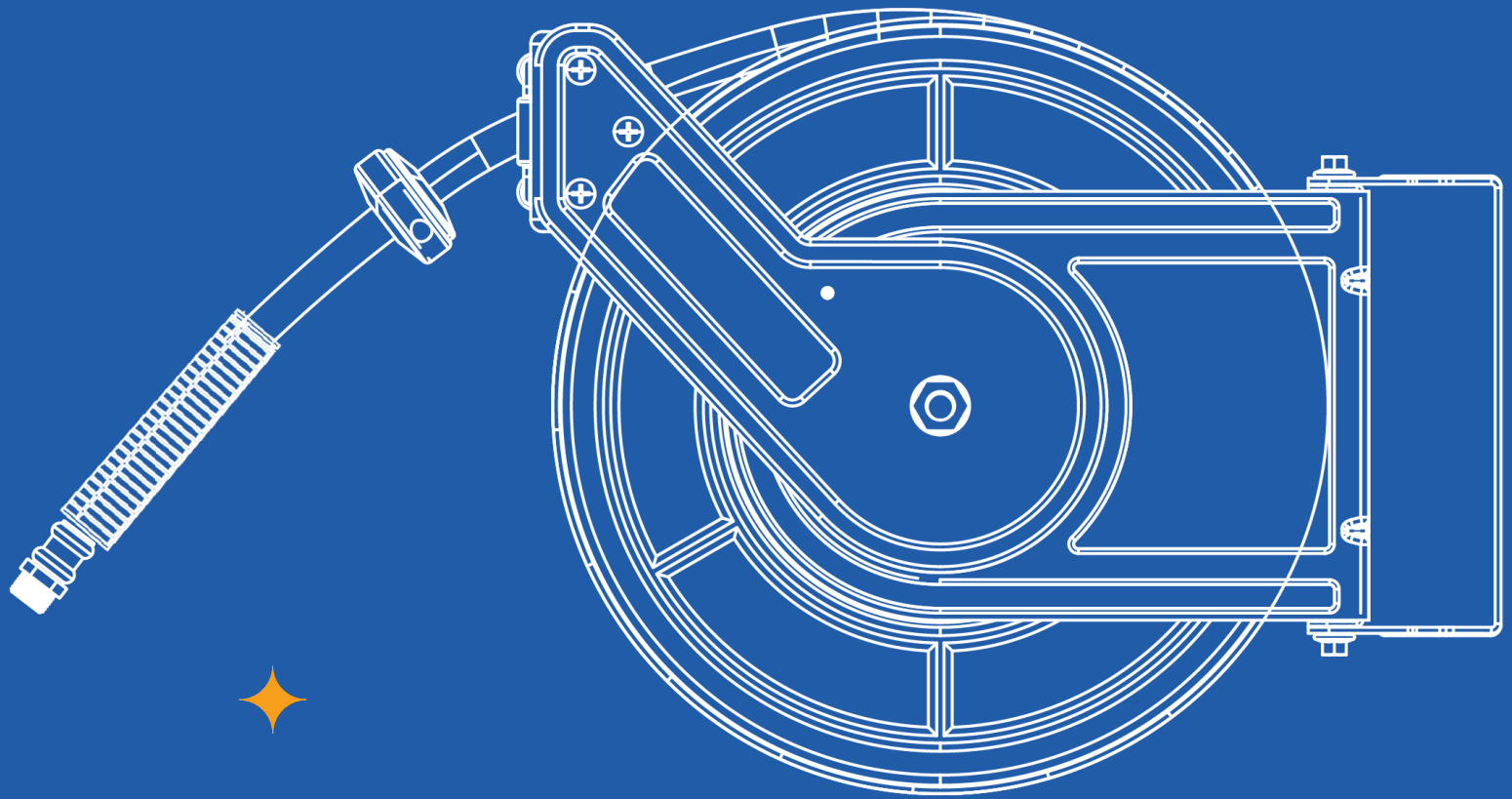

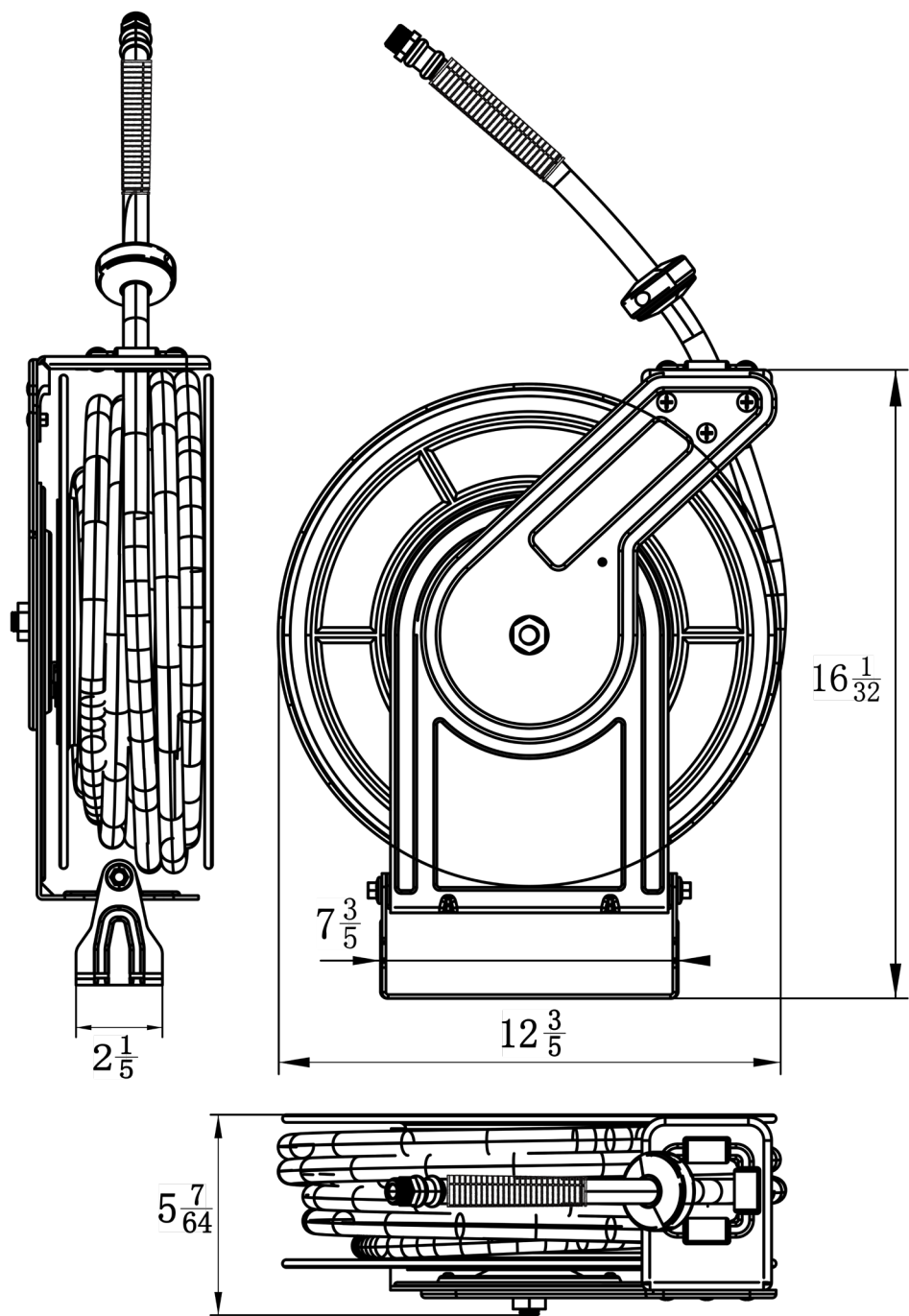

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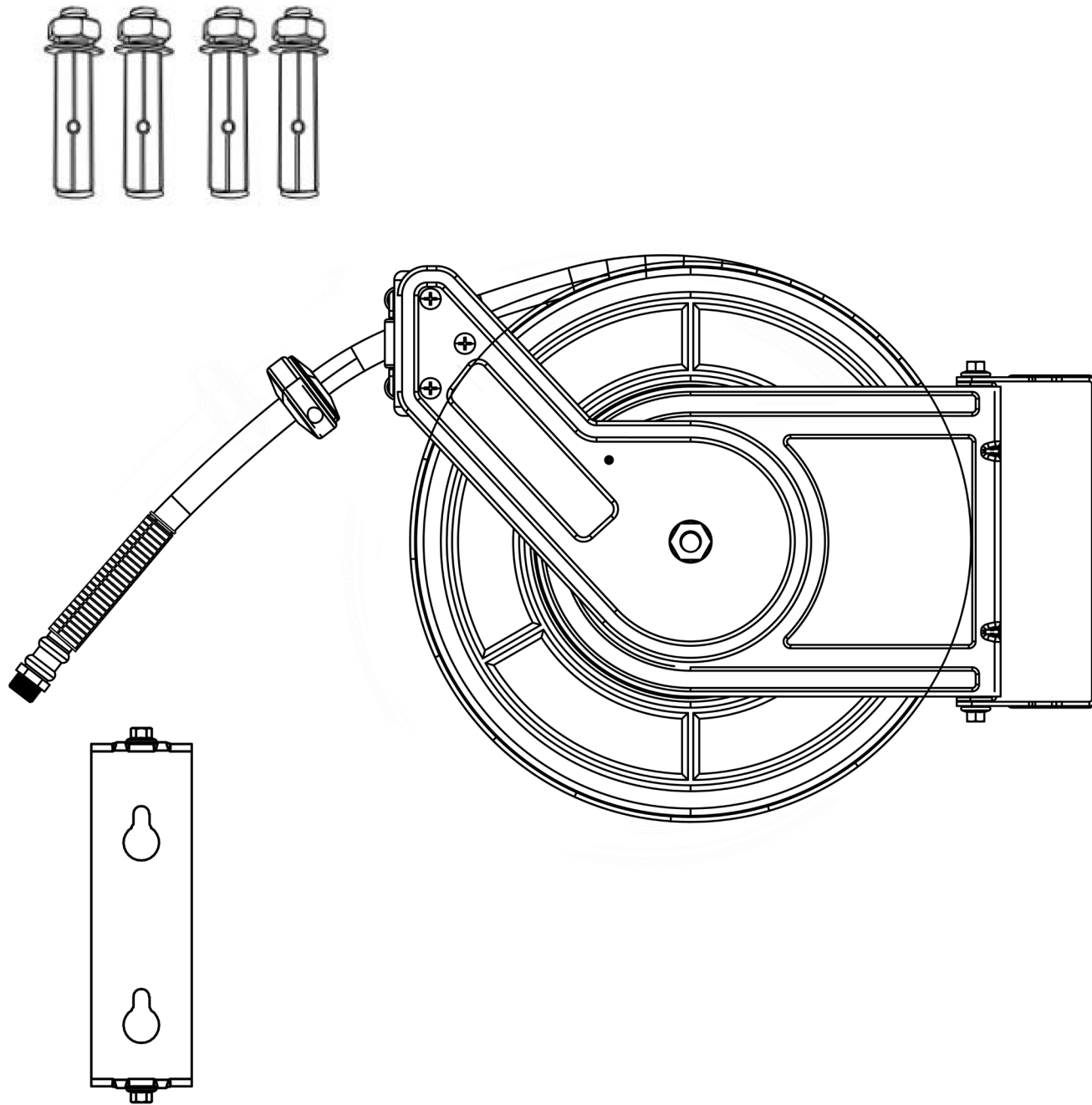
PRODUCT INFORMATION

The Giraffe Tools hose reel is made of quality materials with an auto-retractable feature. The air hose reel can be mounted on the wall or the ceiling, is equipped with a single guide arm that can be repositioned within 225° for better function.

WHAT'S INSIDE THE BOX



1 x Retractable Hose Reel
4 x Expansion Bolt: $\Phi 12 \times 70$

OPEN-BOX CHECK

1. Check whether the parts above are complete and in the box.
2. Check for (white) scratches on the product.

If you have any of the issues mentioned above, please contact the Giraffe Tools customer service team in due time.

Tips: If the received package has a strange scent, know that this is caused by the sealed environment during shipment overseas.

