

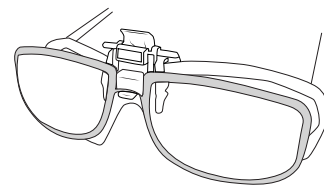

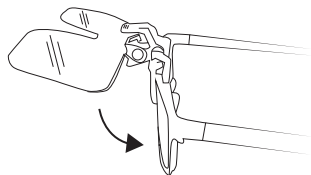

USING SAFETY GLASSES WITH MAGNIFICATION

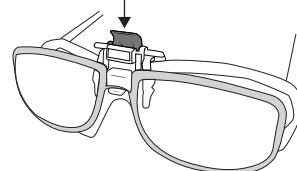
Flip magnifying lenses down over safety glasses.



Flip up or remove magnifying lenses when not needed. To remove magnifying lenses, pinch clip and lift off.

Note: You can attach magnifying lenses to any glasses when magnification is needed.

Pinch here and lift off to remove magnifying lenses



CLEANING AND STORAGE

1. Gently blow any loose dirt or debris from lenses.
2. Clean using microfiber lens cloth. Do not use any abrasives, chemical cleaners, or solvents. Do not expose lenses to chemical vapors such as ammonia or alcohol-based cleaning products.
3. Rinse lenses with lukewarm water or use a polycarbonate-safe lens cleaning spray.
4. Improper cleaning can cause scratching which may weaken the polycarbonate and decrease optical quality of lenses (safety glass or clip-on lenses).
5. Store glasses in protective pouch.

WARNING

- This product is rated for eye protection against low to moderated impact hazards but is not unbreakable. Not recommended for high impact hazards.
- Pitted or scratched lenses reduce protection and should be replaced immediately.
- Safety glasses do not provide unlimited protection. Leave work area if eye irritation occurs or if glasses become damaged or cracked.
