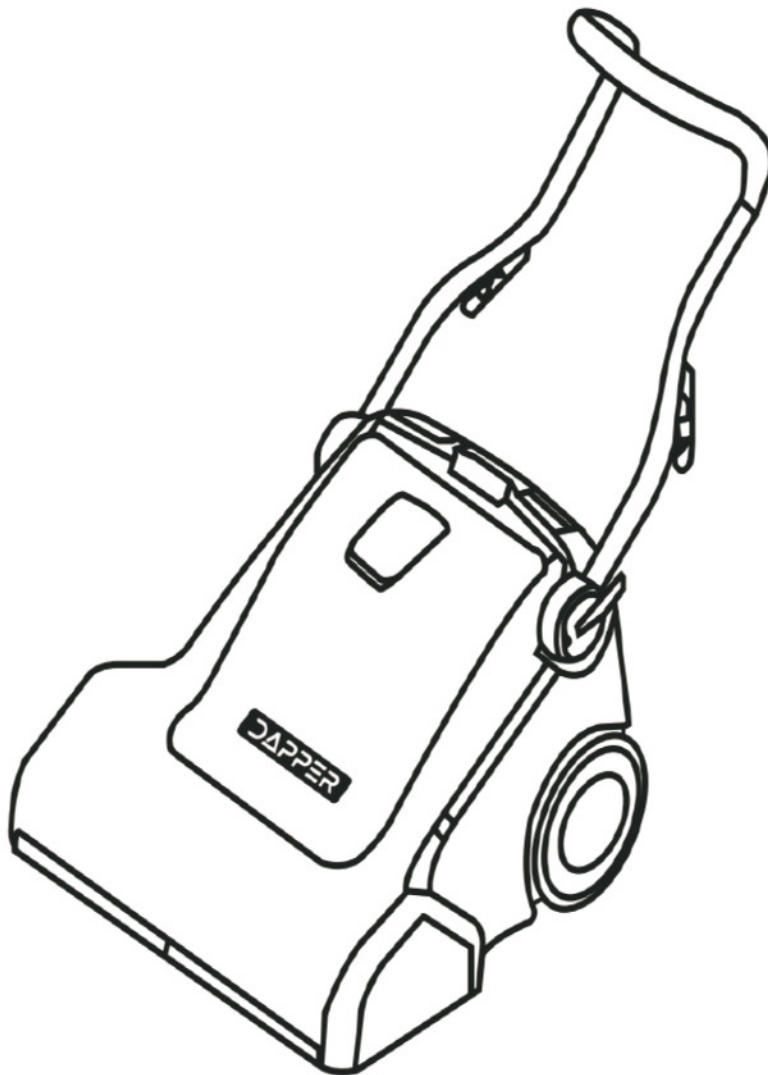

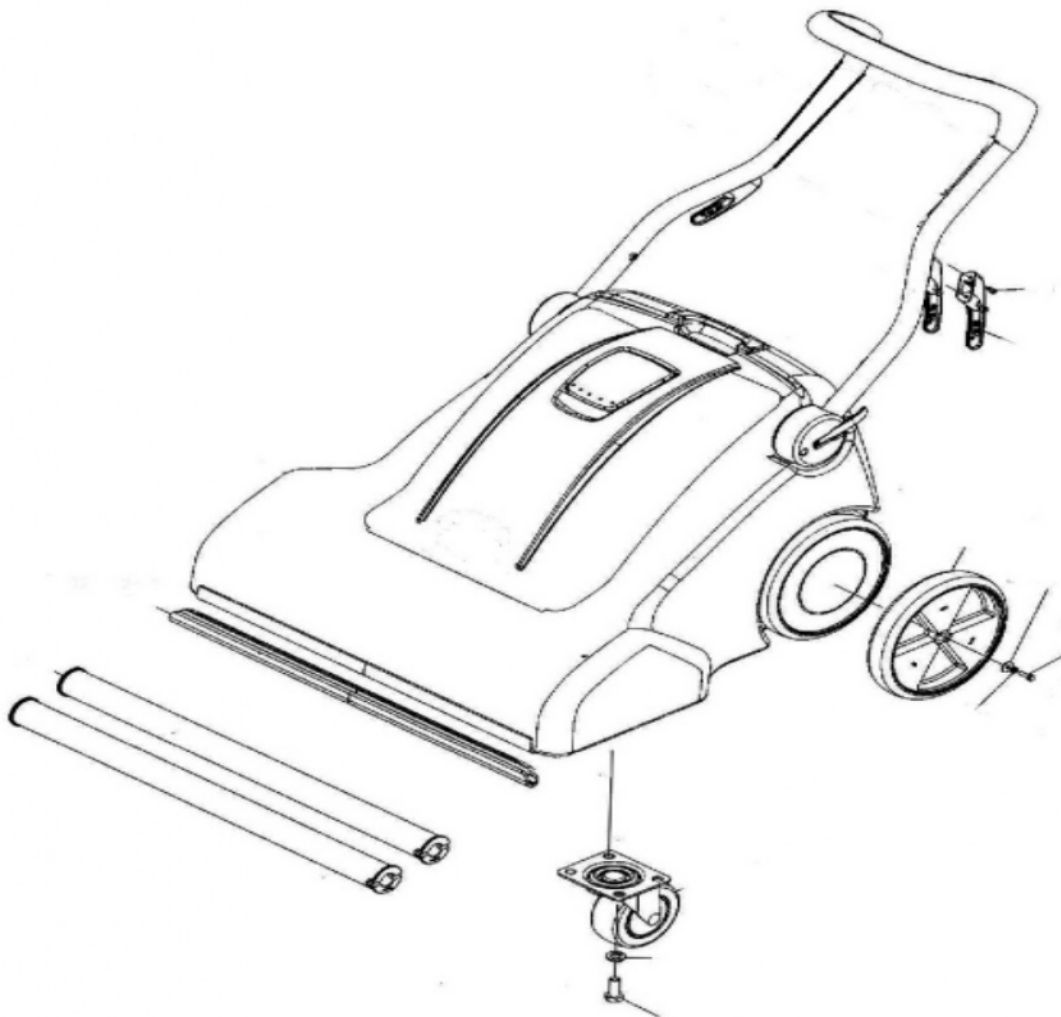
WARNING

Safety Precautions

1. **Floor Damage Warning:** Avoid operating the appliance in a stationary position to prevent damage to the floor covering.
2. **Edge-to-Edge Cleaning:** The brush system is positioned on one side, allowing the right side of the appliance to clean right up to the edge.
3. **Filter Bag Replacement:** If the full filter bag indicator lights up, turn off the appliance and replace the filter bag.

ASSEMBLY

1. **Cable Storage & Removal:** Wrap the power cable around the three cable holders. To remove it, turn the rotating cable holder.
2. **Adjusting the Handle:** Swivel the handle lock outward, set the desired height, and secure the lock.
3. **Vacuuming Procedure:** Remove large debris such as cups, plates, and strings before vacuuming. Plug the appliance into a power socket, switch it to "ON," and move steadily across the surface. For heavy soiling, clean multiple times or at a slower pace.



MAINTENANCE

1. Daily:

Shake the filter bag contents downward if necessary.
Inspect the power cable for damage and replace if needed.
Clean underneath the appliance.
Remove fibers, hair, and strings from the brush rollers.
Check and clean seals, replacing any that are damaged.

2. Weekly:

Clean the brushes and inspect them for wear.
Replace brushes if the bristles have worn down to the length of the yellow indicator bristles.

