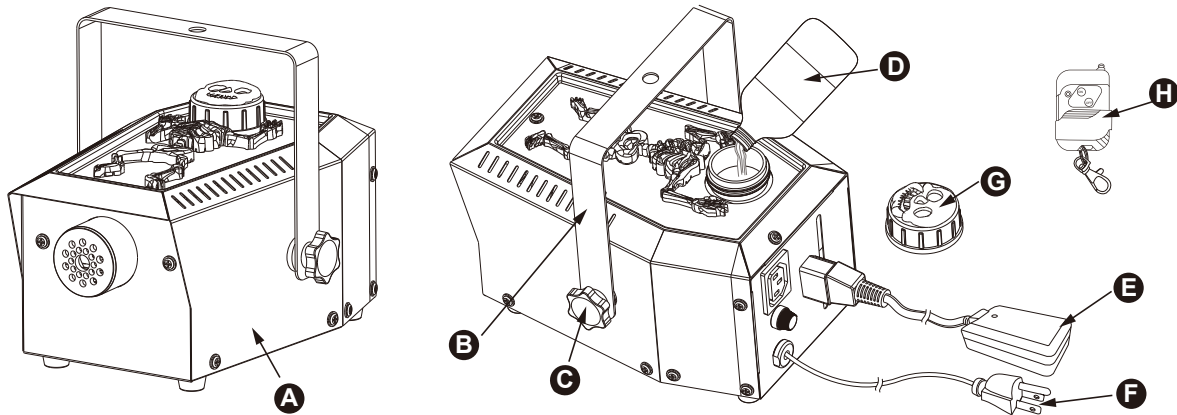

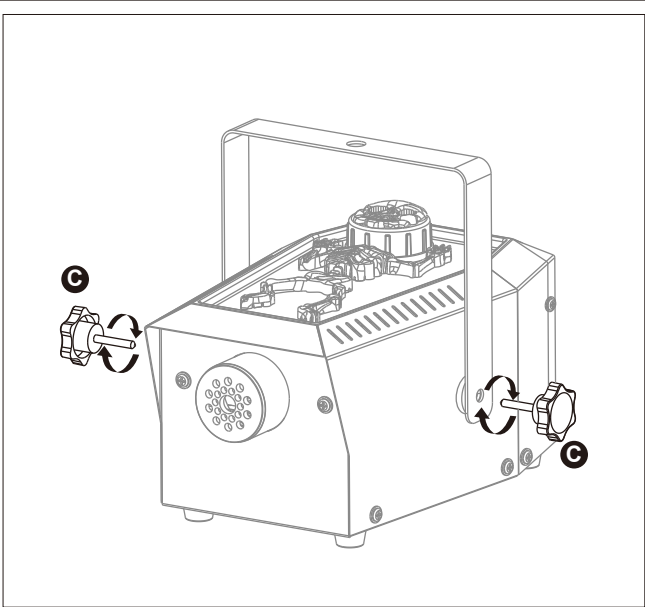
CARE AND STORAGE INSTRUCTIONS

For indoor use only, Don't use it as a toy. Do not operate outdoors. When not in use, store this product in its original packaging. Keep away from heat and moisture. Important safety instruction. Save this instruction sheet for future reference.

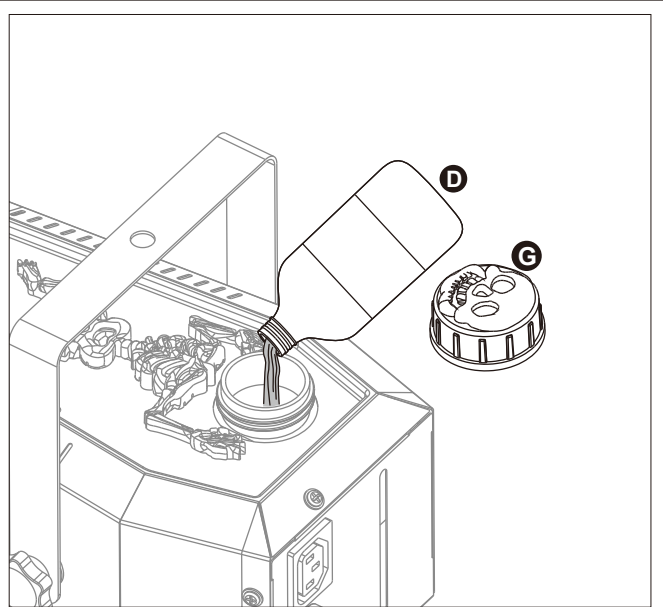
IMPORTANT TIPS:

- The fog machine needs time to warm up before it can produce fog. This may take 3-5 minutes. The fog machine will be ready to produce fog when the light on the (E) Receiver lights up. When filled to the max fill line, the fog machine will run for approximately 90 minutes before running out of fog juice. Refill when fog juice has been depleted.
- To produce fog, when the indicator light on the (E) Receiver is on, locate the (H) Transmitter and push "ON". Fog will flow until the fog machine needs to warm up again. To stop the fog early, press "OFF".
- After each fog blast, the fog machine will need to warm up again. This can take 1-2 minutes. The fog machine will be ready to produce more fog when the light on the (E) Receiver lights up again.
- If you have any broken or missing parts, please contact customer service at customerservice@svichina.com.
- Always make sure there is enough Fog Liquid in the tank before using the fog machine.

