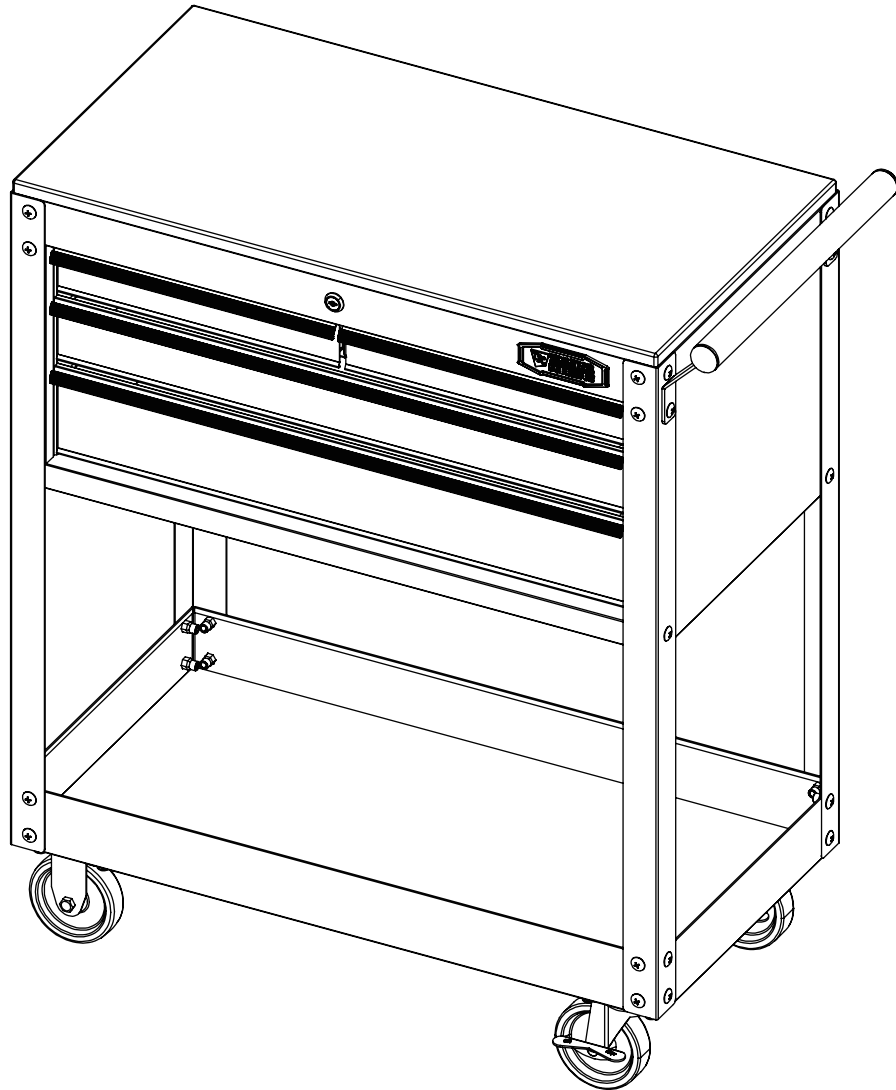

Safety Information

1. Do not open more than one drawer at a time.
2. Do not let children approach the tool cart.
3. Keep the locking casters brake set unless you are moving the cart. This will help to prevent the product from rolling.
4. Lock all drawers before moving the cart.
5. Do not step in the tray.
6. Do not pull the tool cart, push it when moving.
7. Do not alter this product in any manner.



DANGER: Do not stand on this product. You may fall or cause the product to tip.



DANGER: Do not move the product prior to closing and locking all the drawers. The drawers could come open and make the product unstable and tip.



DANGER: Do not mount this product on a truck bed or any other moving object.



WARNING: Keep the product on a level surface. The product may become unstable and tip if stored or moved on an uneven surface.



CAUTION: Do not lift this product directly with a forklift or tow with any mechanical devices.



CAUTION: Do not exceed the maximum product weight, including contents. Do not exceed the maximum weight for each drawer. See Specifications on page 4.

