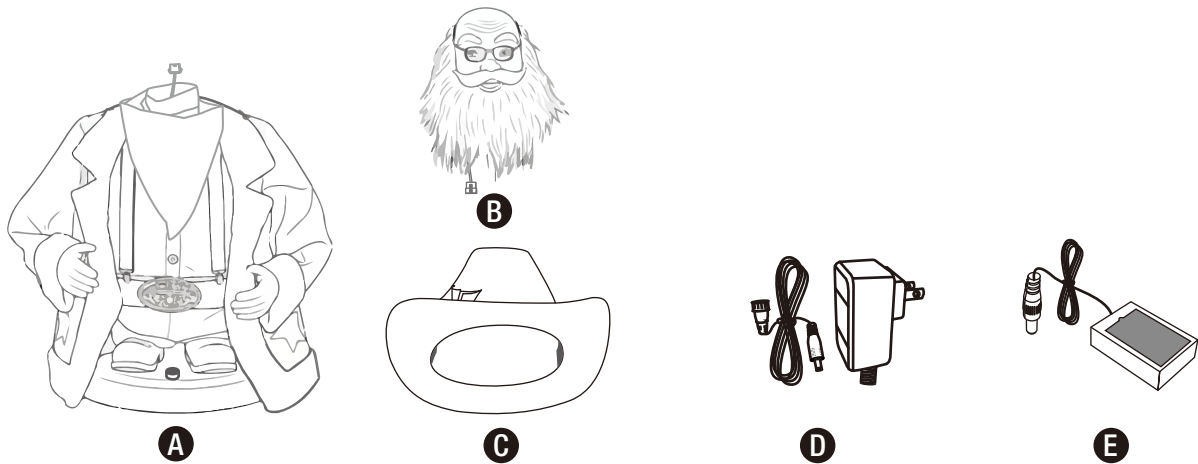

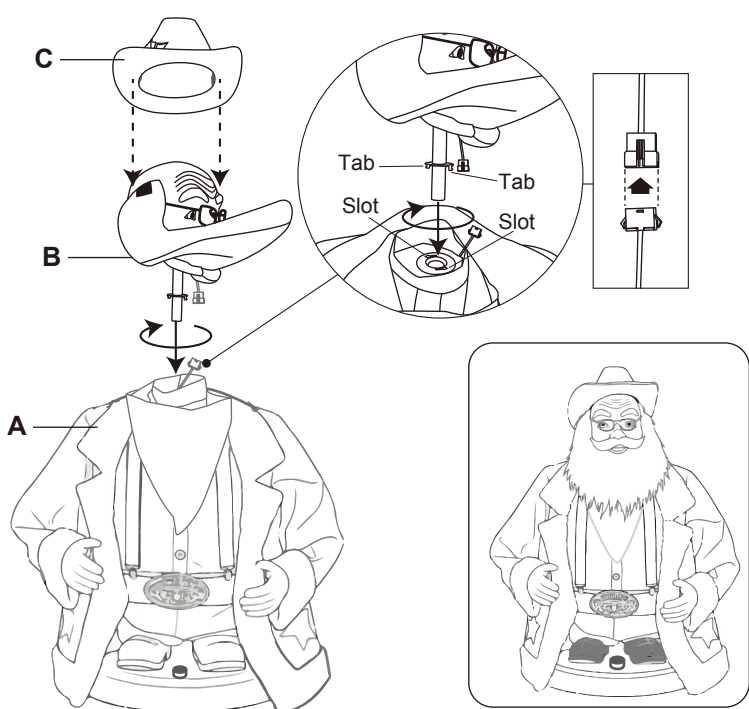

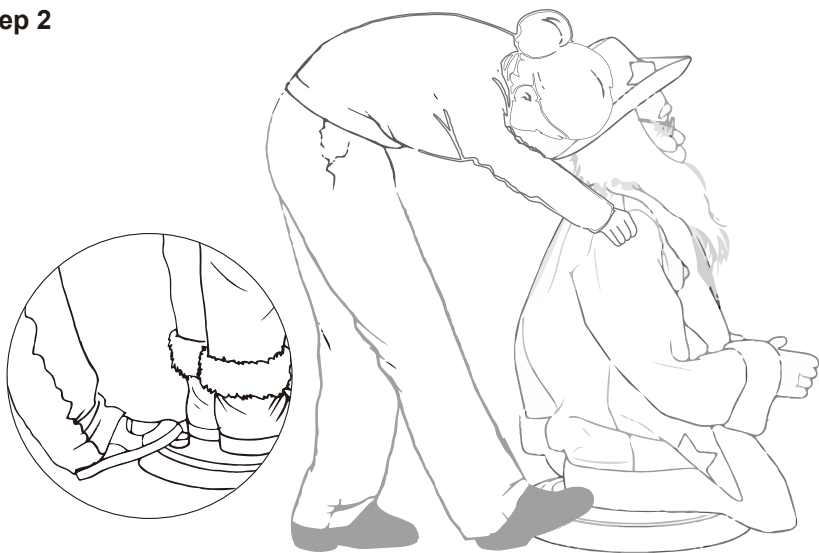
INSTALLATION:

Step 1



Align the tab on the bottom of the head (B) with the slot on the top of the body (A), then rotate clockwise to secure it in place. Secure Hat (C) to Santa Head (B) by connecting the Hook & Loop strips on both parts together.

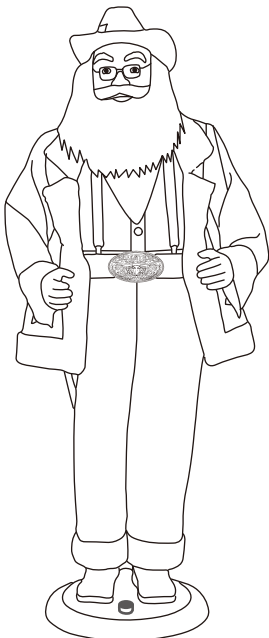
Step 2



Carefully step on the "release button" located behind Santa's feet. While pressing the button, hold Santa by both shoulders and gently lift the figure straight up. Once the figure begins to rise, remove your foot from the "release button" and continue lifting from the shoulders until you hear the body section "click" into place. This indicates that the figure is fully extended and locked in position.

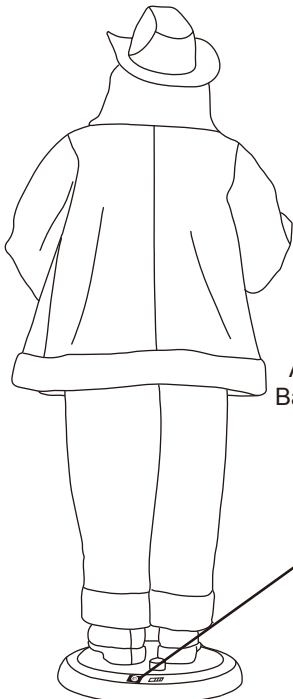
NOTE: If the figure gets stuck while lifting or lowering, take your foot off the "release button," then try the operation again.

Step 3



Once the Dancing Santa is assembled, it can be placed in the desired location. If placed outdoors, then item must be put in a covered location. Santa's costume can also be straightened and the arms posed to your liking to give him a more festive look.

