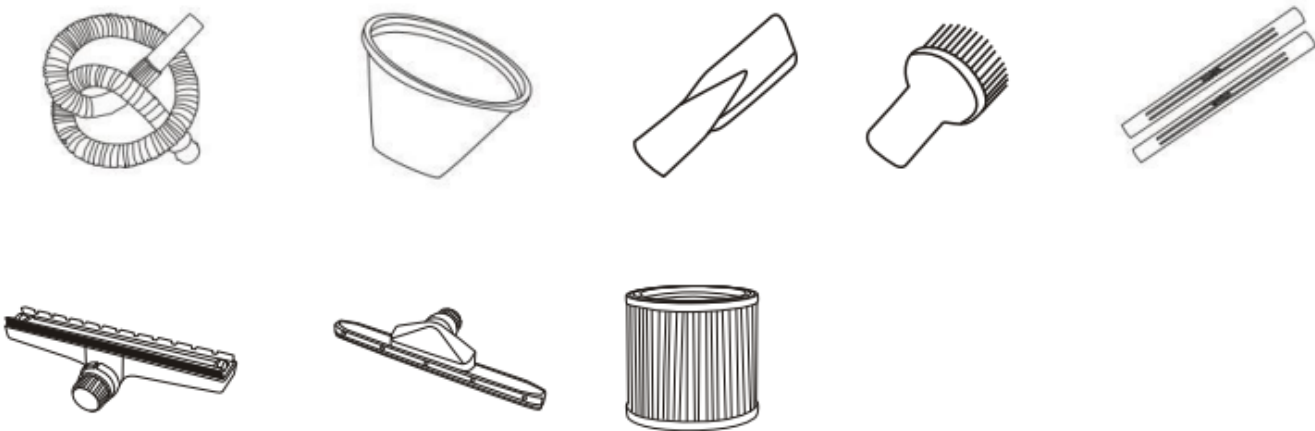


How to Use the Dust Shake:

1. Turn on the power.
2. Block the suction inlet.
3. Press and hold the dust shake button for 1-2 seconds, then release it. Repeat this process 5-10 times.

WARNING! IMPORTANT – Read all safety warnings and instructions BEFORE USE.

Failure to comply may cause electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

1. Before using, ensure the operator is properly trained in using this cleaner.
2. Use the socket outlet only for purposes specified in the instructions.
3. If liquid leaks from the cleaner, turn it off immediately.
4. Regularly clean and inspect the water level limiter for damage.
5. Do not operate the cleaner without a filter; replace damaged filters immediately.
6. EXTENSION CORD USE: Choose a sufficiently thick but not excessively long cord to avoid performance loss. For outdoor use, use an outdoor-rated extension cord.
7. VOLTAGE WARNING: Ensure the power source matches the cleaner's nameplate voltage. Overvoltage may cause SERIOUS INJURY and damage. If unsure, DO NOT PLUG IN. Undervoltage harms the motor.
8. PREVENT ACCIDENTAL STARTING: Ensure the switch is OFF before plugging in
9. Do not vacuum flammable materials, fireworks, lit cigarettes, hot ashes, metal chips, or sharp objects like razors, needles, or broken glass.
10. NEVER USE NEAR GASOLINE, PAINT, ADHESIVES, OR EXPLOSIVES. Sparks from the switch and motor may ignite them, causing explosions.
11. Never vacuum toxic, carcinogenic, or hazardous substances like asbestos, arsenic, beryllium, lead, or pesticides.
12. Do not use outdoors in rainy conditions.
13. Keep away from heat sources like stoves.
14. AVOID ELECTRIC SHOCK: Prevent contact with grounded surfaces like pipes, radiators, ovens, or refrigerators.
15. Do not block cooling vents, as this may cause the motor to overheat and burn out.
16. Maintain proper footing and balance at all times.
17. DO NOT ABUSE CORD. Never carry the cleaner by the cord or yank it from the receptacle. Keep it away from heat, oil, and sharp edges.
18. Do not fold, pull, or step on the hose.
19. Stop immediately if performance declines or any abnormality occurs.
20. DISCONNECT THE CLEANER when not in use, during servicing, and when changing accessories.
21. Clean and service the cleaner after each use to maintain top performance.
22. MAINTAIN WITH CARE. Keep the cleaner clean for safety and efficiency. Follow accessory replacement guidelines. Inspect cords regularly and repair or replace if damaged. Keep handles dry and free from oil or grease.