Assembly

1 Installing the legs

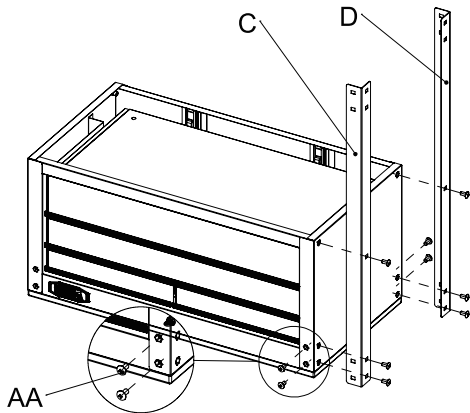
- ☐ Ensure all cabinet drawers are securely locked into place using the lock (K) on the cart.
- ☐ Lay the cart upside down. Use the packaging material to protect the wood top from damage during assembly.
- ☐ Mount the Post 1 (C) & Post 2 (D) to the cart using five bolts (AA) per leg. Do not install two of the bolts (AA) in the posts of the tool cart on the side adjacent to the TSC badge. The side handle (B) will be mounted here in a later step.



NOTE: The holes in the tool cart are tapped and do not require nuts.

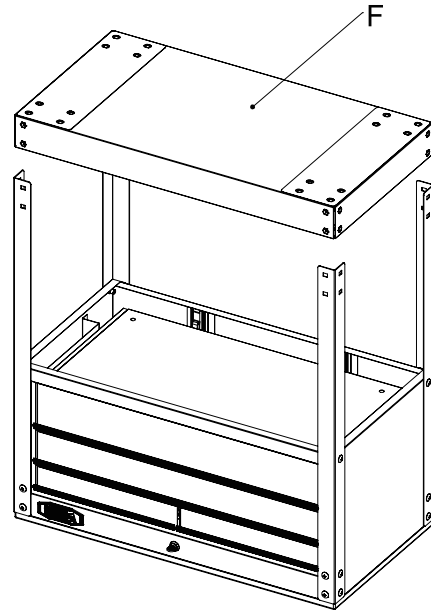


NOTE: Two people may be required to complete this step.



2 Attaching the tray

- ☐ Clip the tray (F) to the four posts (C&D).

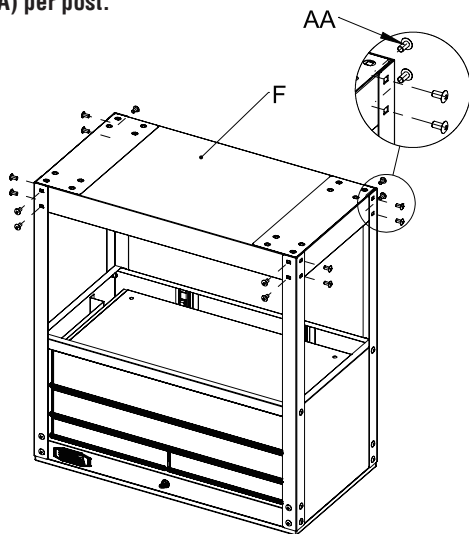


3 Securing the tray



NOTE: The holes in the tool cart are tapped and do not require nuts.

- ☐ Secure the tray (F) to the posts (C&D) using four bolts (AA) per post.

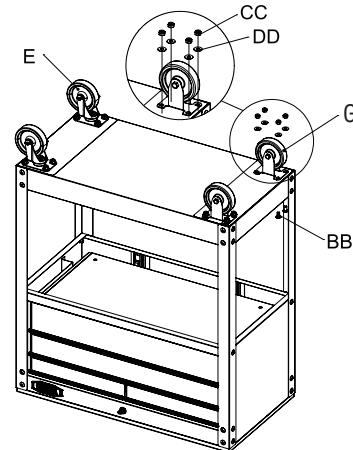


4 Installing the casters



CAUTION: Do not over tighten the bolts.

