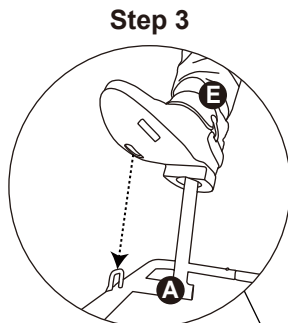
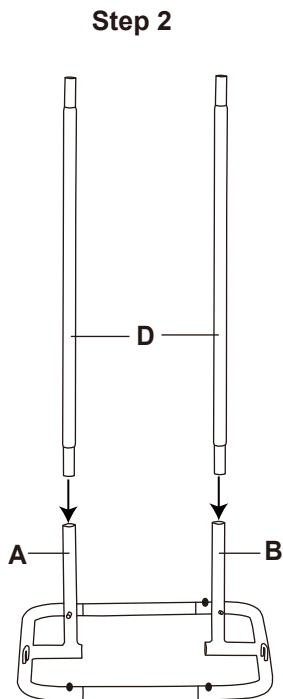
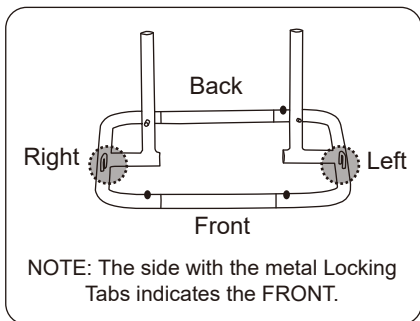
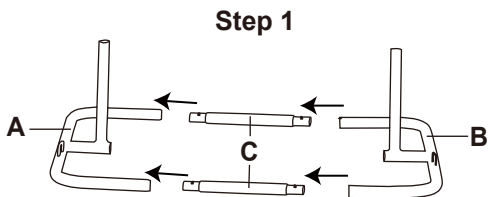
ASSEMBLY:

NOTE: Throughout the instructions, Right and Left are from the SKELETON COWBOY face forward point of view.

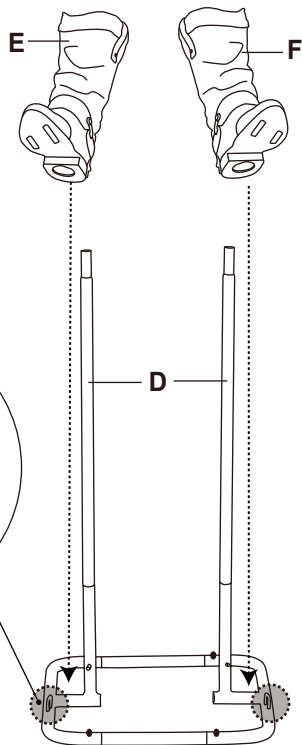


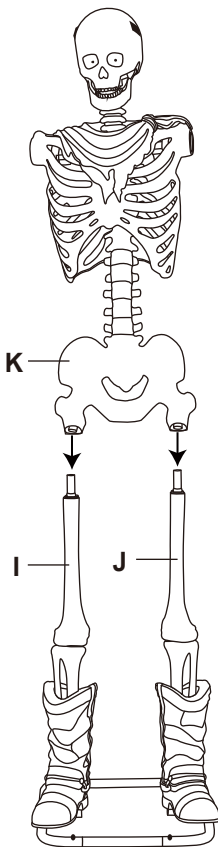
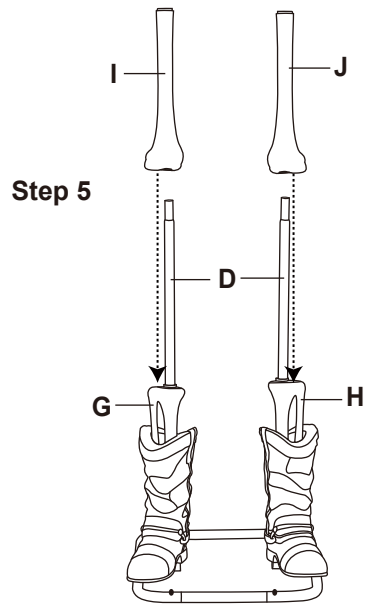
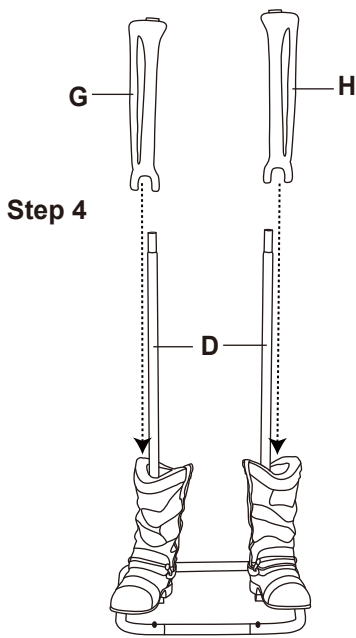
NOTE:

