SAFETY

Safety and Operating Guidelines

1. Keep out of reach of children.
2. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
3. Always turn off the machine before connecting or disconnecting the power cord to the power outlet.
4. Do not operate the machine with bare feet or when wearing open-toed shoes or sandals.
5. Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
6. Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible materials such as, but not limited to, gasoline or alcohol, or use in areas where they may be present.
7. Avoid picking up hard, sharp objects with the cleaner, since they may damage the machine.
8. Use extra care when cleaning stairs.
9. Do not allow the carpet and hard floor cleaning machine to be used as a toy or to run unattended at any time.
10. Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, feet, and all parts of the body away from openings, rotating brushes, and other moving parts.
11. Do not put any objects into openings or near brushes.
12. Do not use the machine with any blocked opening; keep free of dust, lint, hair, or anything that may reduce brush action.
13. Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners.
14. Do not run the machine over the cord and keep it away from heated surfaces.

15. Always disconnect the cord from the electrical outlet before servicing the cleaner or when not in use.
16. Unplug the machine when not in use after all controls have been turned off.
17. Use only the carpet and hard floor cleaning machine for its intended uses described in the instructions. Use only attachments recommended by Dapper, others may cause hazards. Always wash hands after handling chemicals or cleaning materials.
18. Do not use with a damaged cord or plug. If the machine has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, take it to a Dapper service center or authorized Dapper warranty service dealer.
19. To unplug, grab the plug, not the cord, and disconnect. Never handle the plug with wet hands.

Follow these instructions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

1. How the Machine Arrives



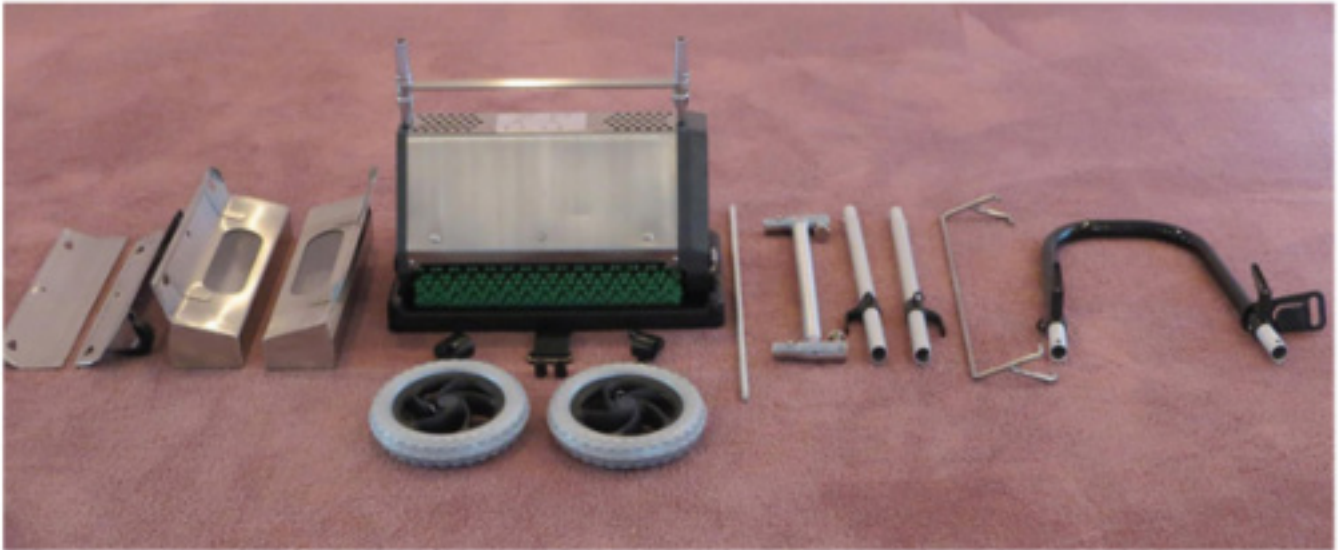
2. Open box (always be careful not to cut yourself when removing any packaging)



