The table below helps calculate the number of rolls of fence required to enclose various acreage sizes. These are suggested guidelines assuming the square area to be fenced.

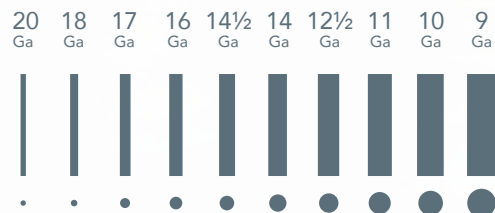

HOW TO GAUGE YOUR FENCE

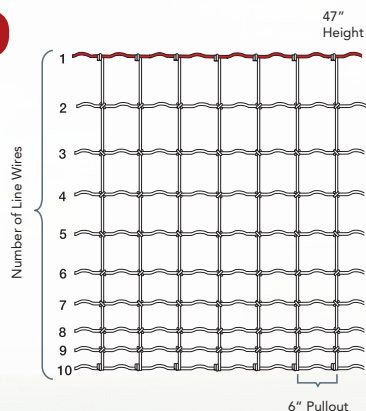
The larger the number, the smaller the wire.

10 #Line wires
47 Height in inches
6 Pullout
12½ Wire gauge

CROSS LOCK® KNOT

The Cross Lock® Knot firmly affixes the fence wires together, providing superior resistance to movement from animal penetration or severe snowstorms.
