### **PLANT NEEDS**

**Light Requirement:** Sun

The optimum amount of sun or shade each plant needs to thrive: Full Sun (6+ hours), Part Sun (4-6 hours), Full Shade (up to 4 hours).

**Maintenance Category:** Easy

**Blooms On:** New Wood

**Bloom Time:** Summer

**Hardiness Zones:** 9a, 9b, 10a, 10b, 11a, 11b

**Water Category:** Average

**Uses:** Container, Landscape

**Uses Notes:** Use as the centerpiece of large container designs or incorporate into mixed borders in the landscape. Use as an annual in cold zones or bring inside.

**Maintenance Notes:** For best blooming, fertilize regularly using a low-phosphorous fertilizer. Avoid the use of "bloom booster" fertilizers.

Any well-drained soil will do. Suitable for containers with any bagged potting mix.
