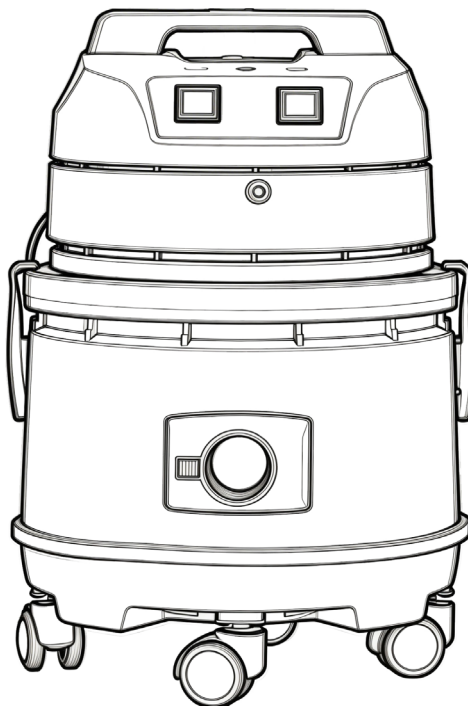

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INTRODUCTION

The Washing Machine is a professional cleaning system designed to tackle tough cleaning jobs on cotton fabric sofas, upholstered walls, carpets, staircases, and car interiors across all fiber types.

- Spraying and vacuuming operate simultaneously, making it efficient, flexible, and ideal for routine maintenance cleaning.
- Suitable for all workplace surfaces including sofas, curtains, mattresses, seats, and carpets.
- Built for large-area cleaning with a working radius of up to 49 ft (15 m).
- Powerful suction allows for fast drying and thorough cleaning. Can also be used as a standalone dry or wet vacuum.

SAFETY

Please read this manual carefully before use. Contact your local distributor with any questions.

1. Before use, confirm that your power supply voltage matches the rating on the nameplate.
2. Do not drag or pull the machine by the hand brush or suction hose. To reposition the machine, push it by the base or lift it by the handle.
3. When the recovery tank is full, the float valve will rise and cut off suction. Drain the recovery tank before continuing.
4. After each use, rinse the hand brush and suction hose with water to prevent bacteria growth and odor.
5. To use the machine as a small-area vacuum, remove the solution tank, install the dust bag and filter, and attach the vacuum nozzle.
6. Do not replace any parts yourself. Unauthorized repairs void all liability coverage.

OPERATION

OPERATION STEPS

1. Add an appropriate amount of defoamer to the recovery tank (A-11).
2. Using the funnel, add an appropriate amount of detergent to the solution tank (A-14), then wipe down the exterior surface to keep it dry.
3. Insert the infusion tube into the solution tank port and secure the side button.
4. Connect the buddy connector (B-18d) to the port (A-10).
5. Connect the hose set connector (B-18c) to the connector (A-6) on the middle cover.
6. Connect the spray handle (B-17) to the hose connector (B-18b).
7. Connect the transparent coupling (B-18a) to the outlet connector on the spray handle (B-17).
8. Connect the plastic nozzle (B-19) to the spray handle (B-17).
9. To use the extension wand, swap the short transparent coupling for the long one, connect the telescopic wand (B-20) or stainless steel nozzle (B-21) to your desired attachment, and connect the spray handle (B-17) to the other end.
10. The green button controls spraying (A-2); the red button controls vacuuming (A-3).
11. Press the valve on the spray handle (B-17) to spray and vacuum simultaneously.
12. For steam cleaning, connect the hose connector (B-15a) to the steam upholstery tool (B-20).
13. Turn on the steam switch (A-3) and wait approximately 15 seconds until steam flows continuously. Steam activates with a single press.
14. When finished, turn off the power and drain all dirty water from the machine.