Follow this 'Click Lock' procedure for all Support Frame assembly.



Align the slot on the bottom of each Boot (E & F) with the metal Locking Tab on the Base. Slide the Boot down firmly until it is fully seated.





Step 6 Attach Hip Joint onto Skeleton Legs

* 2 people recommended for this assembly

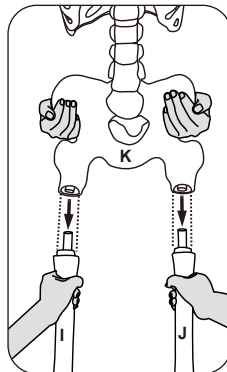


Fig 1 - Line up Slots on bottom of Hip Joint with the top of Leg Struts.

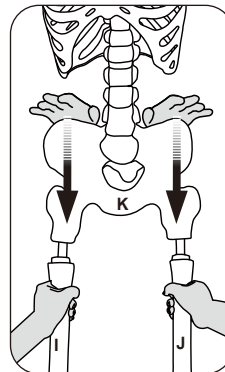


Fig 2 - Press down firmly until you hear a 'clicking' sound on both sides. This will take some downwards pressure to secure both legs in place.

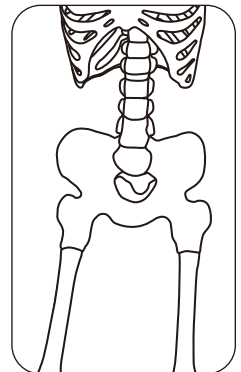
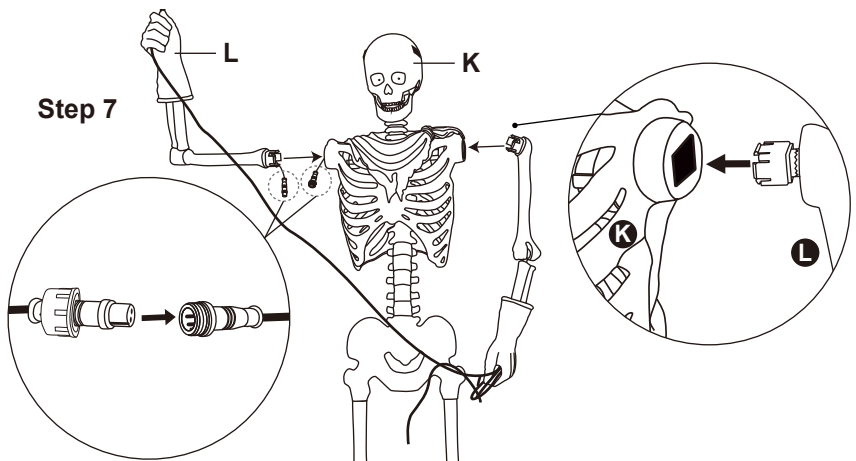
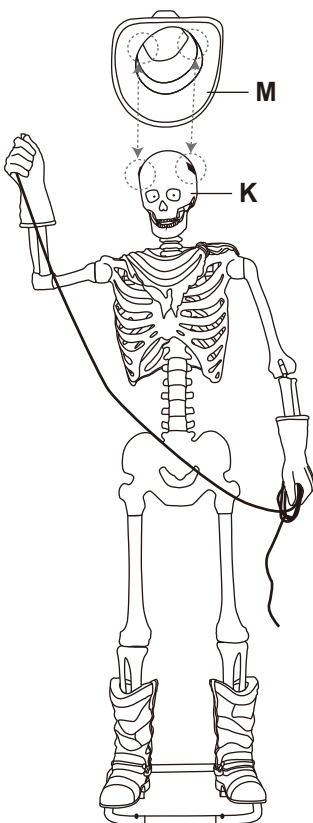


Fig 3 - Ensure the legs are joined properly with a tight and aligned fit.

