

# Instruction Manual ITEM NO: TOY-HDM-GR

# **BATTERY INSTALLATION**


### CONTROLLER:

- 1. Use a Phillips-head screwdriver to remove the screw holding the battery compartment door in place located on the rear of the remote.
- 2. Install 2 x AA batteries according to the polarity diagram located in the battery compartment.
- 3. Close the lid, reinstall the lock screw and tighten.



#### MOTORCYCLE:

- 1. Use a Phillips-head screwdriver to remove the screw holding the battery compartment door in place located on the bottom of the motorcycle.
- 2. Remove the battery cartridge and install 4 x AA batteries according to the polarity diagram located in each battery chamber.
- 3. Reinstall the battery cartridge so the two metal anodes make contact with the springs located in the battery compartment.
- 4. Close the lid, reinstall the lock screw and tighten.



# **OPERATION**

#### DRIVING YOUR MOTORCYCLE

- 1. Slide the power switch located on the bottom of the motorcycle to the ON position.
- 2. Turn on the remote by pressing in the power button located on the center of the remote. A red LED will flash, indicating the remote has successfully paired with the motorcycle.

NOTE: Your vehicle and remote use 2.4 GHz technology, allowing multiple vehicles to be used separately in the same room without interference. To do so, activate and pair one vehicle and one remote and then do the same for each other vehicle/remote sequentially.

#### TROUBLE SHOOTING

If your motorcycle does not work, please check the following:

Check to see if you need new batteries.

Metal railings or other wireless toys/transmitters may cause interference - try playing with your toy in a different location.

#### WARNING

Not suitable for children under 6 years due to detachable parts.

Installation of the battery should ALWAYS be done by an adult.

Keep fingers, hair and loose clothing away from wheels.

Don't pick up while in motion.

Don't put your vehicle or remote control near any source of heat.

Don't operate your vehicle in dangerous places.

Avoid driving on sand and loose gravel.

Don't let the vehicle get wet. Don't run through water or operate in the rain.

If the toy is damaged and any broken parts are exposed, the vehicle should not be used.

Watch for and avoid obstacles.

For best results, operate on hard flat surfaces. Operation on pliable surfaces such as carpeting or rugs may prevent some stunts.

#### BATTERY SAFETY

Do not mix old and new batteries.

Do not swallow batteries.

For best results, use alkaline batteries.

Do not mix Alkaline, Standard (Carbon-Zinc) or Rechargeable (Nickel Cadmium) or (Nickel Metal Hydride) batteries.

Batteries must be recycled or disposed of properly.
