



# HOW TO WINTERIZE YOUR SPRAYER

Prepare the sprayer for end-of-season storage by running antifreeze through the system. This will keep internal parts lubricated, protect against corrosion and keep the unit from freezing.

**Fluids:** For sprayers with 12 volt pump use RV antifreeze. For sprayers with a roller pump use automotive antifreeze.



## 1 DRAIN TANK

Drain the tank of as much liquid as possible.



## 2 NEUTRALIZE TANK

To neutralize chemicals and flush residue use FIMCO Sprayer Tank Neutralizer and Cleaner.



## 3 ADD ANTIFREEZE

12 Volt Pumps add RV Antifreeze. For Roller Pumps add Automotive Antifreeze with Rust Inhibitor.



## 4 RUN SYSTEM

Run your sprayer until you see antifreeze spraying out of all boom nozzles and spray wand.



## 5 STORE SPRAYER

Leave any remaining antifreeze in the sprayer and store until next season.



## 6 NEXT SEASON

Drain the antifreeze, rinse the system with clean water and dispose of the antifreeze. You're ready to spray!