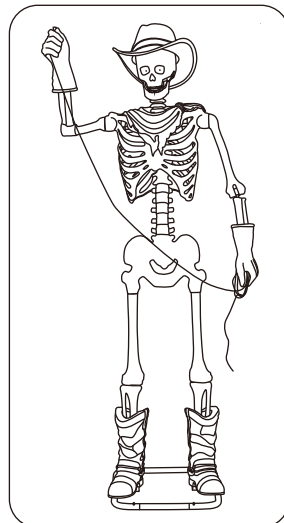


Join Push-In Plug Connectors on cable ends from the Right Shoulder to the Right Arm, secure with Turn Lock Fastener.

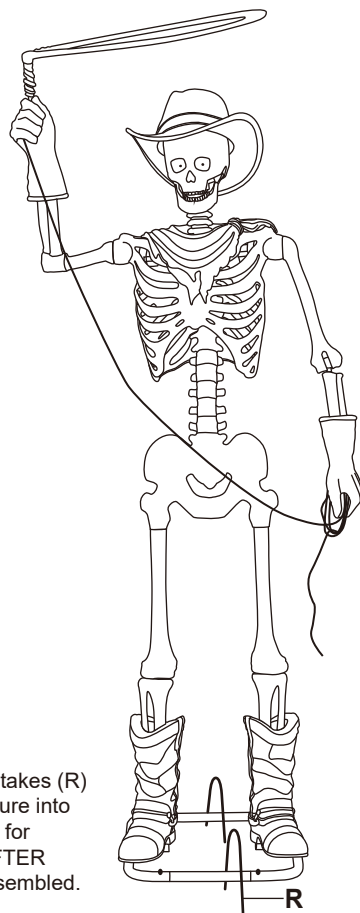
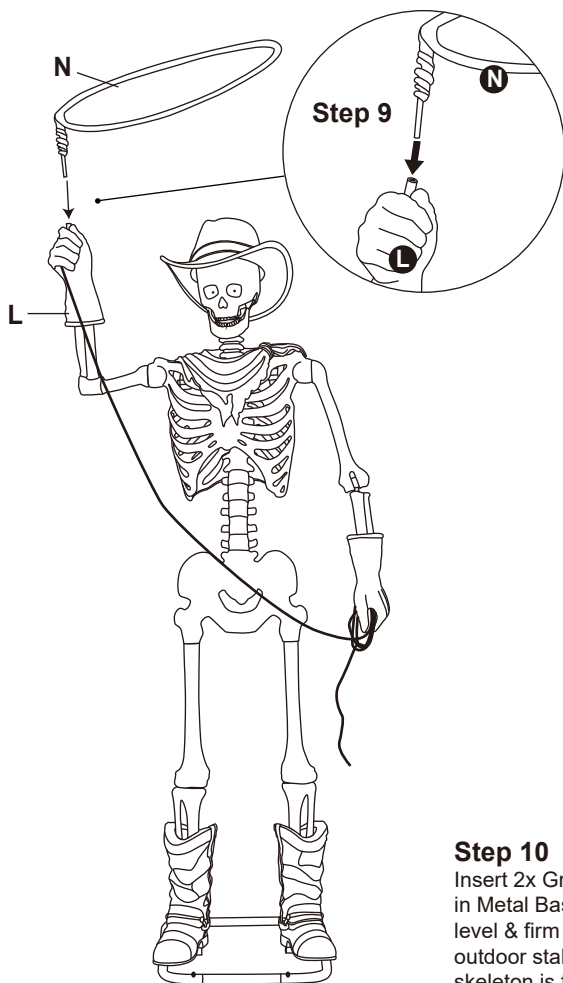


Step 8

Secure Hat (M) by sticking the 2x Hook & Loop Strips at the left and right side to the corresponding strips on the Head (K). Arrange the head as desired.