- ☐ Mount the two swivel casters with brake (E) to the tray (F) using four sets carriage bolt (BB), nut (CC) and washer (DD) per caster. The swivel casters with brake (E) should be installed on the same side as the TSC badge.
- ☐ Mount the two fixed casters (G) to the tray (F) using four sets carriage bolt (BB), nut (CC) and washer (DD) per caster.
- ☐ Tighten all bolts with a 13 mm wrench.
- ☐ Carefully return the tool cart to its upright position.

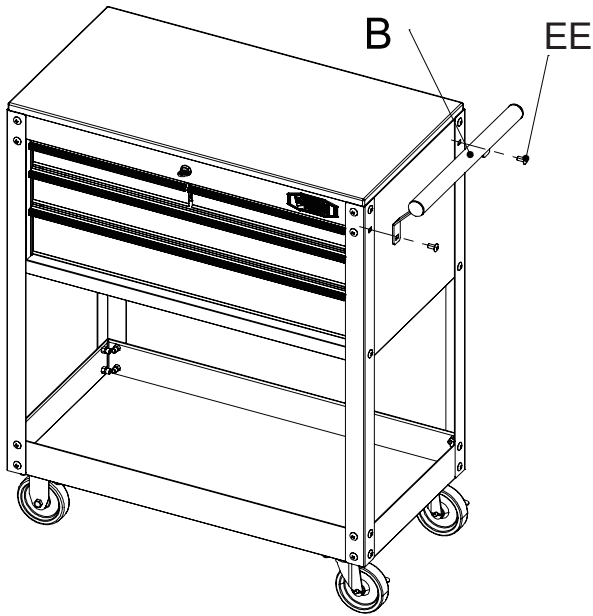


5 Attaching the side handle



NOTE: The holes in the tool cart are tapped and do not require nuts.

- ☐ Attach the side handle (B) to the tool cart using two long bolts (EE).



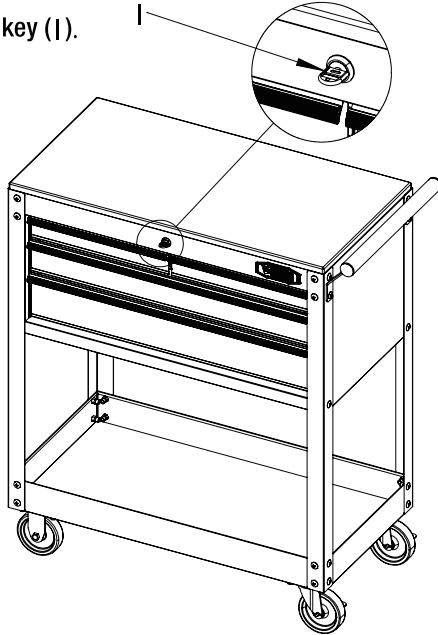
Operation

1 Locking and unlocking the unit



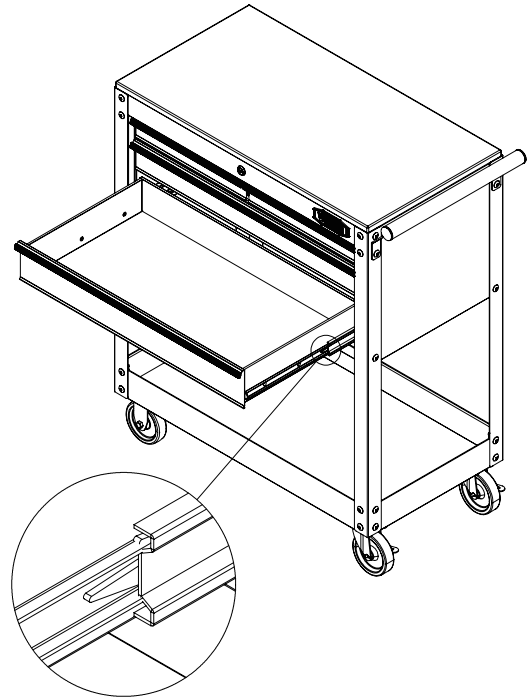
IMPORTANT : The drawers must be fully closed before locking / unlocking the unit.

