ASSEMBLY

Unpacking the Device

1. Open the package and carefully remove the device.
2. Remove all packaging material, including packaging/transport fuses (if available).
3. Check that the delivery is complete.
4. Inspect the appliance and accessories for any damage that may have occurred during transit.
5. If possible, store the packaging until the end of the warranty period.

Intended Use

The sweeper is designed to sweep flat and dry surfaces such as driveways, patio yards, etc. It should only be used as intended. This device is not suitable for commercial or industrial use.

Product Assembly

Installation of Feed Brushes (Figures 3-6):

1. Insert the feed brush onto the sweeper.
2. Attach the feed brush with the cap, ensuring the lettering on the cap is correctly aligned. Turn the cap in the direction of the arrowhead.
3. Repeat the procedure for the other side.
4. To disassemble the feed brushes, turn the cap in the opposite direction and remove the cap and the feed brush.

Mounting of Push Bars (Figures 7-10):

1. Mount the lower and upper push bars as shown in Figures 7 to 10.
2. Adjust the height of the push bar by selecting the appropriate mounting hole.

OPERATION

By pushing the sweeper, the feed brushes and the sweeping brush are rotated via the belt drive. The rotating feed brushes sweep the dirt to the center. This dirt is collected by the sweeping brush and transported to the waste container.

EMPTYING THE WASTE CONTAINER (Figure 11)

Warning: Dust can be hazardous to your health. Wear a dust mask!

1. Remove the waste container from the appliance as shown in Figure 11.
2. Empty the container and reinsert it back into the device.

PARKING POSITION (Figures 8, 12, 13)

The device can be folded for space-saving storage. To fold:

1. Loosen the lower nuts with quick-release function until the pins (Figure 8) pop out of the fixation.
2. Unfold the push bar (Figure 12).
3. Alternatively, loosen the upper nuts with quick-release function afterward.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

1. Keep guards and air vents as dust and dirt-free as possible.
2. We recommend cleaning the appliance immediately after each use.
3. Clean the appliance regularly with a damp cloth and some soap.
4. Do not use detergents or solvents; these could damage the plastic parts of the device. Ensure no water enters the inside of the appliance.

STORAGE

Store the appliance and its accessories in a dark, dry, and frost-free place. The optimal storage temperature is between 5°C and 30°C (41°F and 86°F). Keep the power tool in its original packaging.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
The guide wheel does not rotate smoothly, making pushing difficult.	Debris like small branches may be tangled around the guide wheel, causing it to be inflexible.	Lift the machine and remove any debris from the guide wheel.
The feeding brush is hard to push and does not rotate smoothly.	Large branches or excessive debris may be wrapped around the feeding brush, preventing smooth operation.	Remove large branches and debris that are stuck in the feeding brush.
The wheels slide and do not rotate when the machine is pushed.	The ground may be too smooth or wet, reducing friction and causing the wheels to slip.	Avoid using the machine on very smooth or wet surfaces.