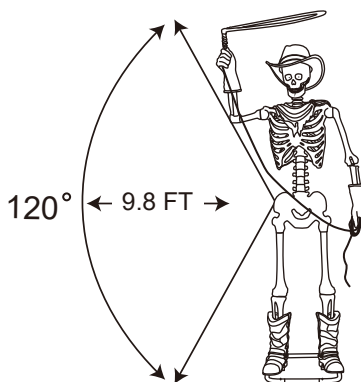


View of partially assembled Skeleton



Step 10

Insert 2x Ground Stakes (R) in Metal Base. Secure into level & firm ground for outdoor stability AFTER skeleton is fully assembled.



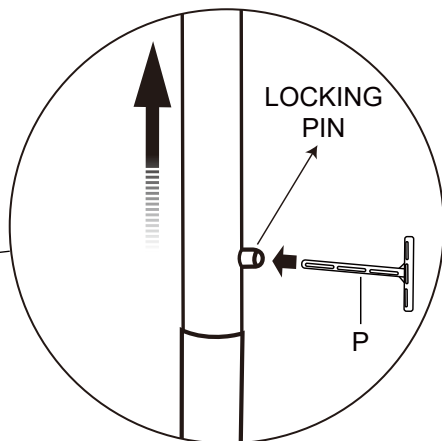
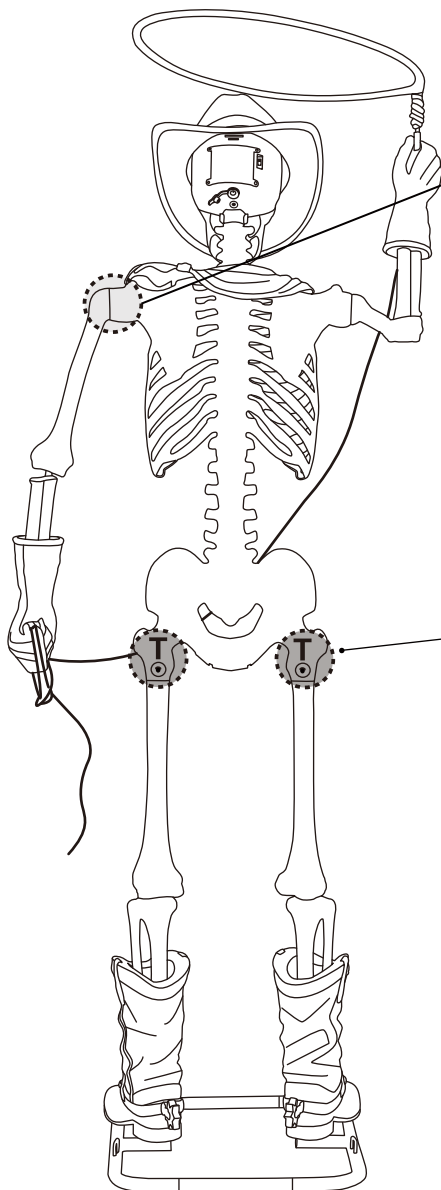
Motion Sensor

DISASSEMBLY AND STORAGE:

POSEABLE LEFT ARM

Once the product is fully assembled, the Skeleton's left arm is poseable. You can adjust the arm to create various poses.



