PLANT NEEDS

Light Requirement: Sun; Part shade

Uses Notes: With a low mounded habit, it makes a fabulous low hedge, edging, or container plant.

Maintenance Notes: Prefers moist acidic soils with good drainage and a good layer of shredded bark mulch. Pruning is seldom needed, but may be shaped in late winter. Apply an evergreen fertilizer in spring.
