



Biometric Keypad Fire Resistant Safe

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WARNINGS

- In Factory Default mode, the safe CANNOT be opened by any fingerprint. For security purposes, please promptly register your own fingerprint before starting to use the safe. The initial Pin Code is 159. Kindly follow the Fingerprint/ pin code set up to establish your personalized fingerprint/pin code.
- Register at least two different fingerprints and test them a few times before closing the safe door.
- Test with a non-registered fingerprint to ensure successful registration.
- Avoid leaving the door open and unattended, as it could allow unauthorized individuals to reprogram the safe, gaining full access to its contents.
- Do NOT store combustible materials in this unit.
- In the event of a fire, exercise caution when opening the safe. If you are unsure about opening the safe due to its contents, contact your local fire department for assistance.
- Test the Emergency Keys and store them in a secure place outside of the safe.
- Test and ensure the safe works properly before mounting.
- It is recommended to check/change the battery every 4 to 6 months.
- Mount the safe before use, as it may tip forward if not properly mounted.
- Keep children away from the safe; they should not play with or around it at any time. Children playing could accidentally get locked inside the safe or inadvertently pull on the door, causing it to tip over if not properly mounted.
- Failure to follow these warnings could result in serious injury or death

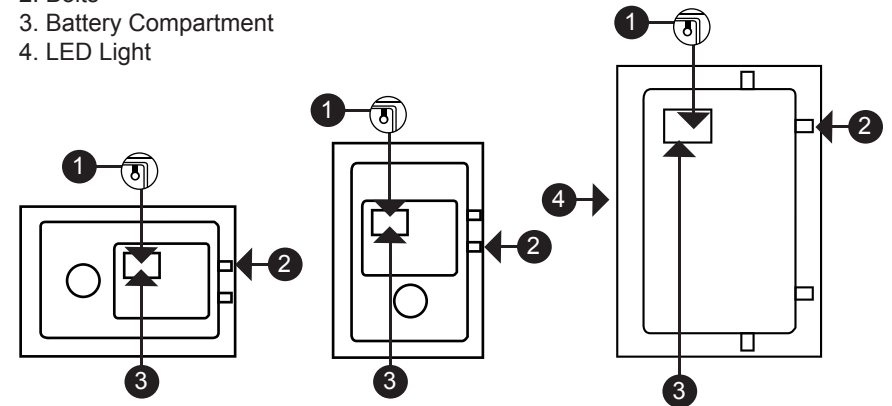

Parts Of The Safe

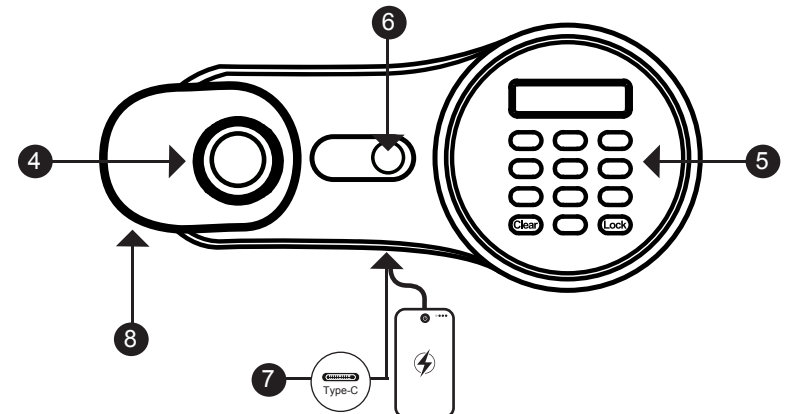
Parts of the Inside of the Safe Door

1. Initialization Button
Remove battery cover with a screw driver to expose the initialization button
2. Bolts
3. Battery Compartment
4. LED Light



Parts of the Control Panel

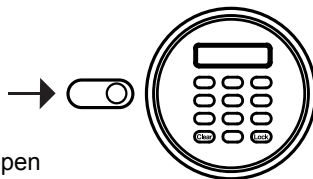
4. Fingerprint Scanner
5. Keypad
6. Emergency Lock Cover
To remove the key cover, gently press the right side of the key cover to release the magnet, then lift it away with your other hand.
7. Type-C Socket
8. Handle

Opening Safe For The First Time

1. Remove the key cover.
2. Insert the emergency key.
3. Turn the key clockwise.
4. Turn the handle anticlockwise (downward) to open the safe door.