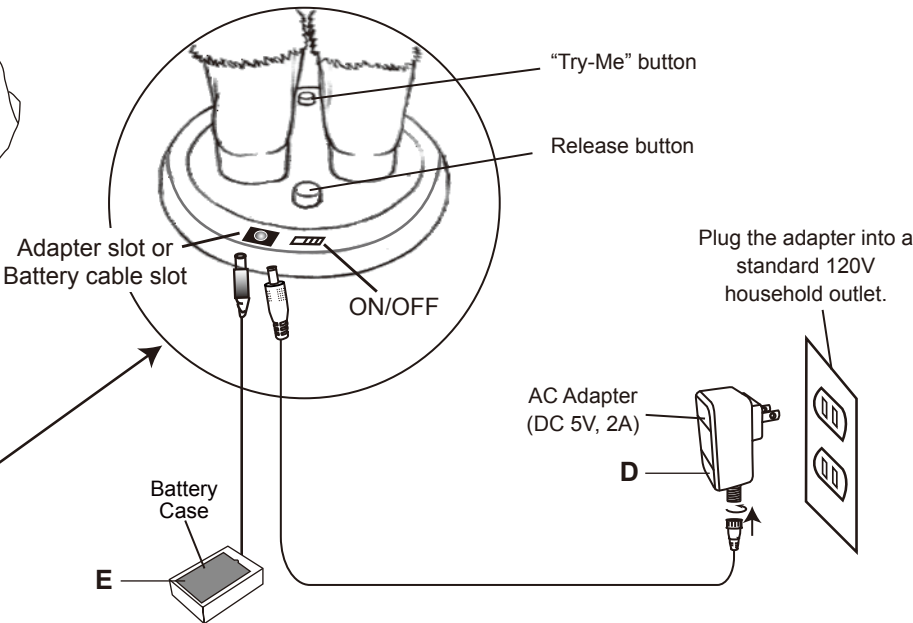
Step 4



This product operates on 3 "D" batteries or the included AC/DC Adapter. Insert Cable Jack into DC Jack on base.

NOTE: The included 3 x "D" batteries are for "Try Me" demonstration purposes only. If the product performance becomes weak, please replace with fresh batteries or operate using the included AC/DC adapter.

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS:

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- 1. The battery box compartment is located on the end of the cable.
- 2. Open cover and clean both ends of the battery contacts and also the contacts of the device prior to installing the batteries. Insert (3) D batteries with correct polarity.
- 3. Close the battery case cover.
- 4. Replace batteries if movement slows.
- 5. Remove batteries if the item will not be used for an extended period of time.

ITEM FUNCTION:

ON	Move the switch into the “ON” position to activate the “Motion Activated” function. When activated, the unit will come to life. The unit will play the full version of sound, motion. (Note: The “Motion Sensor” is activated at angle 120° and the detection zone within 9.8 feet).
OFF	Move the switch into the “OFF” position and press the “Try-Me” button, which is located on the front of the “base section”, to activate Santa's “dancing” motion with arm and body movement and to play the seasonal music.

TROUBLE SHOOTING:

Problem	Solution
The product does not work	1. Check all wire connections and make sure all parts are securely attached.
	2. Check and make sure the ON/OFF switch is in the “ON” position.
	3. When using the batteries: Check to see if the positive and negative terminals of the batteries are installed correctly. The batteries could be drained. Replace with new batteries and try again.
	4. When using the Adapter: Check to make sure the adapter is connected to a working power source. Make sure the adapter is plugged into a standard 120V household outlet.
The Motion Sensor does not work	1. Check to see that the switch is placed in the “ON” position only. 2. Change the product placement environment and try again. 3. Check to see if the ambient temperature is too high. Place the product in a normal temperature environment.

WARNING

- This item contains small parts that can be a choking hazard. Keep all plastic and wire parts away from children.
- 1. Please use the adapter supplied by manufacturer.
 - 2. Please assemble item according to instructions. Connect all wires.
 - 3. Children should be supervised by adults. Item should not be grabbed, as it becomes a tipping hazard. Keep all away from the adapter, as it heats up during operation.
 - 4. Strangulation Hazard: This product contains long cords. To prevent strangulation, do not place the reins around the neck. Keep away from young children. This is not a toy.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. All cautions in these operating instructions should be followed completely.
- 2. Do not display figure near any heat source such as radiators, stoves, fireplaces, etc.
