The long-lasting blooms and impressive flower power make Queen Bee Chastetree a true standout in the garden. Vibrant lavender flowers, which are adored by pollinators, bloom in mid-June and rebloom throughout the summer. With impressive drought, heat, and cold tolerance, Queen Bee matures at 5-6 feet tall and 7-9 feet wide, making it an ideal colorful hedge or focal point in warm climate gardens.

Planting Instructions

- Water before planting
- Plant in Full Sun
- Dig hole 3X the width of pot
- Back-fill and plant 1"-2" above soil level
- Water and add more soil if needed
- Mulch plants
- Fertilize in early spring