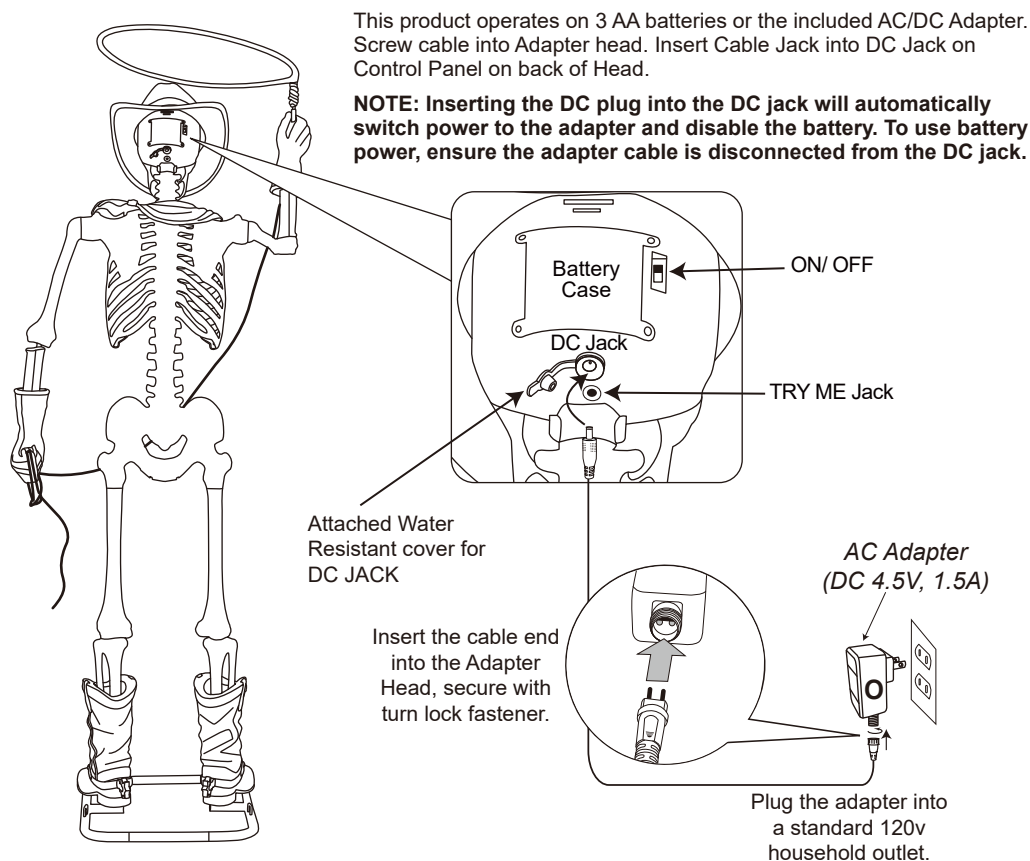
When disassembling the Skeleton

Use the Disassembly Tool (P) to depress the locking pins fully to then separate parts .

The location for each of the locking pins can be identified by the letter "T" sticker attached next to each of the access holes on the Skeleton, as shown.

When not in use, store this product in its original packaging. Keep away from heat and moisture.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:



BATTERY REPLACEMENT

1. Locate the battery compartment at the back of the head. Using a small screwdriver, remove the safety screw located on the battery compartment cover.
2. Remove cover and clean both ends of the battery contacts and also the contacts of the device prior to installing the batteries. Insert (3) AA batteries with correct polarity.
3. Replace cover and safety screw.
4. Replace batteries if movement slows or lights dim.
5. Remove batteries if the item will not be used for an extended period of time.

ITEM FUNCTION:

ON

Move the switch into the "ON" position to activate the "Motion Activated" function. When activated, the unit will come to life. The unit will play the full version of sound, motion and lights. (Note: The "Motion Sensor" is activate at angle 120° and the detection zone within 9.8 feet).

OFF

Move the switch in the "OFF" position to activate the Try-Me feature and then press the large Try Me Button for demonstration.

Please read instructions carefully before use.

Retain for future reference.

TROUBLE SHOOTING:

Problem	Solution
The product does not work	1. Check all wire connections and make sure all parts are securely attached.
	2. Check and make sure the ON/OFF switch is in the “ON” position.
	3. When using the batteries: Check to see if the positive and negative terminals of the batteries are installed correctly. The batteries could be drained. Replace with new batteries and try again.
	4. When using the Adapter: Check to make sure the adapter is connected to a working power source. Make sure the adapter is plugged into a standard 120V household outlet.
The Motion Sensor does not work	1. Check to see that the switch is placed in the “ON” position only. 2. Change the product placement environment and try again. 3. Check to see if the ambient temperature is too high. Place the product in a normal temperature environment.
