Please read instruction manual carefully before use

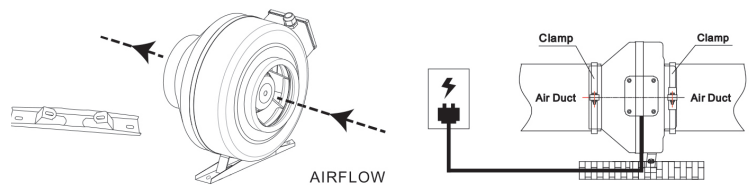
Notes:

- This specification describes how to install, use and clean the fan correctly which will ensure good performance and prolong the life of the fan.
- Remove the fan from the carton and check the fan's appearance and properties for any damage or deformations.
- Ensure that the power and frequency is compatible with rated power frequency.
- Turn off the power before fan maintenance and cleaning. Turn off the power before moving the fan.
- Do not expose this fan to elements (sunshine, rain, snow, etc.)
- Check fan routinely for maintenance.
- Do not clean the parts or components of the fan with liquids.
- To prevent fire, keep away from alcohol, gasoline, or combustibles.
- Keep away from children or unskilled users to ensure safety.

Installation Instructions:

- When installing or moving fan, wear gloves or similar protective measures.
- Install away from the main switch with fan switch in off position.
- Remove all packaging material.
- Check airflow direction indicated.

- Attach mounting bracket on the fan.
- Plug into a power source.



Maintenance and Cleaning:

- The motor and rotor must be periodically inspected every six months.
- Open the junction box cover and turn off the power to clean and repair blower. After cleaning, please confirm the integrity of the fan to ensure all parts are re-installed.