Install Batteries

1. Open the safe door.
2. Remove the battery cover with a screw driver.
3. Insert 4 AA alkaline batteries into the battery compartment.
4. The safe will perform a self-test.
5. The display will count down from 9 to 0, then show GOOD, confirming proper installation.

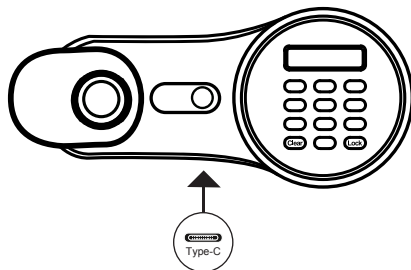
Note:

- Use only alkaline batteries.
- DO NOT mix new and old batteries.
- DO NOT mix different battery types.

External Power Supply

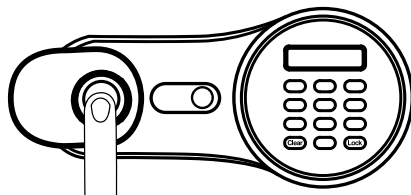
Type-C Socket is located on the bottom of the keypad. In the event of a battery failure, can be accessed from the power source.

1. Prepare a mobile power bank with a Type-C plug.
2. Connect the power bank to the Type-C socket on the safe keypad (see PARTS OF THE CONTROL PANEL).
3. Open the safe using your registered fingerprint or PIN code.



Fingerprint Registration

1. Open the safe door.
2. Press and release the Initialization Button inside the safe.
 - You will hear one beep.
 - The display and fingerprint scanner will flash.
3. Place your finger on the scanner, then remove it. You will hear one beep.
4. Repeat the scan two more times.
5. You will hear two beeps, and the scanner will flash twice.
6. The fingerprint is successfully registered.



Fingerprint Registration can be stored up to Maximum 100 different fingerprints.

Fingerprint Registration Tips:

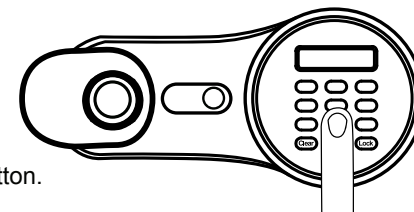
- DO NOT use fingers with cuts or scars.
- Ensure fingers are clean and dry.
- Place finger flat in the center of the scanner.
- In cold or dry conditions, moisturize and rub hands before scanning.
- Test an unregistered finger to confirm the safe remains locked.

Pin Codes Registration

Default PIN code: 159

Pin Code length: 3-8 digits

1. Open the safe door.
2. Press and release the Initialization Button.
 - You will hear one beep.
3. Enter your new PIN code.
4. Press LOCK to confirm.



Important

- Test the new PIN code to confirm successful registration.
- Follow the Lock/Unlock Safe instructions to verify proper function.

Lock/Unlock Safe

Unlock Safe with Pin Code

1. Press the LOCK button to activate the keypad.
2. Enter your registered PIN code (3–8 digits).
3. The display will show OPEN.
4. Turn the handle anticlockwise (downward) to open.

Unlock Safe with Fingerprint

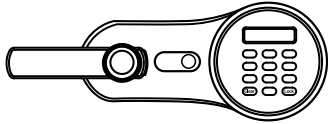
1. Place a registered finger on the fingerprint scanner.
2. The display will show OPEN.
3. Turn the handle anticlockwise (downward) to open.