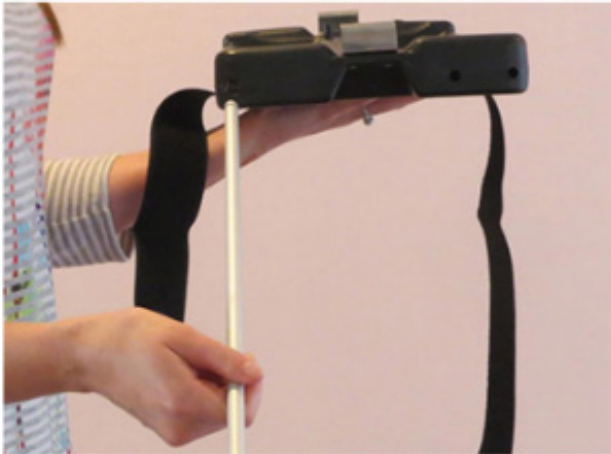
3. Remove content



4. Remove protective wrapping on each piece



5. Machine Parts Set

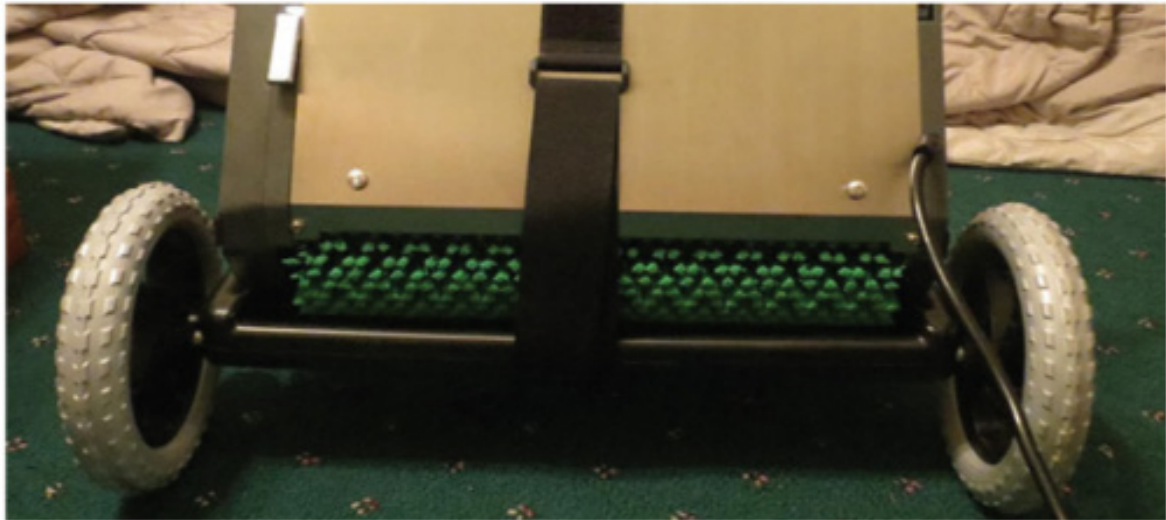


6. Assemble the Transport Trolley: first, insert the axle into a single hole.

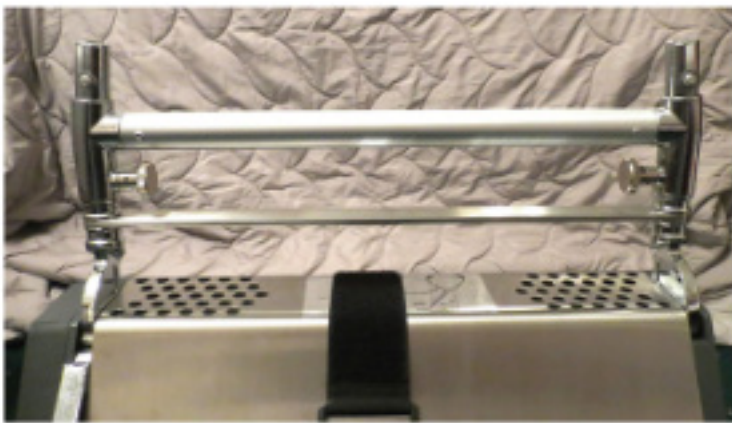
7. Attach wheels to the axle, push in the clip to lock the wheels, and ensure they are securely locked.