TOOLS REQUIREMENT

- Electric drill (9/16")
- Hammer
- Socket set or a Phillips screwdriver

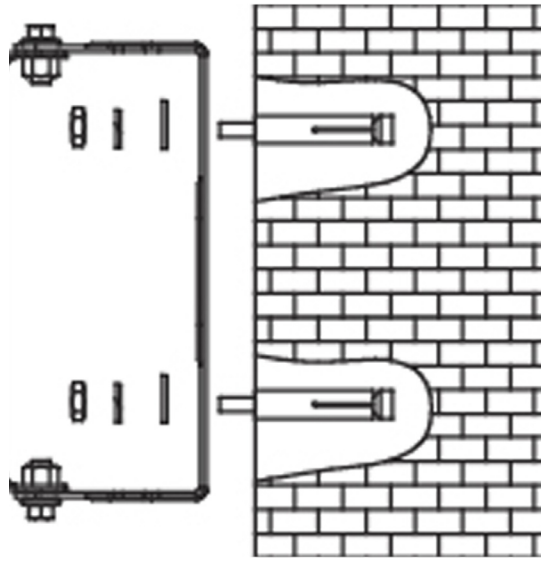
START TO INSTALL



Choose a place



Due to the weight of the filled reel and the pulling force during use, the reel must be installed on a solid surface, that can withstand 20kg of force. As a matter of convenience, please install the hose reel close to your compressor outlet.

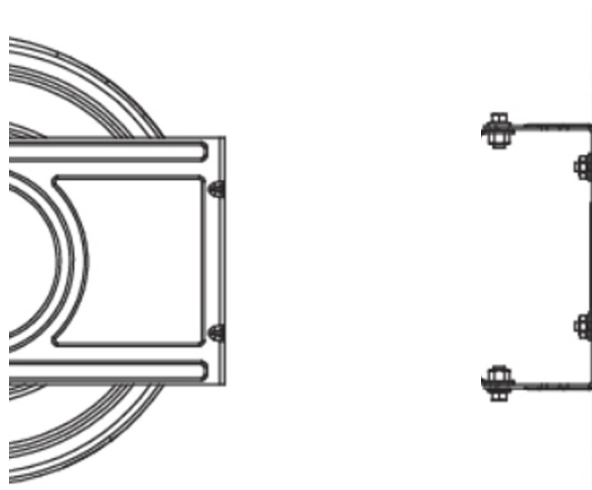


✦ Installing the bracket ✦

1. Use the installation template (page 15) to mark the location of the 2 holes.
2. Use a 9/16" drill bit to drill 2 in. deep holes.

Tips: Depth is important. Mark a 2 in. depth with tape around the drill bit. If the hole is too deep and the wall anchor is rotating, use a matchstick or similar tool to tighten the hole.

3. Hammer the wall anchors into the 2 holes.
4. Hang the bracket on the anchors, put on the washers and screw on the nuts, then use a socket set or a Phillips screwdriver to tighten.



5. Lift the reel and align the reel with the bracket.
6. Secure the 2 screws to the nuts, and tighten.
7. Your hose reel is now installed and ready to use!

PRODUCT TESTING

Check whether the hose retracts as intended:

- Doesn't retract automatically
- Unable to pause

HOW TO

Lock / Extend the hose

There are serial locking and non-locking areas in the steel body, and clicks can be heard when passing through the locking areas. Pull out the hose and stop when hearing the "click" sound to lock the hose.

Retract / Shorten the hose

1. To unlock the hose, give the hose a small tug until reaching the non-locking area (when not hearing the click) to start retraction.
2. To shorten the hose, start retraction and stop when hearing the click.

Tips: Hose can only be locked during pulling out process, and can not be locked during retraction. Always gently retract the hose. If this is not done with caution, the hose reel might get damaged. When walking backwards at a steady speed, the self-segmenting mechanism inserts the hose and weaves neatly into the reel, to ensure that it is free from kinks and tangles.

Recommended usage

1. Always retract the hose after each use.
2. There is an "**STOP**" indication sticker 3.28 feet before the maximum length, don't pull the hose past this point, otherwise, the retraction mechanism will be destroyed.

PROBLEM GUIDE

The reel fell off the wall

Check whether the reel was installed correctly.

The hose cannot be locked

Pull or retract the hose a little until you hear the click. Because of the distance between lock points and unlock areas is very short, if you pull too quickly, you may miss the lock point.

The hose cannot be retracted or extended

It is possible for the hose to become jammed if it retracts unassisted. To free the hose of a jam, pull the hose firmly until it is fully extended. It should now be able to retract once again. Be sure to walk with the hose in hand at a slow speed as it retracts, until it is fully stowed.

The hose is hard to pull

1. Is the hose reel installed at the correct position? If the hose bends too much at the outlet, the hose may rub on the orifice, making it difficult to pull.
2. All mounting holes must be fixed to the wall.
3. Send a photo of the problem to the customer service center for help.