23. CHECK DAMAGED PARTS. Ensure damaged parts are inspected and repaired by an authorized center. Misaligned or broken components may affect functionality. Do not use the cleaner if the switch malfunctions.
24. USE IDENTICAL REPLACEMENT PARTS when servicing.
25. STORE CLEANER PROPERLY. Keep indoors when not in use.
26. Handle with care; rough use may damage even the sturdiest cleaner.
27. Do not clean the interior or exterior with benzine, thinner, or chemicals, as they may cause cracks or discoloration.
28. Never use the cleaner in enclosed areas where flammable, explosive, or toxic vapors or dust are present.
29. Do not leave the cord on the floor after use—it can be a tripping hazard or damage the cleaner.
30. Do not operate while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
31. WEAR SAFETY GEAR. Use goggles or glasses with side shields.
32. Wear a dust mask in dusty conditions.
33. This cleaner is not for unsupervised use by young children or infirm individuals.
34. SUPERVISE CHILDREN to ensure they do not play with the cleaner.
35. Never handle the plug, cord, or cleaner with wet hands.
36. Use extreme caution when cleaning on stairs.

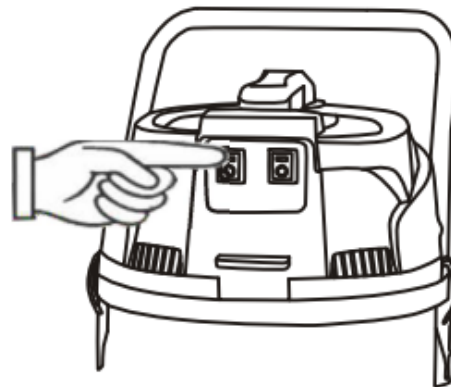
ASSEMBLY

CAUTION: Always ensure the cleaner is switched off and unplugged before performing any maintenance or service.

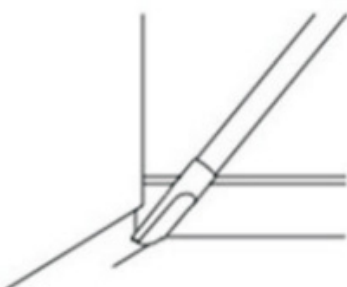
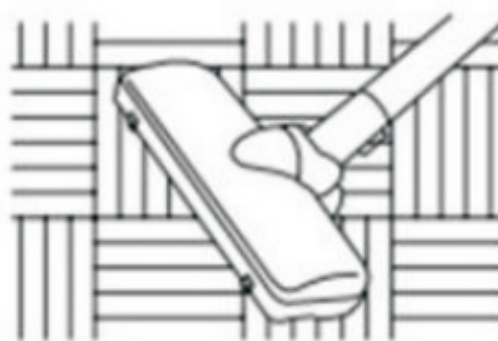
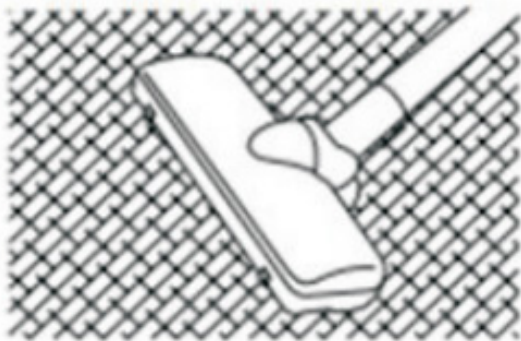
1. Insert the hose into the suction hole and secure it by rotating clockwise.
2. Assemble the brush and tube as shown in the diagram.
3. After use, rotate the hose counterclockwise to unlock it, then pull it out.

OPERATION

1. Insert the plug into the socket correctly and turn the switch "ON" to start the vacuum cleaner.
2. Use the handle to lift and carry the cleaner with ease.



Brush can widely used on Carpet and Floor



Nozzle can used on corners and gaps

Small brush can used on sofa, curtain, bed, etc

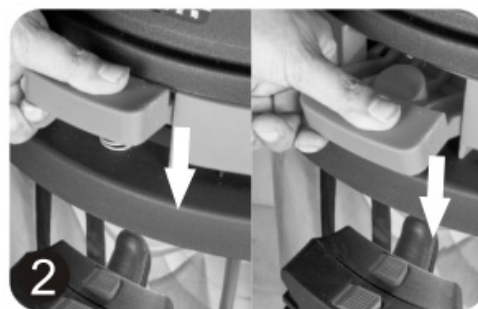


Dust Shake

If the extraction power is weak, clean the filter by following these steps:



Ensure the vacuum cleaner is powered on. Then, disconnect the hose from the vacuum cleaner and insert the block adapter.