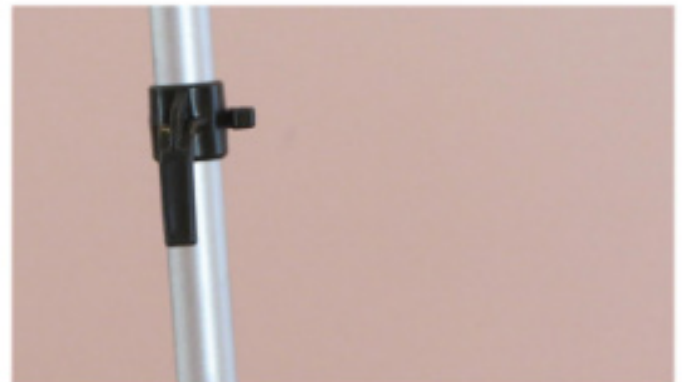
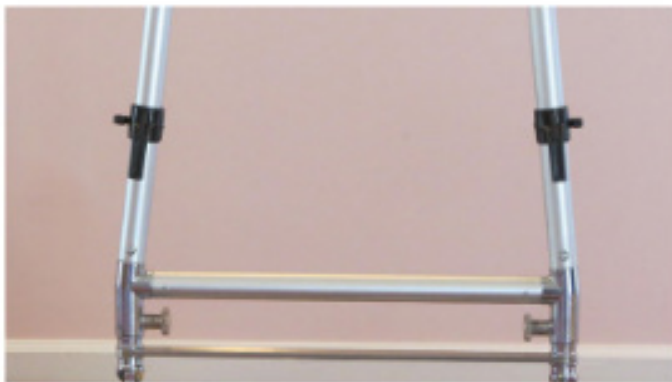
8. Insert front Bar on from of Transport Trolley



9. Put Machine on Transport Trolley



10. Attach Connecting Bar on Top of Machine – Snap Buttons facing back



11. Attach each side of Handle Bars – Push in Snap Buttons to attach – Cord clips are outside



12. Attach Top Handle Bar – Push in Snap Buttons to attach



13. Complete Machine

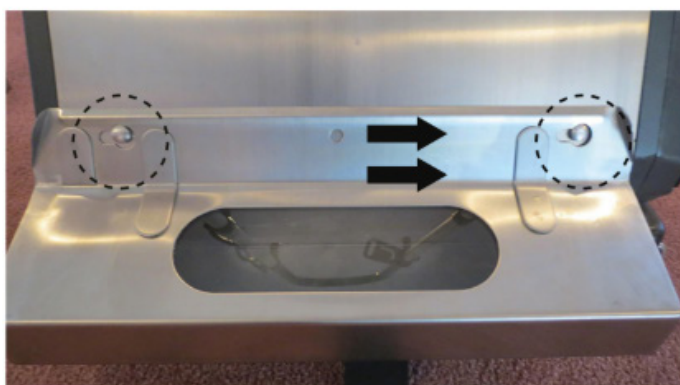

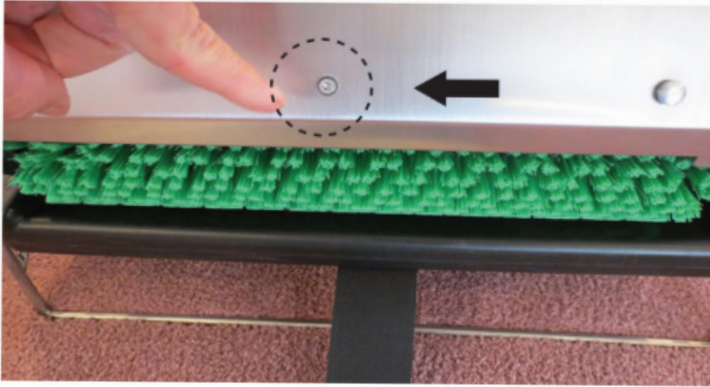
14. Attaching Dust Cover – Pushover Slots and Push Right to Clicked Button