3. Monthly:

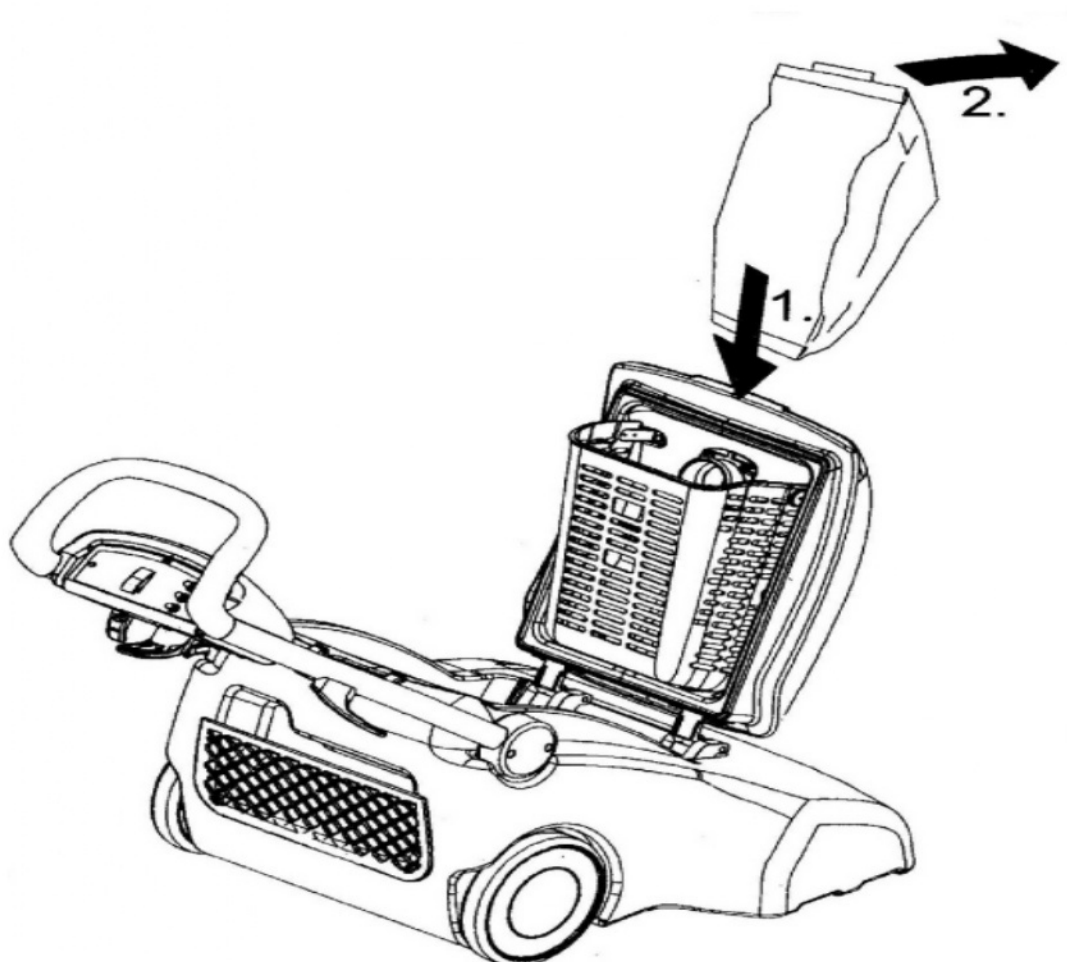
Clean the motor protection filter located at the bottom of the filter chamber.
Check the filter for any damage.

4. Every Six Months:

Remove the wheels, clean the axles, and apply a thin layer of silicone grease.

Main Troubles & How to Solve Them:

Problem	Solution
Appliance is not working:	Plug in the main plug; Check facility fuse.
Brushes do not turn:	Reset the brush drive fuse on the control panel
Suction turbines do not run:	Reset the suction turbine fuse on the control panel.
Insufficient vacuum performance:	Reset the suction turbine fuse on the control panel; Filter bag is full, the indicator 'filter bag full' glows, Replace filter bag; Remove the brush rollers clean suction channel in the brush head and check the suction hose.



Limited Warranty

This warranty is valid exclusively for the original purchaser of the product and applies only within the United States. The warranty begins on the date of the original purchase. Proof of the purchase date is required to obtain service under this warranty.

Under this limited warranty, your sole and exclusive remedy is the repair of the product as described above. All warranty services must be performed by a Dapper Supply-authorized service provider.