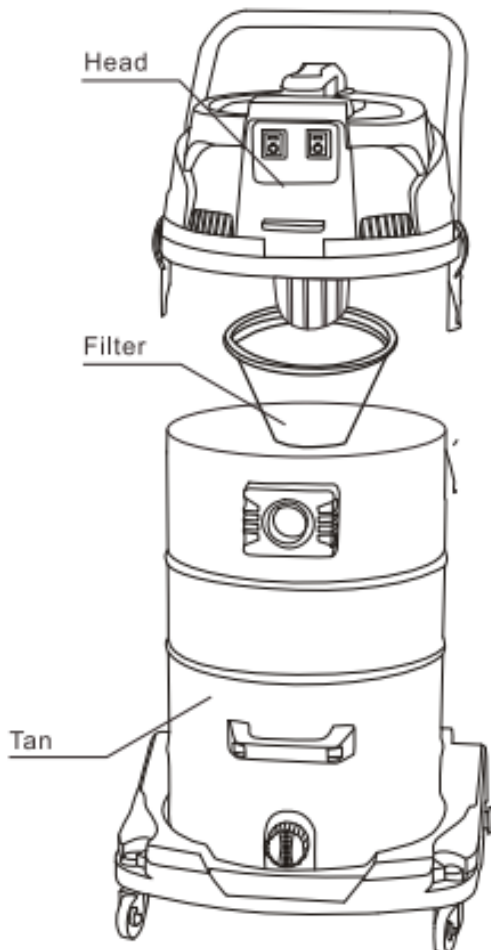
Firmly press the dust shaking button for 2 seconds, then release it for 5 seconds. Repeat this process 5 times.

MAINTENANCE

Clean and Replace Filter

Suction power will noticeably decrease when the tank is full. To maintain optimal performance, empty the trash promptly.

When the tank is full of water, the floater will activate, causing a distinct sound and blocking suction. Stop operation immediately and drain the water from the tank.

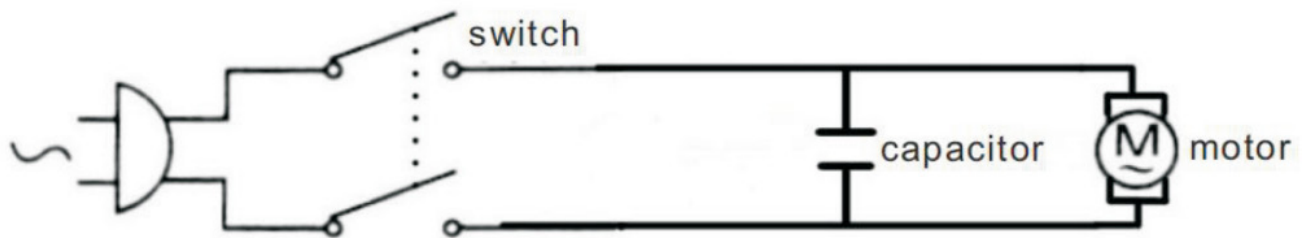


How to clean:

1. Release the two clips to unlock the machine head from the tank.
2. Carefully lift and remove the machine head.
3. Remove the filter and clean it.
4. Reassemble by following the steps in reverse order.
5. Replace the filter if damaged.

Remark: If the machine head does not fit correctly, check whether the filter is positioned properly.

Clean and Maintenance

Dust Container Cleaning

When dust suction is complete or the container is full, suction power may decrease. In this case, turn off the power and empty the dust container.

1. Loosen the container and lift the cover.
2. Remove the filter bag and empty the dust inside the container.
3. Place the filter bag back in its original position, ensuring that the power switch and inlet opening are aligned.

Filter Bag Cleaning

If the filter bag becomes severely clogged, clean it thoroughly with warm water. If needed, use a mild, neutral detergent.

If you encounter any issues while using the cleaner, please refer to the table below to identify the possible cause.

WARNING: Before performing any repairs or cleaning, always turn OFF the power and unplug the machine.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum Cleaner does not work	Not plug in	plug in correct position
	Switch not on 'ON' position	turn switch 'ON'
	No electric power from socket	check the electric situation
Suction power lose	motor is overheat, the protective facility works	let the motor cooling down for 2 hours and then use it again
	dust tank is full	clean the dust tank
	hose broken	replace the hose
	suction hole blocked	check all connection part
	filter not fixed well	re-fix the filter
	hose connectors not fixed well	reassembly the hose
Brush/nozzle difficult to move	strong suction power makes it hard move	adjust the angle between brush/nozzle and floor