15. Removing Dust Cover – Push Button & Slide Left



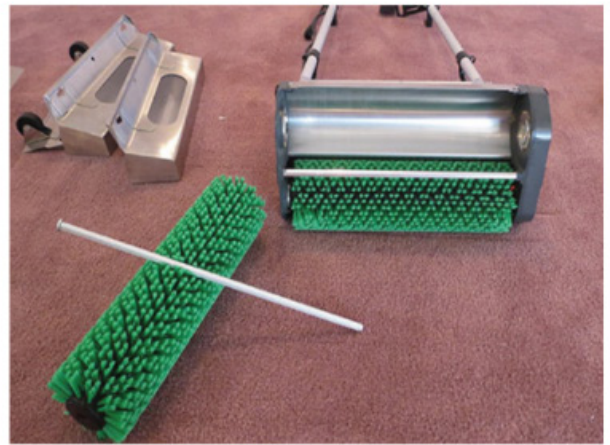
16. Attaching Receptacles - Pushover Slots and Push Right to Clicked Button



17. Removing Receptacles – Push Button and slide Left.



18. Push End of Bar and Slide Out



19. Align Bar & Brush and Push until it slides all the Through – DO NOT FORCE



DO NOT put the brush axles in backwards as this will damage the flange and gears.



20. Mount the handle on the bolt and connect both parts together.



Starting the machine



Push down the start lever on lower left side with your left foot. The motor will automatically start when the handle is pulled back. Place the electric cable in the clip provided on the handle. This will help to protect the cable from the rotating brushes.



Motor Safety Switch

The safety switch automatically cuts off the electricity if the motor overloads. After approx. 30 seconds press the button inwards and continue to work.



WARRANTY

LIMITED WARRANTY:

Dapper Supply, Inc. extends a limited warranty to the original purchaser, guaranteeing that this Dapper product is free from manufacturing defects in material or workmanship for three years from the date of purchase.

Should you discover any such defect within the warranty period, Dapper Supply, Inc. reserves the right to repair or replace the product without charge, or to cover the cost of replacement parts and repair labor needed to correct defects present at the time of purchase or resulting from regular usage, when the appliance has been installed, operated, and maintained as per the instructions provided.

At its sole discretion, Dapper Supply, Inc. may decide to replace the product. In such an event, your replacement appliance will carry the warranty for the remaining term of the original unit's warranty period.

This warranty is valid exclusively to the original purchaser of the product and only applicable within the United States. The warranty commences from the date of original consumer purchase. Proof of the original purchase date will be required to obtain service under this warranty.

Under this limited warranty, your sole and exclusive remedy will be product repair, as outlined above. All services must be provided by a Dapper-designated service company.

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS:

This limited warranty will not cover:

1. Failure of the product to perform during power failures or interruptions, or due to inadequate electrical service.
2. Damage incurred during transportation or handling.
3. Damage caused by accidents, vermin, lightning, winds, fire, floods, or acts of God.
4. Damage resulting from accidents, alterations, misuse, abuse, improper installation, repair, or maintenance. This includes using any external device that alters or converts the voltage or frequency of electricity.
5. Unauthorized product modifications, repairs by unauthorized centers, or use of non-approved replacement parts.
6. Abnormal cleaning and maintenance not aligned with the user's manual.
7. Use of incompatible accessories or components.
8. Any costs associated with repairs or replacements under these excluded circumstances shall be the responsibility of the consumer.
