VACCINES BY HORSE TYPE



While vaccines are available for many diseases, particular horses may be at increased risk for particular diseases, based on their age, exposure to diseases via travel (or other horses that travel), and breeding status.

For vaccination purposes, horses can be generally grouped into 4 categories: foals, show horses, pasture horses, and broodmares. This table outlines the recommended vaccines for each horse type. To meet the needs of all your customers, ensure you are stocked up on the full range of Zoetis vaccines at all times.
