- Preserves and restores the beauty of cast iron and steel
- Can be buffed to a dark lustrous glow

Recommended Uses

It may be used on cast iron or steel. It may be used on grills, ornamental iron work and fences wherever a lustrous glow is desired. It is especially recommended for preserving heating equipment and barbecue grills stored out of season. Refer to the limitation section of this document.

General Description

This non-flammable stove polish paste is a blend of the highest quality waxes combined with the blackest pigments. It preserves the metal on new stoves and helps prevent rust. If used on old rusty stoves it will renew and re-black the surface and help prevent further deterioration. It prevents deterioration of steel and iron even during extended storage.

Limitations

Liquid Stove & Grill Polish cannot be thinned as it would break the emulsion. Do not apply to painted or enameled surfaces as the polish will not penetrate the paint layer. It will not adhere to sandblasted surfaces; we recommend painting them. Not recommended on areas that would come into contact with food. Do not use on car tires. Do not use on stainless steel or galvanized metal. Do not use outside if temperature is below freezing. Cannot be painted over. Not recommended to use on ceramic.

Product Information

Surface Prep and Application:

Check that the fire is completely extinguished and that all surfaces are cold to the touch. Wear protective gloves to keep hands clean. Remove oil, grease, paint and rust. If cleaning the area with any liquid make sure the surface is completely dry before applying polish. Test on a small inconspicuous place to observe the effect.

Shake bottle thoroughly before using. Apply a liberal amount onto a cold surface. Spread over the surface with a damp cloth or sponge. Let dry about 10-15 minutes or until it looks dry. Buff to the desired luster with a soft dry cloth. When firing the stove for the first time after polishing a stove, ventilate the house, as heated waxes in the polish may emit fumes. Normally this will last 10-15 minutes, but this depends on how heavily the polish was applied.

Clean Up:

Clean polish from skin with hot soapy water or vinegar and water. If polish should drip on mortar, use a wax remover and scrub with a nylon brush.

Coverage:

One bottle should lightly polish an average sized, free standing wood stove or a large grill.
