## Filter Replacement Instruction

### STEP 1 - Remove the Old Cartridge

- 1.1 Shut off the water supply to the system. Open a nearby faucet to release pressure and drain water. Press the red pressure release button on the top of the filter housing to release system pressure, if equipped. This will make removing the filter housing easier.
- 1.2 Unscrew the housing using the filter housing wrench or a commercially available "strap" type wrench.
- 1.3 Remove the O-ring using a small, clean flat head screwdriver. Try not to remove any of the lubricant. Set it aside in a clean, safe place.
- 1.4 Remove and discard the old filter cartridge.

### STEP 2 - Clean the Housing

- 2.1 While wearing rubber gloves, clean the housing and cap with lukewarm water mixed with 2 tablespoons of household bleach using a sponge or soft cloth. Rinse all parts thoroughly.
- 2.2 Lubricate the O-ring with clean silicone grease if needed. **DO NOT USE PETROLEUM JELLY.** Insert the O-ring in the filter groove and press it into place. Ensure the O-ring is seated correctly.



#### CAUTION:

This step is important to ensure a proper filter seal. Ensure the O-rings are seated properly. If the O-ring appears damaged, stretched, or crimped, it should be replaced.

### STEP 3 - Install the New Cartridge

- 3.1 Unwrap the new filter cartridge and insert it into the housing, ensure they slip over the standpipe in the bottom of the housing.
- 3.2 Use the filter housing wrench to snugly tighten the housing to the cap. **DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN.**
- 3.3 Close any open valves. Turn on the water supply slowly to allow the system to fill with water. Inspect carefully for leaks. If a leak is found, check if O-rings are installed properly.

### STEP 4 - Flush the System

- 4.1 Slowly turn on a few cold water faucets. Allow the water to run until air and carbon have been purged. Water may be cloudy initially as the system needs to clear trapped air, this usually disappears within a few days.

### STEP 5 - Turn off the Faucet and Your System is Ready for Use
