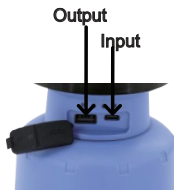

2 FUNCTION

- Rotate to turn on the filament light - filament light reaches 200lm and then cuts to LED light (filament off) and until reach to 500lm.



Output and input mode:
5V2A output, 5V2A input

3 RECHARGEABLE AND POWER BANK FUNCTION

- A) Designed with USB input, equipped a USB cable allows for quick and convenient charging.
- B) Designed with USB output port, can serve as a power bank for smart phone and other devices in emergency.
- C) Blue indicator strobes when charging, 4 blue indicators keep on after fully charged
