PLANT NEEDS

Light Requirement: Full Shade; Part Shade; Sun

Uses Notes: Looks handsome in practically any landscape role! Use as edging, en masse in the border, strategically placed singular plantings, and in containers.

Maintenance Notes: Prefers moist, well-drained soil. It will not do well in acidic pH or compacted sites. Fertilize with a controlled release fertilizer in spring. Pruning is seldom needed but may be trimmed in summer.