- ☐ Insert the key (I) into the lock and turn it fully to the left to lock.
- ☐ Remove the key (I).
- ☐ Insert the key (I) into the lock and turn it fully to the right to unlock.
- ☐ Remove the key (I).



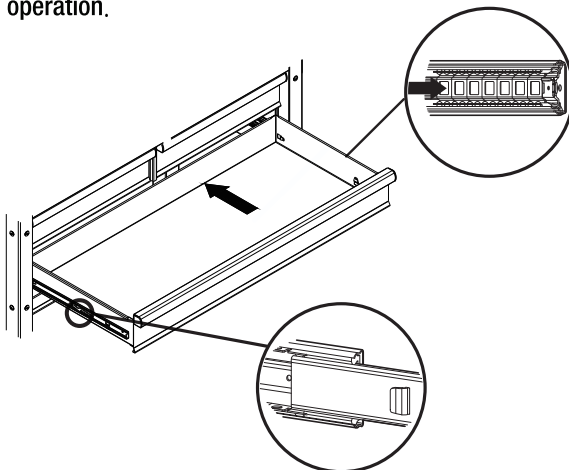
2 Removing the drawers

- ☐ Fully extend and empty the drawer.
- ☐ Depending on the slide, either lift or lower the release lever on both sides so the slides can ride over the stops. Pull out to remove.



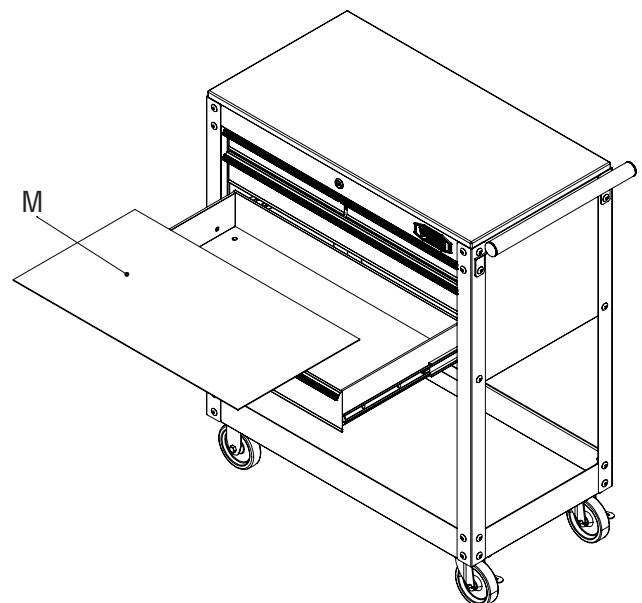
3 Installing the drawers

- ☐ Pull the slides and slide carrier out until fully extended.
- ☐ Hold the slide on the cabinet while aligning it with the slide on the drawer.
- ☐ Slightly insert one side and repeat for the other side.
- ☐ Slowly push the drawer until it is fully closed to engage the slide.
- ☐ Open the drawer and close it to verify proper operation.



4 Installing the drawer liner

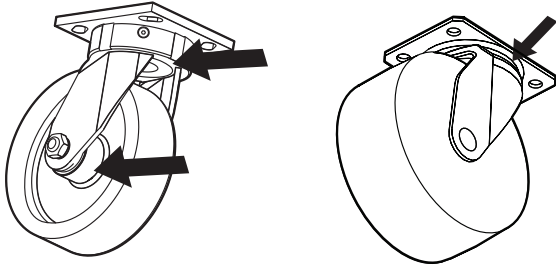
- ☐ Place the drawer liners (M) in appropriately sized drawers to protect the surface.



Maintenance

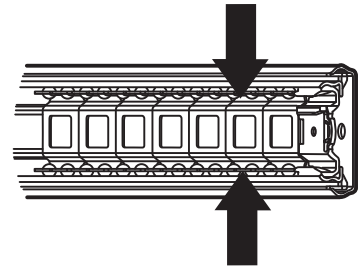
1 Maintaining the casters

- ☐ Grease the casters annually using high quality bearing grease.