Note:

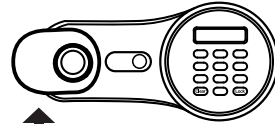
Fingerprints cannot open the safe in Factory Default Mode until registered.

Lock Safe

1. Close the safe door.
2. There are two types of keypads. Please check which one you have and see how the handle is used to lock the safe door.



Handle will automatically return to the horizontal position.



Turn the handle clockwise (upward) to close the door.

3. The safe is now locked.

Reset To Factory Default Mode

1. Open the safe door.
2. Press and hold the Initialization Button for 3–4 seconds.
3. Release when you hear two beeps, the safe is back to factory default mode.

Note:

- Default PIN Code: 159
- All registered fingerprints will be deleted.
- Sound will be enabled.
- Any Fingerprints CANNOT open the safe in Factory Default Mode

Lockout Mode

- After 5 consecutive incorrect entries, the safe will beep for 30 seconds.
- The keypad and fingerprint scanner will be disabled for 3.5 minutes.

Low Battery Warning

When pressing “Lock” to wake up the safe, the display show “LO-BATTE” means the battery is in low voltage. Please replace all batteries.

Alarm System

- Press “0” while the safe is in sleep mode to activate the vibration alarm system.
- When activated, the alarm will sound if the safe is moved or shaken.
- To terminate the alarm, enter the correct password or use a registered fingerprint.
- After opening the safe to terminate the alarm, please press “0” to re-activate the alarm system.

Sound Off/On

Press the CLEAR button to toggle sound. Display will show “SOUND OFF” or “SOUND ON”

Hide Code Function

1. Press LOCK to wake the keypad.
2. Press CLEAR.
3. Enter your PIN code.
4. The display will hide the numbers during entry

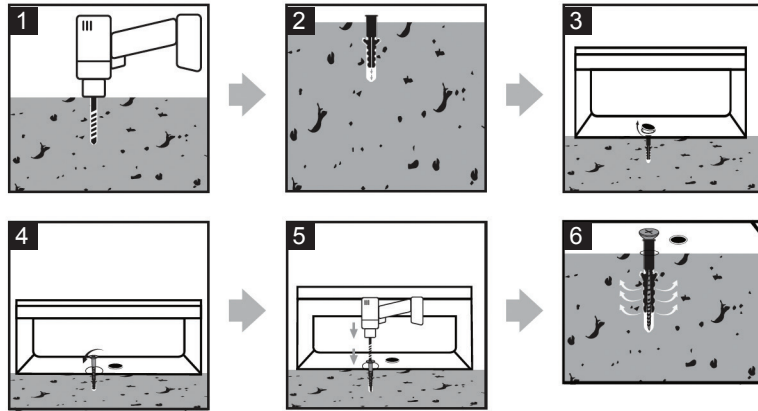

Care And Maintenance

- To maximize the security and performance of the safe, keep Fingerprint Scanner clean; use a dry cloth to remove any smudges or prints off the Fingerprint Scanner after each use.
- Test registered fingerprints and PIN code every 6 months.
- Keep liquids away from the control panel. Spills on the control panel will cause damage and possibly electric shock.
- Secure safe in a proper area to prevent from falling and causing damage or injury.
- DO NOT disassemble the product. For all repairs, contact BARSKA Customer Service.
- DO NOT use chemicals or cleaning agents to clean the safe.

Mounting Instructions

The safe can be mounted to the floor. Be aware of the load bearing. Failure to do so can result in personal injury and/or damage to property. Use appropriate tools when performing work and always use eye protection.



Floor Mounting

1. Drill a hole in the ground where the installation is required with an electric drill, ensuring the hole is the same size as the expansion tube.
2. Insert the expansion tube into the hole.
3. Remove the mounting hole cover at the bottoms on the safes.
4. Make the fixing screw to pass through the mounting holes on the safes and the hole which you just drilled.
5. Tighten the screws with a screwdriver or an electric drill.
6. After being subjected to force, the expansion pipe opens and its tail against the wall.