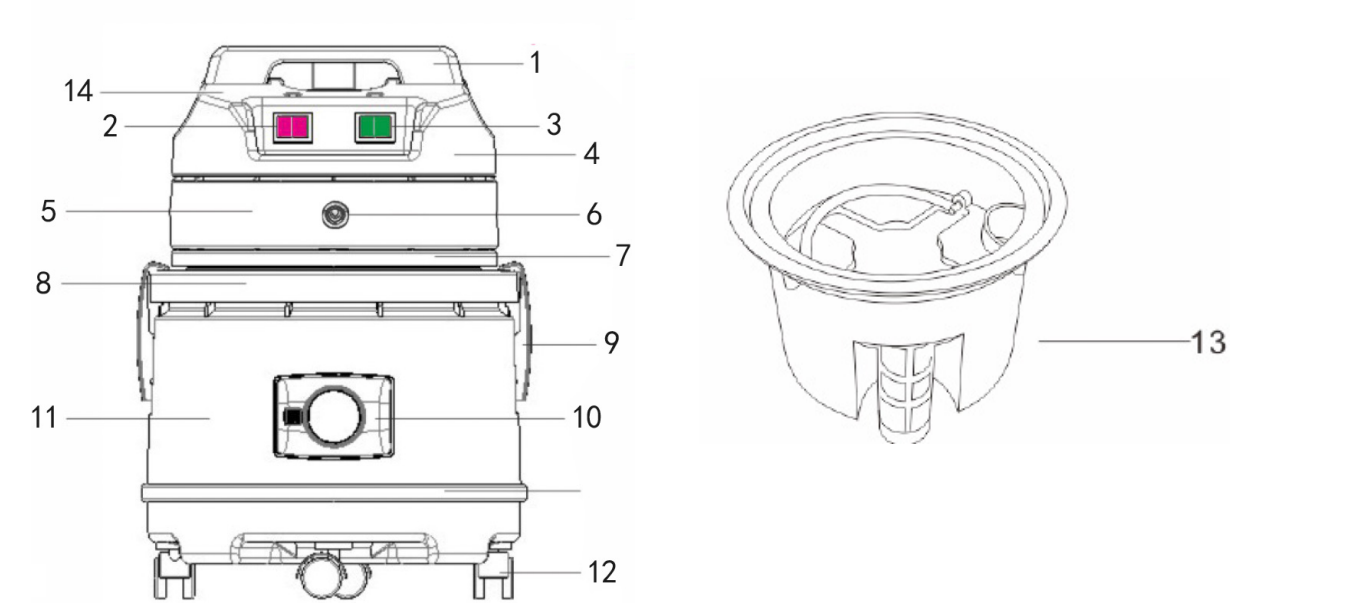

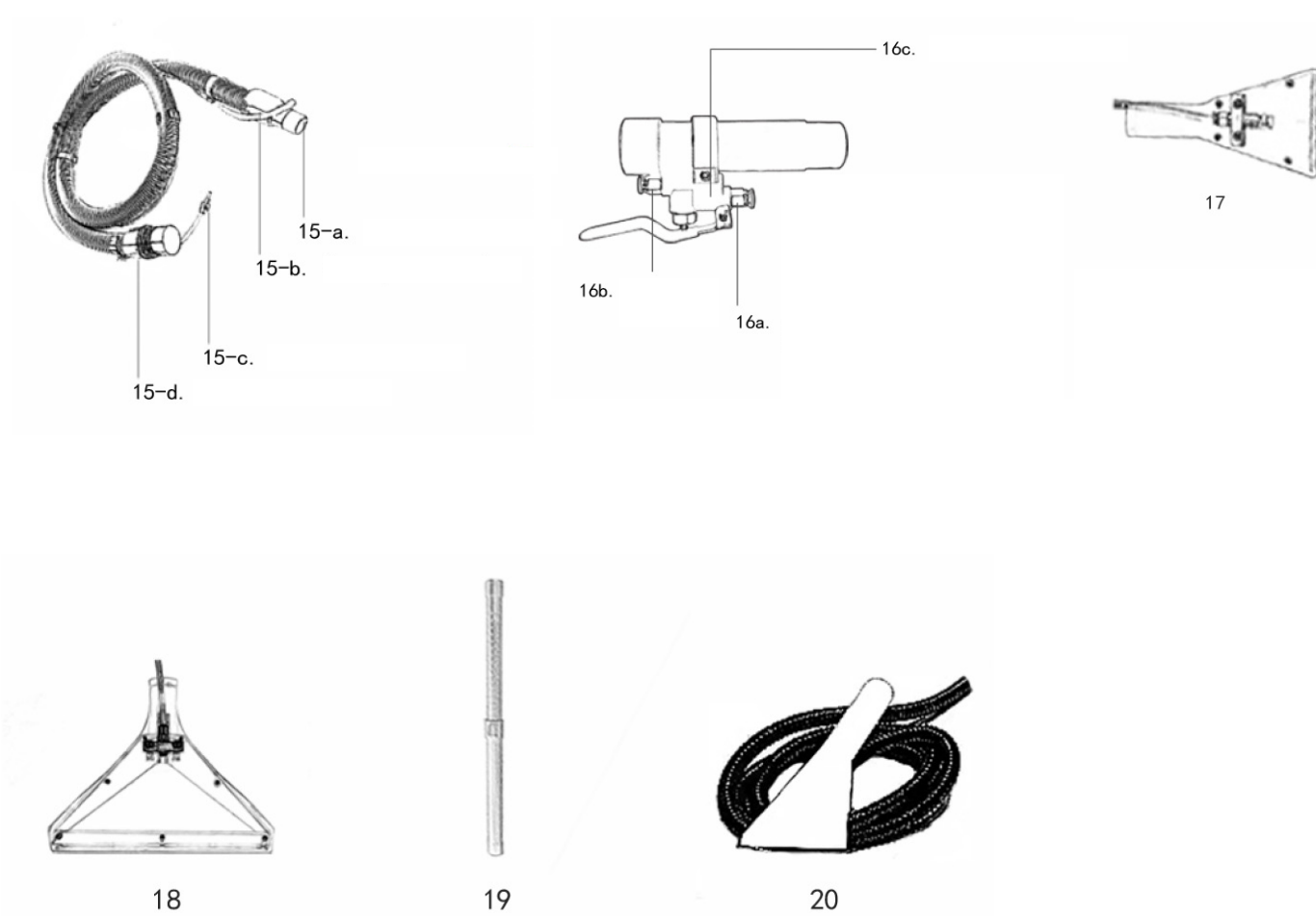

Limited Warranty

If a defect is discovered within the warranty period, Dapper Supply, Inc. reserves the right to repair or replace the product at no cost to you, or to cover the cost of replacement parts and repair labor necessary to address defects present at the time of purchase or resulting from normal usage, provided the product has been installed, operated, and maintained according to the provided instructions. Any replacement parts requested within the first year are free of charge and fall under this warranty.

At its sole discretion, Dapper Supply, Inc. may choose to replace the product. In such cases, the replacement product will carry the warranty for the remainder of the original unit's warranty period. This warranty is valid exclusively for the original purchaser of the product and applies only within the United States. The warranty begins on the date of the original purchase. Proof of the purchase date is required to obtain service under this warranty.
