

What does SABRE® Pepper Gel do?

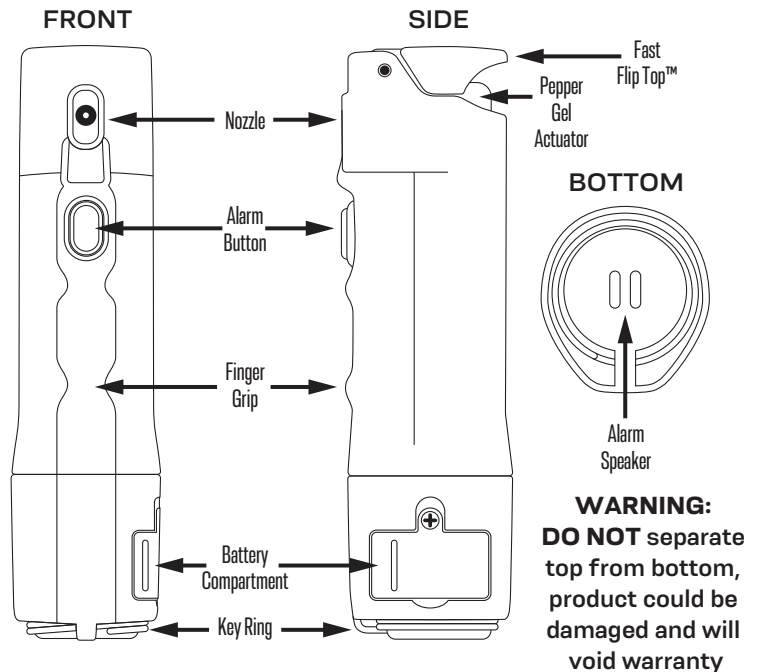

How do I use my SABRE® 2-IN-1 Safety Device?

1. Prior to use, carefully extract the clear plastic pull tab from the battery compartment.
2. Grasp the device ensuring that the index finger is positioned below the alarm button.
3. Slide thumb under the Fast Flip Top™ Safety and apply downward pressure to initiate the gel. Alarm sounds when pepper gel actuator is engaged. Spray from ear to ear across the eyes. A gel stream will reach up to 12-14 ft (3-4 m) in front of you. Shield face when firing into wind. Side step and escape to safety. **To deactivate the alarm, press and hold the alarm button until it stops for approximately 2-3 seconds.**
4. For alarm activation without deploying the pepper gel, press the alarm button twice quickly. **To deactivate the alarm, press and hold the alarm button until it stops for approximately 2-3 seconds.**
5. In instances of prolonged inactivity, it is advisable to assess the device's operational status and, if necessary, replace the batteries at regular intervals of no more than six months.



REPLACING THE BATTERY:

1. Using a #0 Phillips head screwdriver or similar size, turn the screw counterclockwise 3 full rotations to loosen the screw from the battery compartment. Do not fully remove the screw as it can easily be dropped or lost.
2. Gently pull the battery case from the lower alarm compartment by gripping the screw. If the battery compartment does not easily slide out, apply outward pressure to the small notch beneath the battery compartment.

3. Remove four LR44 batteries from the battery compartment.
4. Replace with four new LR44 batteries. Note: battery polarity is molded into the base of the battery compartment. Do not insert batteries backwards.



5. Replace battery component into lower alarm compartment and tighten screw clockwise.
6. Test the alarm to verify alarm operation.