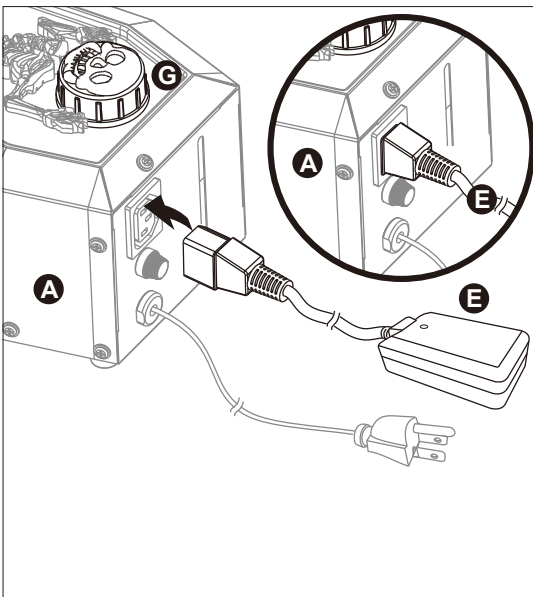
ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



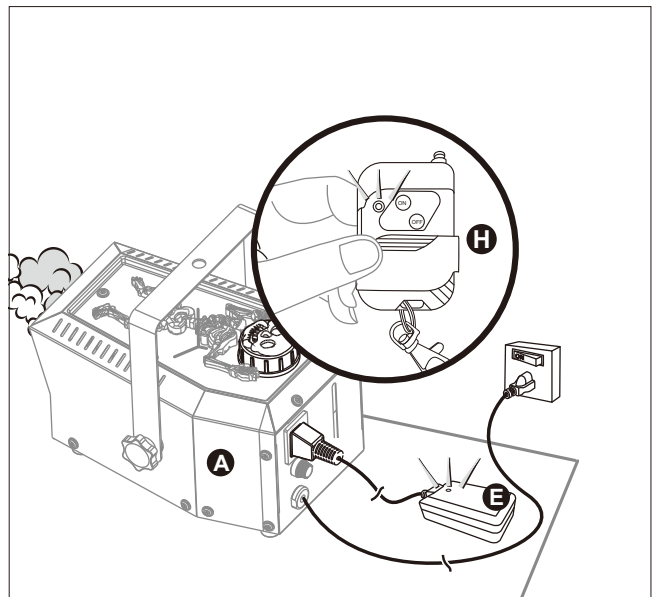
STEP 1
Fasten (C) Handle Screws.



STEP 2
Remove (G) Cap and add fog juice, do not spill or exceed Max fill line.



STEP 3
Replace (G) Cap then plug (E) Receiver into (A) Fog Machine.



STEP 4
Plug (A) Fog Machine into outlet, wait until (E) Receiver lights up, then activate with (H) Transmitter. Press the "ON" button on the (H) Transmitter to activate fog only when the (E) Receiver light is on. When the (H) Transmitter is toggled "ON", the fog will flow until the (E) Receiver light turns off. The light will turn on again in 1-2 minutes after the (A) Fog Machine has warmed up again.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

*Requires 1x23A (12V) Battery (Included)

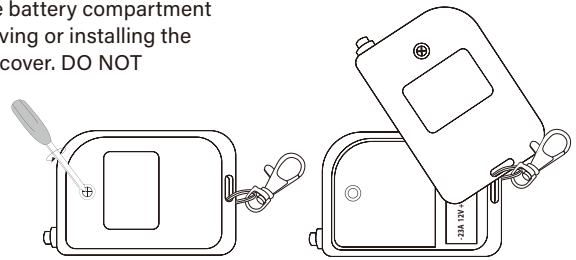
Phillips Head Screwdriver required for assembly (Not Included).

Locate the battery compartment screw on the back of the Transmitter. Remove the battery compartment cover by using a small Phillips Head Screwdriver to unscrew the screw. After removing or installing the battery, place the battery compartment cover into position and secure the battery cover. **DO NOT** overtighten screw.

Battery installation and removal should be performed by an adult.

Use only batteries recommended in the instructions.

- Be mindful to insert batteries with the correct polarity as indicated.
- Remove all exhausted batteries.
- Rechargeable batteries are only to be charged under adult supervision.
- Rechargeable batteries are to be removed from the remote before being charged.
- Non-rechargeable batteries are not to be recharged.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.

