WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRICAL SHOCK OR PERSONAL INJURY:

- Do not use with extension cord near water or where water may accumulate. Keep worklight at least 16 feet from pools and spas. Keep plugs and receptacles dry. Use only three wire outdoor extension cords with grounded plugs and grounded receptacles.
- Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protection should be provided on the circuit(s) or outlet(s) to be used for this worklight in wet locations. Receptacles are available having the built-in GFCI protection and are to be used for this measure of safety.
- Use only with an extension cord for outdoor use, such as an extension cord marked with cord type: SW, SW-A, SOW, SOW-A, STW, STW-A, STOW, STOW-A, SJW, SJW-A, SJOW, SJOW-A, SJTW, SJTW-A or SJTOW, SJTOW-A.
- Do not look directly at the lighted lamps to avoid eye injuries.
- Always keep the worklight away from any flammable surface or materials.
- Always check for damage or worn-out parts before using the worklight. Broken parts will affect the worklight operation. Replace or repair damaged or worn parts immediately. If repairs are needed, consult a professional electrician.
- Do not use a pressure washer to clean this product.

- Store the worklight in a secure place out of reach of children. Inspect the worklight for good working condition prior to storage and before each use.

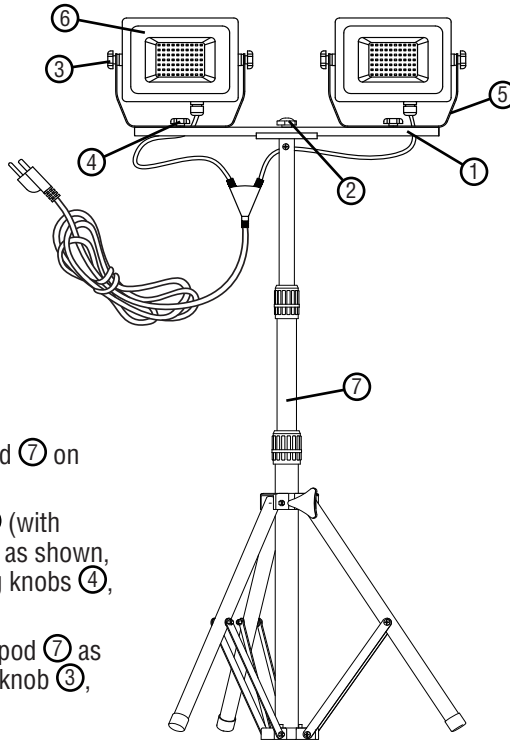

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

WORKLIGHT PARTS

1. Cross Bar
2. Cross Bar Knob
3. Tilt Locking Knobs
4. Pivot Locking Knobs
5. U-shaped Brackets
6. Worklights
7. Tripod



ATTACHING WORKLIGHTS TO CROSSBAR & TRIPOD

1. Extend the legs and place the tripod (7) on a flat surface.
2. Position the U-shaped brackets (5) (with worklights (6)) on the cross bar (1) as shown, and secure using two pivot locking knobs (4), washers and lock washers.
3. Place the crossbar (1) on top of tripod (7) as shown, and secure with cross bar knob (2), washer and lock washer.

OPERATION

ADJUSTING THE WORKLIGHT DIRECTION

1. To tilt a worklight, loosen the tilt locking knobs and tilt the worklight up or down.
2. To pivot a worklight, loosen the pivot locking knob and pivot the worklight left or right.

ON - OFF SWITCH

Remove protective cap before use. Your worklights are equipped with plunger switches on the back side of each worklight.

MAINTENANCE

Clean the lens and stand regularly with a non-abrasive cleaner.

- ⚠ WARNING:** Always make sure the worklight is unplugged and completely cool before attempting to clean.
