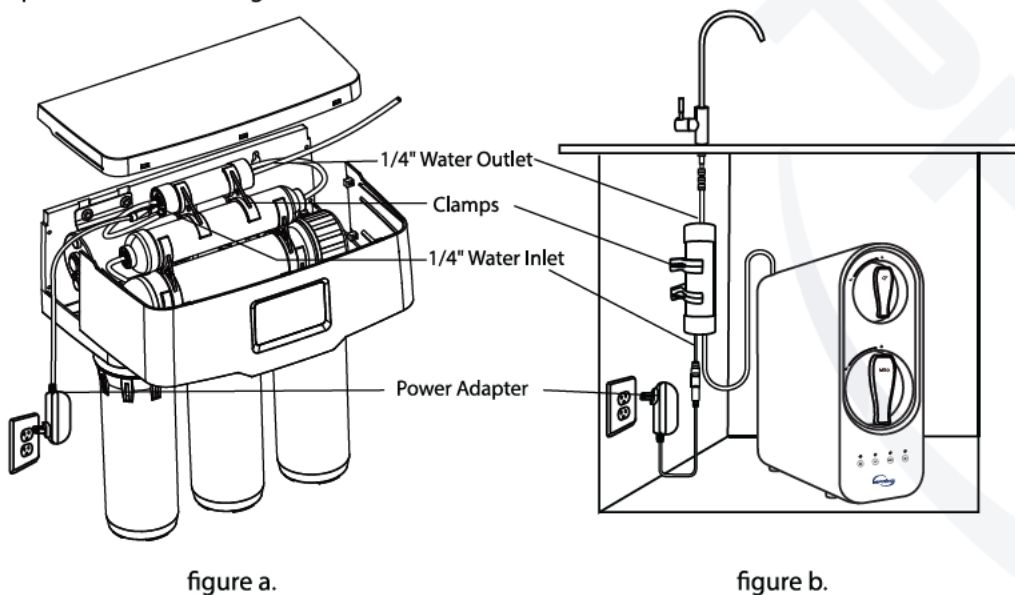


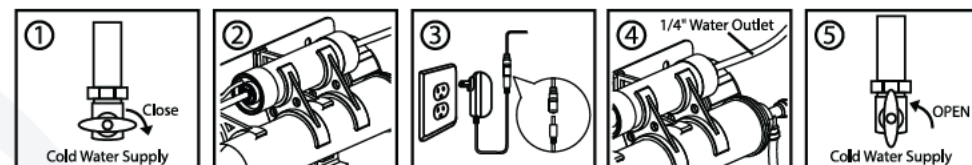

Steps for figure a. :

1. Cut down the water supply and power supply (if applicable) on the water filter which the kit is to be added on. If there is a water tank, turn off the tank ball valve as well.
2. Fit the kit to the clamp the other side of the clamp to the inline post filters of your application.
3. Connect the power wiring and plug the power adapter to the outlet. Connect the water output of the filtration system to the "in" port on the kit.

4. Connect the "out" port to the faucet of the system with a 1/4" tubing. Refer to the "How to Use Quick Fitting" section below.
5. Turn on the water supply. The installation is now completed. The indicator light will turn blue when the water passes the flow sensor and the UV kit started to work. A minimum water flow of 1.5 LPM (0.13 GPM) is required to activate the flow sensor.



Steps for figure b.:

1. Cut down the water supply and power supply (if applicable) on the water filter which the kit is to be added on. If there is a water tank, turn off the tank ball valve as well.
2. Connect the power wiring and plug the power adapter to the outlet.
3. Connect the water output of the filtration system to the "in" port on the kit. Connect the "out" port to the faucet of the system with a 1/4" tubing. Refer to the "How to Use Quick Fitting" section below.
4. Place the kit to the clamp, remove the adhesive on the back of the clamp, then attach the clamp to a desired position.
5. Turn on the water supply. The installation is now completed. The indicator light will turn blue while the UV kit is working.