Leakage

MAINTENANCE

AIR TOOL PRECAUTIONS

1. Inspect the tool's air hose for cracks, fraying or other faults before each use. Discontinue use if the air hose is damaged or hissing is heard from the air hose or connectors, while operating the tool. Replace the defective component/air hose.
2. Do not allow people, mobile equipment, or vehicles to pass over the unprotected air hose. Position the air hose away from high traffic areas, in a reinforced conduit or place planks on both sides of the air hose to create an enclosed area.
3. Prevent damage to the air hose by observing the following:
 - a. Never carry the tool by the air hose.
 - b. Keep the air hose away from heat, oil, sharp edges or moving parts.
4. Check the maximum pressure rating for air tools and accessories. Compressor outlet pressure must be regulated to never exceed the maximum pressure rating of the tool.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

CAUTION! Release air pressure from the hose system before servicing the reel.

1. Maintain the tool with care. A tool in good condition is efficient, easier to control and will have fewer problems.
2. Inspect the reel, hose, and accessories for damage or excessive wear before each use. Have damaged or worn components repaired or replaced by an authorized technician. Only use identical replacement parts when servicing.
3. Only use accessories intended for use with this tool.
4. Maintain the tool's labels and name plates. These carry important information. If unreadable or missing, contact us for replacements.

WARNING! Only qualified service personnel should repair the tool. An improperly repaired tool may present a hazard to the user and/or others.

CLEANING

Wipe the surface with a clean, moist cloth. Do not use solvents when cleaning.

SAFETY

WARNING! Read and understand all instructions before using this tool. The operator must follow basic precautions to reduce the risk of personal injury and/or damage to the equipment.

Keep this manual for safety warnings, precautions, operating or inspection and maintenance instructions.

HAZARD DEFINITIONS

Please familiarize yourself with the hazard notices found in this manual. A notice is an alert that there is a possibility of property damage, injury, or death if certain instructions are not followed.

WARNING!

WORK AREA

1. Operate in a safe work environment. Keep your work area clean, well-lit, and free of distractions.
2. Keep anyone not wearing the appropriate safety equipment away from the work area.
3. Store unused tools properly in a safe and dry location to prevent rust or damage. Lock tools away and keep out of reach of children.

PERSONAL SAFETY

WARNING! Wear personal protective equipment approved by the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) or American National Standards Institute (ANSI).

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

1. Always wear impact safety goggles that provide front and side protection for the eyes. Eye protection equipment should comply with CSA Z94.3-07 or ANSI Z87.1 standards, depending on the type of work that is performed.
2. Wear gloves that provide protection from the work materials or to reduce the effects of tool vibration.
3. Wear protective clothing designed for the work environment and tools.
4. Non-skid footwear is recommended to maintain balance in the work environment.

PERSONAL PRECAUTIONS

Control the tool, personal movement, and the work environment to avoid personal injury or damage to the tool.

1. Do not operate any tool when tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medications.
2. Avoid wearing clothes or jewelry that can become entangled with the moving parts of a tool. Keep long hair covered or bound.

SPECIFIC SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

WARNING! DO NOT let comfort or familiarity with product (gained from repeated use) replace strict adherence to the tool's safety rules. If you use this tool unsafely or incorrectly, you can suffer serious personal injuries.

WARNING! Direct exposure of pressurized air or fluids to skin could result in severe bodily injuries.

1. Use the correct tool for the job. This tool was designed for a specific function. Do not modify or alter this tool or use it for an unintended purpose.
2. Ensure that the reel is properly installed before connecting the input and output air hoses.
3. Remove system pressure immediately if a leak occurs in the hose or reel, or if the reel ceases to wind and unwind.
4. Release the hose slowly and control it as it retracts.

WARRANTY

At Giraffe Tools, we conduct rigorous testing on every machine before it leaves the factory and perform a lifetime test on every thousand machines to ensure they will withstand many years of use beyond the warranty period.

In addition to our thorough testing, we offer a **24-month warranty** on all original Giraffe Tools new products. The following specifics apply:

1. Giraffe Tools warrants its products against defects in parts and materials for a period of 24 months from the original purchase date. Please note that this warranty does not apply to **products acquired second hand**.
2. All warranty periods commence on the date of purchase and are non-transferable.
3. The warranty is limited to the provision of a replacement or refund free of charge within the specified period, provided that the above conditions are met, and the original proof of purchase is presented.
4. For quality-related warranty claims, items will be replaced with a new item of equal value when available. In situations where a replacement is not available or preferred, Giraffe Tools will offer a full refund.
5. Warranties on all replacements follow the same 24-month warranty time frame as the original defective item. Warranties on fully refunded products will be voided after the refund is released.