- Connect only to a properly grounded outlet.
- Place product on a flat, level **HARD** surface and connect the cord to prevent the product from overturning.
- For use only in covered areas. Keep unit dry, do not expose to rain or moisture.
- Leave enough space for good ventilation. Keep unit cool and away from other objects.
- Use only with Fog Liquid (sold separately).
- Do not operate unit without Fog Liquid.
- Pour Fog Liquid carefully to avoid spills which could result in electric shock. Do not use if liquid spills onto unit. Let unit dry completely before plugging in.
- Do not overfill the liquid.
- Keep away from flames and flammable/explosive substances to avoid fire or explosions. Never pour flammable liquids such as gas, perfume etc. into the fog machine.
- Keep product and Fog Liquid out of reach of children. Use only under adult supervision.
- Do not spray in the direction of flames or people. Stay at least 20 inches (50cm) from the nozzle at the front of the unit.

- Do not obstruct the nozzle.
- Do not open unit. No user serviceable parts inside, please refer to your vendor. Only an electrician can change the power cord.
- Clean unit before storage to avoid damages.

CAUTION

- Risk of burn, fire or electric shock.
- Please read instruction manual before using.
- Don't immerse in liquid.
- Not for space heating purposes.
- Changes or modifications not expressly approved by the party responsible for compliance could void user's authority to operate the equipment.

FUSE REPLACEMENT

If the Fog Machine does not work at all when it is connected to the power socket, then it is probably that the fuse has been broken.

- Risk of electric shock and fire. Disconnect from power socket before replacing the fuse.
- Turn the fuse knob counterclockwise to reveal the fuse.
- Replace the fuse with the same size and type fuse: 5A, 125V
- Place fuse in cover and reinstall by turning clockwise. Be sure not to over tighten.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- (a) It is normal for condensation to appear on the nozzle of the Fog Machine.
- (b) A small amount of fog may spray during or after operation.

MAINTENANCE & SERVICING

Use of fog liquids other than Fog Liquid are not recommended and may result in blockage, leakage, or other damage to the unit.

INSPECTION

Before each use, check unit for any cracks in the enclosure, remote control, cords, and plugs. Make sure there are no exposed wires. Do not use if any of the above conditions are found.

CLEANING

Should you experience low fog output after many hours of continuous operation or after the machine has been idle or in storage for a long time, it is recommended to run a cleaning solution through the system to prevent the accumulation of particles in the heating element.

- (a) While the unit is unplugged and cool, empty all Fog Liquid from the machine and replace with a fog machine cleaning solution in the tank. Fog Machine Cleaning Fluid (not included) is recommended. Plug unit in and allow to warm as usual.
- (b) Run unit in a well-ventilated area until tank is empty.
- (c) Cleaning is now complete. All fog machines are prone to clogging due to the consistency of Fog Liquid and the high temperatures at which it vaporizes. However, a well-maintained machine should provide years of reliable use.

STORAGE

It is important to remove all fluid from the unit when storing for an extended period of time.

1. When the unit is unplugged and cool, empty all Fog Liquid from the machine. Plug in unit and allow to warm as usual.
2. Before storage, it is recommended to follow the CLEANING procedure available in this instruction sheet.
3. Run unit in a well-ventilated area for 10-seconds to confirm tank is empty and dry.
4. Store on a flat, level surface. Keep in a well-ventilated, cool and dry location.

For best performance, operate unit for 10-minutes every 3 months. Follow the Operation Instructions and Storage instructions accordingly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Correction
Fog machine will not produce fog	· Ensure there is sufficient Fog Liquid in the tank. · Ensure the fog machine is plugged into a working outlet. · Ensure the fog machine has been given 3-5 minutes to heat up. · Ensure the light on the transmitter turns on when pressing the buttons. If not, try replacing the batteries. · Ensure the fuse is not blown. Follow instruction under Fuse Replacement section of manual. · Ensure you are standing close enough to the fog machine for the receiver to pick up the signal from the transmitter (remote).
Fog machine will not produce constant fog, it stops and starts	This is how the fog machine is supposed to work. You will need to wait for the machine to reheat between fog bursts. You can purchase a fog machine timer (sold separately) which will enable you to not have to press the button on the remote each time. However, the fog machine will still need to reheat between each burst of fog.
Fog output is low	· Try cleaning the machine (details in "Cleaning" section). · Ensure there is sufficient Fog Liquid in the tank.

For a period of one (1) year after purchase, Haunted Hill Farm ("Manufacturer") will either repair or replace defective components in accordance with this Limited Warranty.

Sales and use taxes, plus shipping and handling charges are the responsibility of the consumer.

This warranty is between Manufacturer and the original purchaser and is valid only when accompanied by the original purchaser's sales receipt showing original date of purchase and location of purchase. Replacements under this warranty revert back to the date of original purchase for future warranty.

Manufacturer or its authorized dealer can accept or reject warranty claims based on its findings. This warranty applies in normal residential use only, where an issue with the product is due to a defect in material or workmanship. Manufacturer can make substitutions as required of materials, components, and sub-components of comparable value and utility. This warranty is limited to product repair or replacement (to be determined solely by Manufacturer). Warranty return is limited to only the single affected component.