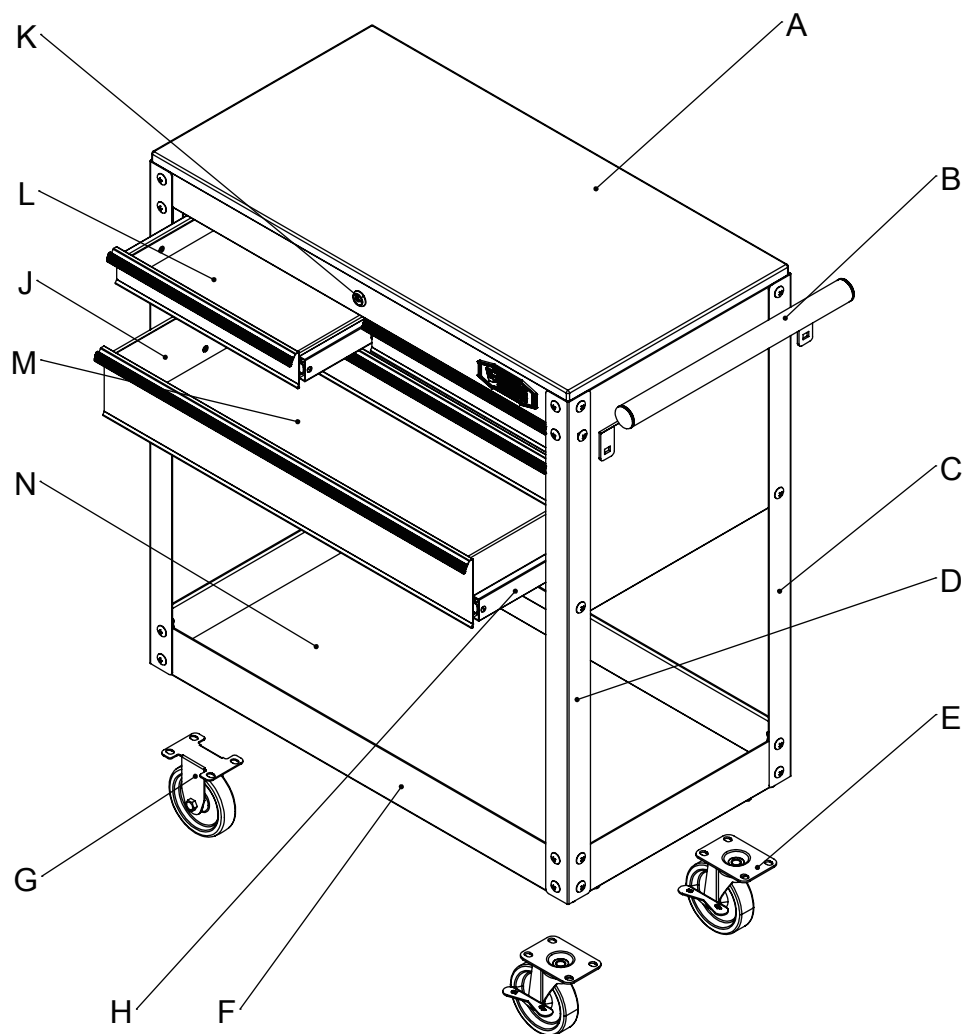
2 Maintaining the drawers

- ☐ Periodically clean the drawer trim, and inside the drawers with a mild detergent and water.
- ☐ Remove grease and oil with a standard, nonflammable cleaning fluid.
- ☐ The use of drawer liners is recommended to protect the finish inside the drawers and make the drawers easier to clean.
- ☐ Lubricate the slides semi-annually with grease or equivalent.



Care and Cleaning

- ☐ This steel product has been coated with industrial powder coating for a durable finish.
- ☐ To help protect the powder coated finish, do not allow harsh chemicals (oil, grease, or other chemical) to remain on the powder coating surface.
- ☐ Use a glass cleaner to clean and maintain all surfaces of powder coating.
- ☐ The wood top is made of Parawood (also called Rubberwood) which has UV coating to help protect it from moisture. It can be cleaned with most household cleaners.