Process:

- Buyers must provide sufficient proof of purchase.
- Giraffe Tools must document what happens when buyers troubleshoot the product.
- Visible proof depicting the defect, such as pictures or videos, is required.
- It may be necessary to return an item for quality inspection.
- For defective items that Giraffe Tools needs to have returned, warrantions those replacements are voided if the wrong item is returned to Giraffe Tools or if the defective item is not returned.

Valid proof of purchase:

- Order number from online purchases made through Giraffe Tools or Giraffe Tools's authorized resellers.
- Sales invoice that shows a description of the product along with its price.

Not Covered Under Warranty:

- Purchases from unauthorized resellers.
- Alterations not carried out or authorized by Giraffe Tools authorized resellers.
- Products without sufficient proof of purchase.
- Second-hand products.
- Items that have expired their warranty period.
- Damage from misuse of products, including, but not limited to, improper storage, falls, extreme temperatures, water, and improper operation of devices.

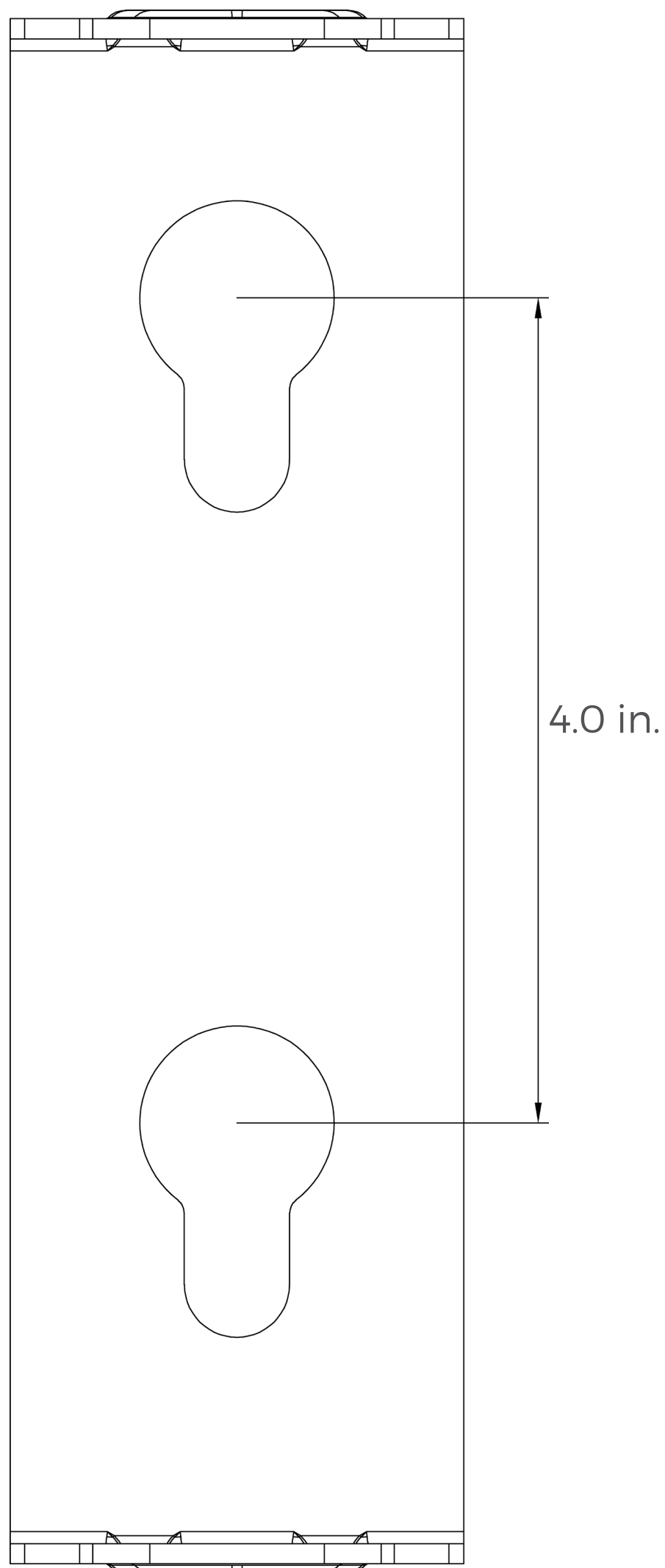
